UFO SIGHTING [REDACTED] 20 NOV 94

1. Mr [REDACTED] called me this morning to report a UFO sighting. I am forwarding this information to NDIC for follow-up. I do not know [REDACTED] well, he is my insurance broker. He is young, single, apparently reliable and observant, with an excellent memory. I have no reason to doubt his sincerity in making this report.

2. [REDACTED] was driving east in his vehicle on Hwy 417 early Sunday morning, returning home from Ottawa. At 0523 hrs, as he approached the Limoges exit, he saw "a lot of lights" on his right side, about "1000 feet" away, just ahead of him, at tree top level. At first he thought it was "a plane", but discarded that thought as it had too many lights and did not behave like a plane. The object maintained its distance, and continued to travel just ahead of [REDACTED] at the same speed (120 km/hr). [REDACTED] occasionally lost sight of the object due to the treetops, for up to 10 seconds. The object reappeared once on the left side of the highway near the Concession 5 crossing, but was on the right side the rest of the time. It was not observed to cross the highway. At one point the object slowed down, and [REDACTED] also slowed down to 80 km/hr to avoid overtaking it. Following this the object disappeared briefly.

3. At 0529, [REDACTED] regained visual contact with the object, which he described as waiting for him on the ~~left (north)~~ **RIGHT SIDE** side of the highway, hovering in a field near the Casselman exit at roughly the height of a telephone pole. [REDACTED] exited from the highway at this time, and manoeuvred his vehicle to shine his headlights on the object. He flashed his "brights", but the object did not appear to react. [REDACTED] followed the object for approximately one kilometre and the object again paralleled his path and speed, travelling behind houses and buildings about "two football fields" away. He then stopped to observe the object, but when it appeared to approach him, [REDACTED] drove home. As [REDACTED] drove home, he lost sight of the object. He arrived home at 0535 hrs, and when he left his car and garage, observed the object nearby, close to the exit off the highway. From 0535 hrs to 0700 hrs, [REDACTED] observed the object about **TWO** "half a kilometre away", from his vehicle, from his garage, from inside his house, and through binoculars. [REDACTED] also took 18 pictures from a camera mounted on a tripod, at varying
