I wish to report the sighting of an unidentified flying object which appeared over the skies of North Vancouver at 9.55 pm Pacific time on the evening of April 30/1994

On clear nights it is my custom to stand on my patio for a while after darkness has fallen and try to recognize the more common constellations and watch for meteorite showers etc. I have done this for over sixty years and enjoyed and marvelled at the spectacle. Sometimes I see the new satellites but never before have I seen anything like this.

The object was of triangular shape such as an arrowhead, but slightly elongated so the front portion was further apart from the back portion than the width of the back portion. It consisted of three very bright orange-yellow lights with a dark mass in between like this :-
