

# UFOs Have Contacted U.S. Government, Says Research Group



**THIS IS** a photo of a UFO moving at night over Dallas, Texas, published for the first time. Mutual UFO Network, whose scientists checked the picture and the man who took it, says it is genuine, and it is not any natural phenomenon.

Alien beings — creatures from other worlds — have probably been in contact with the U.S. Government, according to scientific groups studying UFOs.

“There’s absolutely no doubt we are being visited by extraterrestrial life,” Stan Fouch, a UFO expert, told MIDNIGHT. “Recently, there has been a rash of new sightings.”

Fouch, an IBM mathematician, is a director of the Texas-based Mutual UFO Network (MUFON), one of the main scientific civilian organizations that study UFO phenomena in the U.S.

“In one night alone, last November 10, there were 35 sightings over Kansas City, Mo. Pictures that were taken are still under study.

“Since the government stopped official investigation of UFOs in 1969 military

radar installations have logged them traveling at speeds up to 10,000 miles an hour and making right-angle turns.

“No machine built on this earth is capable of doing that.

“These objects vary in size from eight feet across to 150 feet. Mother ships — cigar-shaped and up to three miles long — are known to patrol outside Earth’s orbit. Astronauts have seen them.

“We feel pretty sure these beings have already contacted

our government. If the military isn’t out looking into UFO reports, we’ll be very surprised.”

One American UFO group is already in touch with the Russians, said Fouch.

“The Center for UFO Studies, in Evanston, Ill., researches the physical traces of UFOs, like the scenes of reported landings. The Center has an exchange of information agreement with the Moscow Institute of Aviation.”

Fouch told how the government was forced to officially deny the existence of UFOs.

“In the early fifties, the Air Force asked the public to report UFO sightings to them. In 1952 alone there were 1,900 sightings, and the Air Force communications were so tied up, another Pearl Harbor would have left them helpless. So the project was called off, and the government deliberately debunked the whole thing.”

People who observe UFO landings are generally unharmed, said Fouch, but one man was badly burned and others have been stunned or blinded temporarily.
