

# Mark sees UFO over Broomhill

Yet another unidentified flying object has been sighted in Keighley.

The latest edition to Keighley's diary of the unknown came on Saturday, when 13 year old Mark Adams, of Luddenden, Halifax, spotted some strange lights in the sky over Broomhill, Keighley.

Mark, who was walking with his grandparents through Broomhill estate at 8.45 p.m., described the lights: "I spotted a so-called UFO in the form of red, green, and white lights travelling from South West to North East.

"Although it was a moonlight

night the sky was cloudy and it was very plain to see below the clouds, travelling at a great speed.

"It could not have been a plane because the lights on it did not flash and there was not a single sound in the sky. I would be grateful to know if anyone else saw the object in the sky."

Mark's is the latest in a string of UFO sightings in the Keighley district over the past three years.
