


On 94-06-07 Gimli, Manitoba R.C.M.P. Detachment received a report of a U.F.O. sighting that occurred at approximately 03:30 hrs. this date. The sighting occurred approximately two miles north and three and one half miles west of the Town of Gimli, Manitoba. Two persons saw the object for approximately three minutes. They saw a large donut shaped object that they estimated to be between three hundred and four hundred feet in diameter. The object was white light in color and had between nine and twelve flashing and/or pulsating lights running evenly around its circumference. The persons estimated it to be between five hundred and fifteen hundred feet in altitude and it was flying in an easterly direction (towards Lake Winnipeg). They said the object was slow moving and described it as being moderate in brightness. The sky was partly cloudy at the time of the sighting.

The object was seen by [REDACTED] and his wife, [REDACTED], who live at [REDACTED] Rural Municipality of Gimli, Manitoba.
