THE A/N IS A NATIVE SUMMER STUDENT WITH THE HIGH PRAIRIE R.C.M.P. DETACHMENT. ON THIS DATE AT APPROX. 2230HRS HE WAS WEST BOUND ON HWY #2 4-5 KM EAST OF HIGH PRAIRIE IN A POLICE MOTOR VEHICLE WHEN HE SPOTTED SOME STRANG LIGHTS IN THE SKY. HE DESCRIBED THE LIGHTS AS YELLOW, GREEN AND RED IN A TRIANGULAR FORMATION. THE LIGHTS APPROACHED THE HWY FROM THE SOUTH AND WERE QUITE BRIGHT. AS THEY PASSED OVER THE HIGHWAY THEY DIMMED AND THEN GOT BRIGHT AGAIN AS THEY MOVED ON. [REDACTED] DESCRIBED THE OBJECT AS TRAVELLING AT AN EXTREAMLY FAST RATE OF SPEED. TOO FAST FOR A CONVENTIONAL AIRCRAFT. THE OBJECT WAS LAST SEEN HEADING NORTH TOWARDS THE PEAVINE METIS SETTLEMENT. [REDACTED] NOTES THAT OTHER DRIVERS ATTENTION WERE DRAWN TO THIS OBJECT AS WELL. ALL THE VEHICLES ON THE HWY AT THE TIME SLOWED DOWN TO TAKE A LOOK.
