

UFO sighted over Goole

Yet another UFO has been sighted over Goole.

Three Goole men at Tudor Scrap Metals in Jerry Lane, Old Goole, saw a yellow - white circular object in the sky at around dusk on Wednesday of last week - and they had mixed feelings about the experience.

Mr Richard Sherwood, of New Close Lane, said: "I was frightened. I've seen all sorts of aircraft but this was no aircraft. It had no lights and did not make a sound."

Mr Sherwood said that Mr Jim Taylor, Of Jerry Lane, was tying up the guard dog for the night while he and Mr Alan Dixon, of Canal Side, were shutting the gates when they saw the round, yellow - white object in the sky above the docks. "It looked like the moon at first," said Mr Sherwood. "But it seemed to be heading straight for us."

"I thought it was going to land in the yard. We called Jim over and when he saw it he immediately went to call the police. Then, all of a sudden, it took off at a terrific speed downriver. It was the fastest thing I've ever seen."

Mr Dixon said it was strange that a Vulcan bomber aircraft came by

about five minutes later and went off in the same direction. It seemed to be following the flying saucer," he said.

Mr Sherwood said he would now believe anyone else who thought they had seen a UFO. "But I hope I never see that thing again," he said.

Mr Dixon had spotted UFOs before. "They can come thick and fast for me," he said. "I'd like to see one land - maybe it'll give us some jobs."

Mr Taylor thought the experience frightening, as Mr Sherwood did. "I was worried," he said. "I wanted to find the nearest hole and take cover. I honestly believe it was a UFO."
