

# MP WANTS 'FLYING SAUCER' PROBE

**A** Federal MP has asked the Air Force to investigate whether a flying saucer landed on his property on the north coast of New South Wales recently.

Mr. Ian Robertson said that he had always been sceptical about flying saucers and unidentified flying objects, but now he wasn't so sure.

An extremely shaken farmer had asked him to have a look at some strange damage to a fodder crop.

"What I saw has been completely perplexing," said Mr. Robertson. "I just can't find any explanation short of a visit by some strange craft."

## FLATTENED

He said an area of the crop measuring 60ft. by 25ft. had been flattened. Some yards farther on a small area had been flattened and had some indentions on the ground which indicated that something had moved along for a short distance.

"It appeared as though something had landed in the big patch and travelled along the ground for some distance, then taken off. Then it had landed a few yards away, travelled along the ground for a shorter distance and taken off again," said Mr. Robertson.
