PLEASE BE ADVISED THAT ON NOVEMBER 12, 1994 AT APPROX. 2200HRS THE [REDACTED] WERE SOUTH BOUND ON HIGHWAY 19 FROM COURTENAY, BC, WHEN THEY OBSERVED A WHITE LIGHT STEAK ACROSS THE SKY TOWARDS THE GROUND. THE [REDACTED] STATE THAT AS IT GOT CLOSER TO THE EARTH IT CHANGED FROM WHITE IN COLOR TO ORANGE. THEY STATE THEY DID NOT SEE IT HIT THE GROUND ANYWHERE AS IT DISAPPEARED BEHIND SOME TREES.

- 1) DURATION OF SIGHTING - THREE TO FOUR SECONDS
- 2) DESCRIPTION - A LIGHT, WHITE AND THEN ORANGE, ALTITUDE UNKNOWN, ONE IN NUMBER, APPEARED BRIGHTER THAN A NORMAL STAR, NO SOUND REPORTED.
- 3) CONDITION OF SKY - CLEAR, DARK, AS THEY DROVE THEY ENTERED VERY THICK FOG.
