ON THE 7TH DEC 1994 TWO ADULT MALES REPORTED SEEING A METEOR OR WHAT THEY BELIEVE TO BE A METEOR STRIKE THE EARTH IN THE SLAVE LAKE ALBERTA AREA. THE SIGHTING TOOK PLACE LAST NIGHT 6 DEC 1994 AT APPROX 11:30 PM AND LASTED APPROX 3 SECONDS. THEY DESCRIBE A REDISH BALL WITH AN ULTRA VIOLET GREEN-BLUIISH TAIL WITH A LONGER WHITE TAIL BEHIND THAT. EXTREMELY BRIGHT AND EVEN BRIGHTER WHEN IT STRUCK THE EARTH. THE SKY WAS VERY CLEAR WITH LOTS OF STARS VISIBLE. ONE WITNESS ESTIMATES METEOR INITIALLY SIGHTED ABOUT THE HEIGHT OF A SINGLE ENGINE AIRCRAFT AND ONE SAYS IT STRUCK EARTH IN A WOODED AREA 1/2 MILE TO 1 MILE NORTH OF HWY 2. THE OTHER WIT SAYS IT COULD HAVE STRUCK UP TO 50 MILES AWAY.
