U.F.O. SIGHTING.

SUBJECTS REPORTS SEEING A LIGHT IN THE SKY HOVERING OVER HWY. # THREE APPROX. 5 TO 8 KMS WEST OF BELSOTTE SASK. HE WAS IN HIS CAR GOING WEST AT ABOUT 100 KMS PER HOUR. THERE WAS ANOTHER CAR ABOUT 1/2 A KM. AHEAD OF HIM. HE HAD THE LIGHT IN SIGHT FOR ABOUT 4 KMS. HE DESCRIBES IT AS A WHITE LIGHT ABOUT 2 FEET ACROSS. IT HOVERED OVER THE VEHICLE AHEAD OF HIM. AT FIRST HE BELIEVED THE LIGHT WAS THAT FROM AN ONCOMING VEHICLE HOWEVER IT NEVER GOT ANY CLOSER. AT ONE POINT IT WENT HIGH UP IN THE AIR AND HE THOUGHT THAT IT MAY HAVE BEEN A VEHICLE P ON A HIGH HILL HOWEVER THERE ARE NO HILLS AT THAT POINT. THE LIGHT HOVERED ABOVE THE VEHICLE INFRONT OF HIM. FROM TIME TO TIME IT WOULD WOBBLE FROM SIDE TO SIDE. THE LIGHT MAINTAINED A CONSTANT INTENSITY. NO COLOR (WHITE LIGHT). HE SAW THE LIGHT FOR ABOUT 3 OR 4 MINUTES. THIS WAS AT 2000 HRS ON SATURDAY 94-10-01. ANY OTHER WITNESS ARE UNKNOWN. IT WAS CLOUDY AT THE TIME. HE IS CERTAIN THAT THE LIGHT WAS NOT GLARE.
