

UFO Creature Breaks up Police Chief's Marriage

'My Wife Divorced Me When I Gave Her Photo I Took of a Spaceman'

A visitor from outer space has broken up the happy marriage of Police Chief Jeff Greenhaw of Falkville, Ala. When Greenhaw told her about seeing the strange spaceman she laughed in his face — even when he provided a snapshot of the creature to prove he wasn't dreaming.

She's still probably laughing after she got the divorce, according to Greenhaw.

"She wouldn't be laughing if she saw what I saw," Greenhaw said.

Greenhaw's domestic problems were launched when a woman telephoned him at home. She told the police chief she had seen a "spaceship" with flashing lights land in a field near the tiny town of Falkville.

THE POLICE CHIEF, who had been given similar UFO reports recently, raced to the scene with his camera.

On the lonely gravel road, he got the shock of his life.

Standing in the middle of the roadway was the creature. It was covered with a metallic material of some kind. Its face was featureless. There was a short antenna on top of its head.

The chief stepped outside his squad car with his camera.

"Howdy, stranger," Greenhaw said.

But the creature didn't reply, and started moving toward him. The frightened chief flashed four pictures.

FINALLY, THE spaceman stopped, scarcely 10 feet away.

"I was scared stiff," Greenhaw admitted.

He said he reached into his squad

car and flipped on the flashing blue lights — and the space creature wheeled and ran.

"I jumped into my car and took after him," Greenhaw said.

But the creature was too fast, even for the high-powered police car.

"He was running faster than any human being I ever saw," said Greenhaw.

Greenhaw said his car suddenly skidded on the loose gravel, and by the time he got it back under control the visitor had vanished.

GREENHAW KNEW the story was unbelievable, but he thought his pictures would convince all doubters. But his wife simply wouldn't join the growing number who are convinced Greenhaw really saw a visitor from outer space.

She filed for a divorce and received it the same day — routine procedure in Alabama when the divorce is uncontested.

To a large number of people, however, Greenhaw's experience was far from unbelievable as UFOs criss-crossed southern skies en masse.

of Columbus, Ala., and several policemen reported seeing a UFO with green and red lights hovering over a stockyard.


Two youths in Mobile County,

Ala., spotted a saucer-shaped UFO about to land and fired two shots at it with a 12 gauge shotgun. They said before the UFO zipped away, a door in the object opened briefly.

A RASH OF UFO sightings were reported near Parrish, Ala., and the Norman Blanton family watched one land in a field near their home. They said the object changed colors as it landed — from white to green to blood red. The Blantons rushed to the landing spot in their car, but as they approached the object lifted from the ground and shot skyward.

Such sightings are not the result of hysteria or imagination, said Dr. Stonewall Stickney, an Alabama psychiatrist.

"I think the people have been seeing something, and there is no reason to think the objects are not from some other planet," he said.
