WHITE WITH A TRACE OF RED IN THE FINAL BURNOUT G. A SINGLE METEOR
WITH A LONG TAIL, NOT FRAGMENTED; WIDTH ABOUT A QUARTER THE DIAMETER
OF THE FULL MOON H. APPROXIMATELY 3-4 SECONDS I. NIL J. APPROXIMATELY
15 DEGREES ABOVE THE HORIZON MOVING FROM NORTH-NORTH-EAST TO WEST-
SOUTH-WEST K. APPEARED TO BE VERY CLOSE TO THE STATION, POSSIBLY WHY
THIS METEOR SEEMED TO BE SO LARGE.
