

# University Professor Claims Overwhelming Evidence Shows UFOs Are Intelligently Guided

"I sincerely wish Flying Saucers and other unidentified flying objects didn't exist because they worry me, but there is overwhelming evidence that forces me to believe in them," says a Canadian university professor.

Dr. P.M.H. Edwards, 56, who is also adviser to the Aerial Phenomena Research Organization of Tucson, Ariz., told The ENQUIRER:

"My fears center on the thousands of unexplained disappearances of people each year.

"Are we being used for dissection or other biological purposes? Are we being put in a zoo somewhere? Are we being used for meat?"

Dr. Edwards, who is a professor of linguistics and modern languages at the Univer-

sity of Victoria, in British Columbia, said he cannot ignore UFOs because as a student, he was warned by a professor not to laugh at an idea until he knew something about it.

Dr. Edwards began investigating, and, becoming convinced that UFOs exist, continued his studies and today considers himself an authority on the subject.

"There are sightings all the time," he declared. "In addition, we also have close to 1,000 cases where UFO occupants were seen either inside or near the vehicles. With so many cases, it's nearly unthinkable that they would all be unreliable.

"How can we foolishly keep attributing UFO sightings to mistaken identification of air-

craft, satellites or natural phenomena when we know that UFOs perform feats that no man-made objects or natural phenomena ever perform? Optical illusions? Then why don't we suffer from optical illusions when we're looking at other objects?"

Dr. Edwards said, "We all have a feeling that we are the highest creatures in the universe.

"We don't want to believe there are any beings smarter than we are. It's this attitude that's responsible for our not solving the UFO enigma.

"Of course, this field is a happy hunting ground for kooks and opportunists, but we mustn't let kooks obscure the facts."

Dr. Edwards admitted he

has never seen a UFO. "But then I've never seen a murder committed either. A large and reliable number of people have seen both.


"Why should I accept their evidence that murders are committed but reject that of having seen a UFO?"

"We know a great deal about their maneuvers and this evidence is enough to convince even the most hardened skeptic that they are intelligently guided," Dr. Edwards maintained.

"For a number of years they have been seen to follow trains, planes and cars, and to hover over airfields.

"Then it was cross-country power lines and radio and TV installations.

"Recently they became very

interested in our children, their schools and playgrounds, and in hospitals, including the children's wards.

"We don't know the reasons behind all this — and that worries me," said Dr. Edwards.
