Frightened, the children ran away and reached a nearby gas bar, but noticed the creature looking at them from behind a fence. Hysterical, the children ran home.

Their parents could not calm the children down; they called the police and then took the children to a hospital where they were examined and released.

Investigation by RCMP suggested that the children had been following drunken partiers who had decided to scare the children.

1. At 23:30 hrs. Thompson RCMP received a complaint from c/n's mother, of a possible UFO in Deerwood Park. The complainant stated that her son and daughter as well as a neighbour's daughter had just entered Deerwood Park from Caribou Road when they saw lights moving all around them, lights shining on the ground around them and in the trees around them. The lights were pale blue in colour. The kids, all aged 12 years, continued down the emergency pathway they were on until they reached a large snow hill, approximately 100 to 150 feet into the park. The snow hills were man-made as part of the City snow removal system. As they approached this hill they noticed a bright light at the top of the hill (in the sky). As the light was turned off they saw a large being standing on the top of the hill. The being as described by was approximately 8 feet tall, hairy all over, with a bony torso and large legs and feet. The being was also said to have red glowing eyes. The hair on the being was described as something like a bear would have. With at the scene was and

lives at . C/n went on to say that when they saw this being, they became frightened and started running away. The being descended the hill and started chasing them. The children said that they ran to a Shell Gas Bar, which is within sight of the park, and told a clerk of their encounter. The clerk

stepped out of the building and looked for the being but could not see it. She then went back into the gas bar. The children then stepped out and they said they saw it peering at them from behind a fence. At that point they ran further into town and then finally back home. The complainant was told to calm the children down first, then to get as much information from these children as possible before calling the police again.

2. At 00:05 hrs. Thompson RCMP received a call from the Thompson General Hospital stating that the parents of the a/n children had brought them in for treatment as they were hysterical with fright and that the parents could not calm them down. The admitting nurse basically witnessed what had already been stated. Two members of the Thompson RCMP attended the hospital and it was decided that they would go back to the park with \_\_\_\_\_ and his father so that \_\_\_\_\_ could show what had happened. Once there, further information was revealed showing that the children had followed 3 to 4 intoxicated males, carrying beer, into the park. \_\_\_\_\_ stated that one of the males turned to him and said, "you better watch out up ahead." The 3 to 4 males then disappeared and moments later the children saw the monster on top of the hill. Ryan stated that the males were carrying beer and police found an empty beer bottle on top of the hill, at the point where the monster was supposed to have been standing. After examination, the children were released to their parents in a much calmer mood.

3. At 21:00 hrs. a statement was taken from \_\_\_\_\_ while he was in attendance at the Thompson Detachment. The statement basically covered all the same points as outlined in the original complaint. \_\_\_\_\_ stated that there were 4 to 5 males in the park as opposed to his earlier comment of 3 to 4 males.

4. At 21:40 hrs. a statement was taken from \_\_\_\_\_ while she was in attendance at the Thompson Detachment. She basically reiterated the original complaint, however she did say that she never got a good look at the monster while in the park but only a glimpse of something while back at the gas bar. It is felt that the panic and fear as shown by \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ transferred onto \_\_\_\_\_. \_\_\_\_\_ was frightened and ran away from something she never really saw.

- 6) THE CHILDREN HAD BEEN TO THE MOVIES, (THEY SAW "STOP OR MY MOTHER WILL SHOOT"), AND HAD BEEN OUT LATER THEN THEY WERE SUPPOSE TO HAVE BEEN. THEY MAY HAVE FABRICATED THE STORY TO STAY OUT OF TROUBLE.

ALSO THE CHILDREN DID TELL POLICE THAT THEY FOLLOWED FOUR TO SIX DRUNKEN MALES INTO THE PARK. ONE OF THE MALES STOPPED AND TURNED, TELLING THE CHILDREN TO BE CAREFUL. IN ANY CASE, POLICE FEEL THAT THE CHILDREN'S STORY IS PART IMAGINATION AND PART FABRICATION.

Immediately, they saw a brilliant flash in the southwest, as if something had crashed. The light was white, like a fluorescent light, and had been "harsh" to the eyes.

On 4 April 1992, the principal witness was flown over the "crash site" by the RCMP, but nothing was observed.

The night of April 1 - 2, 1992 was calm with excellent visibility as my friend and I drove north of Neepawa, Manitoba on Provincial Highway # 5 to Dauphin. Traffic was light as we drove along drinking Coca Cola and chatting. We believe we were only a few kilometers north of Neepawa when we noticed a peculiar vehicle approximately 500 - 700 m ahead of us on the highway proceeding north. At first one would assume it was the back end of a "semi" as it was bedecked with red lights, but it was different. Rather than having a rectangular or squarish conformation with small red lights around the periphery of the "back", it was triangular with large lights and excessive numbers of them, almost filling the entire triangle. I remarked to that it looked like a Christmas tree.

