


exposures. (At 0700 HRS, [REDACTED] WENT TO BED.)

4. [REDACTED] was unable to discern an overall shape or identify aerodynamic surfaces such as wings, but he described two small "V" shapes at what he thought might have been a trailing end. He observed many lights which were "like spotlights" but which "didn't light up the ground or his car". The lights were white and shone "in all directions". [REDACTED] rolled down his window, shut off his car and radio, but couldn't hear or smell anything. There was no indication of exhaust, wind, or heat from the object. He thought at one point he may have heard a humming sound, but couldn't associate it with the object. Twice, through binoculars, the object was observed to "tip over", and [REDACTED] observed lights on the bottom side.

5. [REDACTED] saw two other vehicles on Hwy 417, and one on the secondary road while he was stopped, but they gave no indication they had observed the object. [REDACTED] also saw, and heard, an aircraft fly overhead the object while he, and it, were stopped in the field, but there was no discernable reaction from either the aircraft or the object to the other's presence. Upon returning home, [REDACTED] awoke his parents, who went outside to look at the object with him, and observed it both with binoculars and a camera. His mother stated that she had seen the same object in the same area the evening before, watching it for a about one minute as it travelled east at about the speed of the traffic, at a "very low altitude". At that time, she had commented to her husband that there was an aircraft low over the field. Her husband, who had been watching television, did not get up to look at the aircraft. He did observe that the "TV set went out" later, around 2000-2100 hrs.
