3,500 Evacuate as Volcano Erupts in Southern Chile

One of the volcanos in the Cordon of southern Chile erupted violently Saturday, billowing smoke and ash high into the sky and prompting more than 3,500 people living nearby to evacuate. Authorities initially said the Puyehue

volcano was involved, but later said the eruption was occurring about 2 miles from that peak. A rift more than six miles long and three miles across

was torn in the earth's crust.

The National Emergency Office said it recorded an average of 230 tremors an hour.
