AT APPROXIMATELY 2120 HRS, ON 94.05.10, [REDACTED] WAS TRAVELLING IN HER VEHICLE SOUTHBOUND ON 200 STREET IN THE AREA OF 18 AVENUE IN LANGLEY. SHE STATES THAT TWO "STARS" CAME DOWN AND FOLLOWED HER VEHICLE. SHE STATES THAT SHE SAW THREE AIRPLANES CHASING THE STARS. SHE BECAME SCARED AND PULLED INTO A DRIVEWAY IN THE AREA OF 3RD AVENUE AND 212 STREET, AND TURNED HER VEHICLE LIGHTS OFF. THE STARS ASCENDED WITH THE THREE PLANES IN PURSUIT.

THE SKY CONDITIONS WERE CLEAR THIS EVENING. WITNESS DID NOT MENTION ANY SOUND, AND THE DURATION WAS POSSIBLY ABOUT 5 MINUTES MAXIMUM.

CHECKS WITH THE LOCAL AIRPORTS NEGATIVE. THEY HAD NOT RECEIVED ANY REPORTS FROM THE DND OF ANY ACTIVITY EITHER.
