

# ON WATCH FOR FLYING SAUCERS

A group of enthusiasts at Folkestone have set up their own space-tracking station to investigate the phenomenon of flying saucers and other unidentified flying objects.

A special check is being kept by the group of any disturbances of the ionosphere and the earth's magnetic field caused by the appearance of UFOs.

"We have special recorder boxes planted under the earth in a number of fields surrounding Folkestone," a spokesman said at the group's headquarters in Victoria Grove, Folkestone.

High-frequency radio equipment using large aerials pointing out into space, enable members to differentiate between communications from earth-launched satellites and disturbances caused by unknown objects.

Recently there has been an increase in the number of "sightings" of UFOs in the Folkestone and Hythe area.
