Thanks for your card. I'm honoured to be in the CSAR Directory of Consultants, and look forward to further developments.

Interested to hear that you are planning a summer visit to England. I'm afraid that neither of us will be at Cambridge. We are not able to travel much at the moment because we have to look after Colin's 90-year-old mother who lives with us. But if you are thinking of doing any travelling in Britain apart from the London and Cambridge areas, we would very much like to see you over here in Montgomery. Unfortunately we don't have sufficient room to offer you a bed, but there are good accommodation facilities in the town. It's really a town in name only, having a population of around 1,000, but it's a very historic place and was an important centre in the past. There is a ruined castle, Georgian houses and other interesting buildings, and lovely scenery. Montgomery is actually on the Welsh border, west of Birmingham and about 200 miles north-west of London. It's easy to reach by car, or there is an adequate rail service as far as Shrewsbury, which is 20 miles away and we then collect visitors from the railway station there, as the bus service to Montgomery is infrequent.

Anyway, do bear us in mind when you are planning your itinerary, and let us know if you are able to fit us in.

Our BIGFOOT CASEBOOK is due out any minute now from Stackpole Books, and I will ask them to send you a review copy. They also did a U.S. hardback edition of ALIEN ANIMALS last autumn, to be followed by a paperback this autumn, and I will ask them to send you a review copy of that too. Possibly EARTH RITES might also be of interest to you, and I will ask our U.K. publisher to send you a copy.

Dear Janet Bord,


