Experts on terrorism and n-clear weapons, author Steve Quayle and Shane Conner of KI4U, Inc. discussed the reality of nuclear terrorism and how we can protect ourselves. Quayle said that there could be as many as 4-5 dozen terrorist nuclear weapons within the U.S., and he warned that the anniversary date of the bombing on Hiroshima, August 6th, might be a time of an attack, since bin Laden has referred to "an American Hiroshima." According to Quayle's sources, the cities of Atlanta, Beaumont, TX; Boston, Chicago, Houston, Las Vegas, Los Angeles, Miami, New York, Philadelphia, Phoenix, Seattle, and Washington have been possibly targeted by al-Qaeda nuclear weapons. He has prepared a set of web links related to this topic. Conner believes the US government has dropped the ball by not offering enough civil defense training to citizens. The rate of survivability is good after an attack, but only if people protect themselves from the fallout, he said. For instance, if someone sees a mu...

Steve Quayle shared an update on terrorism and spoke about his newest book, Lucifer's Luggage: Suitcase Nukes in America. He said his book is in response to the duplicity of information that has been given out to the public, and that even though you don't hear about it in mainstream media, terrorists' nuclear weapons are already here in the US. The arrival of such weapons on American soil is the result of a "catastrophic intelligence failure," Quayle commented. One such weapon, he detailed, is "red mercury" which kills by intense radiation exposure and was produced by the Russians to be as small as a softball. The Russian military hero, Alexander Lbed, was killed because he had knowledge of the operatives who sold suitcase nukes and the locations where they were sent, said Quayle. The weapons are followed by a "technician" who keeps them "fit for firing," he added. Iran might be behind some of the nukes, yet they in turn could be puppets of the "international global elite ...

"Prophecy, Popes & the Antichrist"

John Hogue, an expert on Nostradamus and the prophetic traditions of the world, returned to the show to discuss prophecies related to the Popes, Fatima and the Antichrist. The 12th century Irish seer St. Malachy prophesied a list of the Pope's names, that is over 80% accurate, he said.

Containing only two more names after John Paul II, the list may actually have been written by a mysterious person in the 1590's using Malachy's name, Hogue shared.

While reaching the end of Pope list may mean we are nearing the "great chastisement," such end times ideations can become a self-fulfilling prophecy, in which people create a destiny based on their programmed beliefs, said Hogue. It's uncertain whether the third secret of Fatima was ever truly revealed, though Hogue suggested the version that Cardinal Ratzinger released in 1960, which he interpreted as describing a cataclysmic outcome to the Cuban missile crisis, may have been it. "Cell Phone Dangers"

Researcher William Thomas presented his investigation into the health dangers of cell phones. "It's the most dangerous personal device ever invented," he declared, comparing cell phone use to smoking. He also cited dangers from cell phone towers which are irradiating everyone with "electromagnetic smog."

The main problem from the phones is not heat absorption (which is regulated by testing) but the microwave pulses which can cause disruption to human cells, Thomas noted. This can lead in the short term to headaches and sleep problems and in the long term to brain cancer, leukemia, and autoimmune disease, he detailed. Thomas estimated that in about 5-8 years, we will likely see more instances of these serious illnesses as the long range damage sets in.

Using a headset doesn't alleviate the problem as the cord acts as an antenna which still irradiates the user, he said. Additionally, portable home phones that operate in the gigahertz range (2.4 AC 5.6) are also a health risk, T ...

In this special program three different guests weighed in on the disaster that occurred after the Sumatra quake. In the first hour volcanologist R.B. Trombley of SWVRC discussed the underpinnings of earthquakes and tsunamis. "The Earth is a living, dynamic planet," and as such it is a natural phenomenon for tectonic plates to move. The Sumatra quake was set off when the 620 mile boundary of the Euro-Asian plate shifted, he said. In Hour 2, author Steve Quayle noted that Stan Deyo had correctly foreseen the possibility of a quake near Indonesia and had posted diagrams related to it. Deyo reportedly said he had never seen such pressure building up on the plates, and there could yet be a domino effect where more large quakes occur in other areas, such as America's West Coast. Quayle also pointed out that two Indian scholars had also predicted the Indonesian quake, though at a lesser magnitude. Author Stuart Wilde shared visions of disaster in the third hour. Douglas Hagmann of the Northeast Intelligence Network and author Steve Quayle joined together for a discussion on terrorism, globalism, and the 9-11 attack.

Quayle commented that while the U.S. has done an excellent job of preventing further terrorist acts on our soil, America is rapidly becoming the victim of economic terrorism. As the dollar's value continues to plummet, he noted that countries such as China, Russia and India are participating in an "orchestrated sell off" of the U.S. currency. "I think 2005 is going to be a critical year," Hagmann stated. He sees a "festering hatred" brewing among Muslim populations alienated by America's foreign policy and he advocated learning to "think like them" in order to understand and predict their behavior. The United States has become a "pariah nation" said Quayle, "checkmated" by countries like China and Russia. But there's a bigger "dialectic" at work he outlined-- a "globalist" agenda in which America could end up being milit ...
