WERE STOPPED HAVING A FEW BEER WEST OF MEADOW LAKE SASK. THEY HAD
PARKED AT THE NESSET LAKE RECREATIONAL AREA, A SMALL LAKE ENCLOSED BY DENSE
BUSH. AT APPROX. 2245HRS. ON 94-09-27 THEY OBSERVED SEVERAL BRIGHT LIGHTS IN
THE BUSH WHICH WERE WAVING. THE LIGHTS MOVED BACK AND FORTH AND THEN WERE A
MONG THE TREES AND REMAINED IN THAT POSITION. BOTH [REDACTED] AND [REDACTED] GOT OUT OF

THEIR VEHICLE TO INVESTIGATE AND HEARD ONLY THE LOCAL LAKE GEESE. AND THE SOUND
OF THE EVENING WIND IN THE BUSH. THE SKY WAS MOSTLY CLEAR WITH A SMALL AMOUNT OF
CLOUDS AND THE MOON WAS BRIGHT IN THE SKY. THE SIGHTING LASTED APPROXIMATELY 1/2
HOUR AT WHICH THE TWO CASUALLY FINISHED THEIR BEER AND THEN DEPARTED. NOTHING
UNUSUAL OCCURRED WHEN THEY STARTED THEIR CAR TO LEAVE.

IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT SEVERAL HUNTERS ARE IN THE AREA, AS WELL AS NATIVE PEOPLE
WHO HUNT AT NIGHT AND WHAT THESE TWO PEOPLE MAY HAVE SEEN WAS NIGHT HUNTERS
USING SPOT LIGHTS AND THEN SEEING THE TWO TRIED TO FRIGHTEN THEM.
