HUNDREDS of people flocked to a major highway circling Buenos Aires after news of the latest in road hazards—a collision between a car and a flying saucer.

Some reports claimed that two of the saucer's crew were captured after the collision on General Paz-avenue.

In Bahia Blanca, 430 miles southwest of Buenos Aires, a 19-year-old mother of two said a man from outer space had called at her house.

The woman, Susanna de Salazar, said a tall, hairless and earless being with flashing eyes, a big mouth and long teeth, rapped at the door of her house. When the creature saw her it disappeared.

She fainted.
