A FIREBALL SIGHTING WAS REPORTED IN OUR DETACHMENT AREA.

ON DECEMBER 6TH 1994 AT APROXIMATLY 22:30 HRS [REDACTED]

ATTENDED THE LYNN LAKE DETACHMENT AND REPORTED THAT WHILE THEY WERE
TRAVELING FROM THOMPSON MANITOBA TO LYNN LAKE MANITOBA BY PRIVATE VEHI
CLE ON PTH #391 N. AT APPROXIMATLY MILE 30 FROM LYNN LAKE @ 21:45 HRS
BOTH OCCUPANTS OBSERVED A BRIGHT WHITE FLASH IN THE SKY, NO SOUND WAS
NOTED.

APPROXIMATLY 20 MINUTES LATER AT MILE 15 FROM LYNN LAKE A GREEN
COLORED FIRE BALL WAS OBSERVED FALLING IN A NORTHERLY DIRECTION
THE OBJECT APPEARED TO BE FALLING SLOWLY. NO SOUNDS NOTED.
A SHORT DISTANCE FURTHER THEY STOPPED THE VEHICLE NEAR A MUSKEG AREA
AND COULD OBSERVE A GREEN GLOW IN THE NORTHER HEMISFERE. NO SOUNDS
WERE NOTED.

AT THE TIME OF THE OBSERVATION THE SKY WAS CLEAR, COLD. SOME
METEORITES WERE SEEN IN AREA BE NOTED OBSERVERS, AND VERY ACTIVE
AURORA BOREALIS.

AT THE TIME THAT THE NOTED OBSERVERS WERE MAKING THEIR REPORT
A STRONG ODOUR OF A CANIBUS SUBSTANCE COULD BE SMELLED.
