

IT'S RAINING FISH

A RETIRED engineer from East London was well aware of the existence of flying fish, but that didn't stop him being completely dumb-founded when he looked out into his garden.

For lying on his lawn were six fish.

After a sudden shower, the 67-year-old man was amazed to find the fish and he took them to the Natural History Museum to be analysed.

They were shown to the curator of European fish, Alwyne Wheeler, who confirmed that the small fish were commonly found in river estuaries.
