# Three Amazing Cases of UFO Healing

**A Man Aged 73 Grew New Teeth** **Paralyzed Pianist Was Able To Play the Piano Again** **A Young Girl Was Cured of Cancer**

On Dec. 30, 1972, at about 10:20 p.m., an illiterate night watchman named Ventura Maceiras was sitting listening to his transistor radio outside his wooden shack in the Argentina boondocks.

Suddenly the radio began to fail. He thumped it a few times with no effect, then as he switched it off, he noticed a loud humming "like the noise of angry bees."

Looking up, he saw a powerful light hanging stationary, directly above a nearby grove of eucalyptus trees. In the middle of the light, he could clearly distinguish an enormous object whose color, as he watched, changed from orange to purple.


At the center of the object, Maceiras could see a round cabin with windows, and through the windows, two figures. The figures wore helmets and what looked like dark gray divers' suits made of inflated tubes joined together to give an accordion effect.

They both had slanting eyes which gazed fixedly at him, and their mouths were a thin line. As the craft tilted toward him, Maceiras could see instruments and dials inside the cabin.

Then almost immediately a brilliant flash of light shot out from underneath the craft, momentarily blinding him.

Seconds later, as the humming noise rose in pitch, the craft moved away slowly toward the northeast and disappeared behind the trees on a low hill.

Immediately after the incident, Maceiras felt a strong tingling sensation



in his legs, and for several weeks he suffered from unbearable headaches, violent nausea and diarrhea, and abnormal loss of hair.

He also developed swollen red pustules on the back of his neck, experienced difficulty in speaking, and his eyes watered constantly.

At the site where the object ap-

peared, the tops of the eucalyptus trees were scorched or completely burned, and a large number of dead catfish were found in a nearby stream!

Maceiras, who was 73, was interviewed more than 60 times by different people, including doctors, engineers, and police officers. He answered every question without hesitation, and at no time was there any contradiction in his story — even under hypnosis.

But the most extraordinary effect of this encounter is that since February 1973 Ventura Maceiras has grown a new set of teeth — his third!

Perhaps the most fascinating case of direct UFO therapy on record took place in the French Alps in 1968. Reported by Aime Michel in Flying Saucer Review, "The Strange Case of Doctor 'X'" has never been published in America.

The only thing that distinguishes the case of Dr. "X" from biblical stories of miraculous cures is the careful scrutiny and follow-up done by contemporary scientific and medical observers.

Because he holds an official position in his town, the doctor has chosen to remain anonymous.

Dr. X is 43, married, and the father of a small son. Before stepping on a mine during the Algerian War, he was a gifted pianist, but the resulting partial paralysis of both limbs on his right side ended his piano playing and left him with a noticeable limp.

One other fact is pertinent: three days before the episode, while Dr. X was chopping wood, the ax slipped and wounded him on the left leg, just above the ankle.

The wound was treated immediately, but on the night of Nov. 1, 1968, he was still in pain and walked with extreme difficulty.

Sometime after 3 a.m. on the morning of November 2, during a rainstorm, Dr. X was awakened by his 14-month-old son calling from his crib.

In the nursery, he perceived, through closed shutters, powerful flashes of light he assumed to be lightning.

He gave the baby its bottle, painfully descended the stairs, and went to the kitchen for a drink of water. By then, the rain had stopped, but not the light flashes.

At some point, Dr. X realized he had heard no thunder. He went to the living room, opened the French windows wide, stepped out onto the terrace, and saw, far down the valley, two identical, luminous disk-shaped objects with horizontal and vertical antennas from which the flashes of brilliant light were being emitted at one-second intervals.

The two disks starting moving up the valley toward him and, at the same time, began to draw nearer to one another. Amazed, Dr. X watched the "inner antennae interpenetrate each other and then disappear entirely" as the twin objects came into contact and actually fused, the two disks becoming one!

The single disk continued to approach Dr. X's house until, at about 200 meters from where he stood, it stopped and remained stationary.

Then a light beam emanating from the disk (which Aime Michel later calculated to be approximately 140

feet long and 35 feet thick) began moving toward him.

The rotation of the disk's lower portion speeded up formidably, the disk tilted, and Dr. X "received the light-beam, which shone all over him . . . at the moment when the light-beam reached him he instinctively covered his face by a reflex action."

An instant later, Dr. X heard a "bang" like a firecracker, and "the object dematerialized," vanished, extinguished like the light from a TV tube.

Badly shaken, Dr. X returned to the kitchen and made notes on what he had seen, including sketches of the disks.

He then went upstairs, woke his wife, and told her what had happened. Suddenly, his wife cried out, "Your leg!"

Dr. X, who was striding back and forth and talking excitedly, was no longer limping. He pulled up his pajama leg.

The ax wound was completely healed.

Aime Michel is still following the case, for extraordinary things have been happening to Dr. X and his family; most notably, "all signs of his Algerian War wound — which had remained unchanged for 10 years — have completely vanished."

He plays the piano again as well as ever.

There is one intriguing incident from Brazil which took place at Petropolis, in the mountains to the west of Rio de Janeiro, where the daughter of a wealthy Brazilian family was dying of cancer of the stomach.

On the night of Oct. 25, 1957, when the girl was in agony, a beam of light appeared outside her bedroom window. But the beam was only the beginning.

Seven members of the girl's family were present as the room filled with vivid light.

Running to the window, her brother saw a saucer from whose open hatch descended what must be the strangest-looking Medivac team on record!

According to one of the witnesses, the two small beings "were 1.20 metres (a shade under four feet) in height, with long yellowish-red hair down to the shoulders, and bright green slanting 'Chinese' eyes."

In astonishment the family watched as the small surgeons approached the bed and laid out their instruments.


Then one of them placed his hand on the forehead of the sick girl's father, who immediately began to communicate to him, telepathically.

The small surgeons then shone onto the girl's stomach a "bluish-white light." The operation for the removal of the cancer took about half an hour.

Before leaving, the saucer Medivac team informed the girl's father telepathically that she would need medicine for a while, and gave him a metallic-looking "hollow ball" containing thirty small white pellets. The patient was to take one daily.

In December 1957, the girl's doctor was able to verify that she was indeed cured of cancer.
