Patrol to [redacted] He explained that he first noticed it in the south east sky at approx 5:55 AM. He first thought it was a plane but noticed it wasn't moving. He and his partner [redacted] watched it (off and on) from then until 6:40 AM when it disappeared. [redacted] drew a picture of it and it is attached. The outer edges on both sides were a bright blue in color. The inside two circles would change colors from white to orange to blue. There was also an object off to the right of the main object that he could not describe as he couldn't see it but that object would flash indiscriminately a bright white flash. The object was described as " Huge " but he could not say how far away it was, possibly a few miles, possibly 5-6 miles. The object made no noise and was at approx., a 45 degree angle in the sky to them. The object would only move in a horizontal or vertical motion, very fast and stop suddenly. Sky was clear at the time.