We gave the observation little thought as we talked. I do not recall whether this vehicle disappeared and then reappeared or remained on the highway, but about 6 or 7 km south of the Laurier turn off, we encountered it again, this time at close range. There was no actual "back" to this vehicle, no licence plates and no wheels that we could see. I assumed it was a set of farm harrows or a cultivator with the "wings" drawn up and that the farmer had assembled this arrangement of lights because he/she was driving on the highway at night. About 15 minutes, we concurred, elapsed from the time of our initial sighting and when we caught up to this "vehicle". We cannot account for the fact that we covered approximately 70 km (from "a few" km north of Neepawa to 6 or 7 km south of the Laurier turn off) in 15 minutes. But we are not absolutely positive about our location on Highway # 5 at the time of the initial sighting. Neither of us recalled going past McCreary.


I wanted to pass this "thing" as it was traveling at only about 70 KPH, but it was encroaching on the left lane by a meter or more. I noted the red illumination on the surface of the pavement, especially below the left corner. The width at the base of this triangular moving assemblage of lights almost reached the edge of the pavement on the right and was estimated to be about 4 meters in height. It looked like a neon sign. The intensity of these red lights was comparable to that given off by the tail lights of any conventional vehicle at night.

Imperceptibly the "vehicle" closed the distance between it and my 1990 GMC truck to within 10 m. I thought it was even closer. At least some of the lights were blinking on and off and most prominent were 3 elongated pairs each about a meter long and .2 m in width positioned vertically at each of the three corners of the triangle (Figure 1.) The top and left pairs blinked alternately, I am not sure about the pair in the right corner. The other lights which were of various shapes were estimated to be 15 or 25 cm in diameter or width. The only other component of this assemblage that was observed was a dark cylindrical or piece of material (metal ?) perhaps 15 centimeters long and 2 or 3 cm in diameter (Figure 1). These lights were observed at close range for no more than 3 or 4 seconds. The "vehicle", which emitted no audible sounds, seemed to float along about .5 m above the pavement. In retrospect, it seemed odd that at the time, I didn't suspect something strange.

Instantly these red lights went out and there was nothing there. I quickly put on my brights, but we saw nothing. No light or fire or anything suggestive that the thing took flight, could be seen. It simply vanished before us. It was at this point that we realized that we had witnessed something unusual - a U.F.O. or a U.V.O. (Unidentified vanishing object). It was truly, the only incredible event either of us had ever seen. Literally it had, apparently, defied the known laws of Science. Within

our knowledge of the laws of Physics, this was not natural, it was supernatural. Waves of "goose bumps" raced through us. The time was 12:18 A.M.

At approximately 12:45 A.M. and about 45 kilometers up the road we approached the CNR crossing just southeast of the Village of Ochre River. When <sup>1300</sup>~~600~~ or ~~700~~ meters east of this crossing, we saw 2 large circular red lights probably a meter or less apart on the right shoulder of the highway some 200 meters ahead of us. Concurrently a freight train was moving northwest at the crossing which was known to have 3 sets of red lights; one set directed down the right lane of the highway, one set directed down the left lane and one set above. We could not see the railroad-crossing lights on the right, perhaps because they were obstructed from our view by the 2 closer intervening lights which did not blink. The railroad-crossing lights above did not work and the "lights" on the left consisted only of a single tiny red light that alternately "blinked" on and off as the railroad cars went by, temporarily obstructing our view of it. In the late evening of April 4 we approached the same crossing from the east when a northwest bound train passed through, simulating the situation of April 2. Upon actually observing the functioning railroad crossing lights from the same distance, we confirmed our belief that the intervening lights were at least twice as large taking into account the fact that they were only about 200 m from us and the crossing lights about 700 m. The CNR subsequently inspected the crossing lights upon our request and found them to be functional. They had no explanation as to why they had not worked properly in the early hours of April 2. Although I know very little about U.F.O.s I was of the understanding that they can interfere with electrical systems. My truck was not affected.

is a Dauphin - Ochre River School Division teacher and colleague who lives less than 100 m from the railroad crossing and east-west orientated Highway # 5. Mr. \_\_\_\_\_ was in bed around 1 A.M. April 2 (he says it easily could have been 12:45 A.M.), when an exceptionally bright white light shone into his bedroom, the window of which faces west. The light was much brighter than what normally emanates from east-bound vehicles at night. Mr. \_\_\_\_\_ did not get up to observe the source of the light. He heard no sounds, however his bedroom window was shut. It was June when I learned of this bright light seen by \_\_\_\_\_ .

We slowed down as we approached what appeared to be a road block with several bright white lights shining down the highway toward us, the 2 big red lights were still on the right shoulder. Both of us thought that several vehicles were involved in this apparent road block as indicated by the lights. Could the white lights have been the same as those experienced by \_\_\_\_\_ ? The timing was right. The red lights were positioned a short distance to the east of a small bridge on the highway. Two reflector posts guarded either side of the bridge railings. As we got closer we were astonished to see there were no vehicles coming or going! Inordinately bright white light shone from the reflectors and an atmosphere of unparalleled power and authority, in our experiences, shone from these lights. The gravity of the situation was of an intensity beyond my ability to describe it. Incredibly, all 4 lights from the reflectors or from a point just in front of them seemed to be directing us to the 2 big red lights! \_\_\_\_\_ was praying, her head now below the dash. We didn't stop and all seemed to vanish as we passed by. Synchronously, the train past the crossing as we past the "road block" so no red light would be expected from <sup>the</sup> crossing which we then approached.
