


STATEMENT OF: [REDACTED]

Slave Lake AB  
9:40 pm.

It was on the 6th day of December of 1994. A friend, [REDACTED] and I were traveling from High prairie to Slave lake. Between Drift pile reserve and Faust around the half way mark. (that would be eastbound on highway 2.) We then were shocked to see a light in the sky. It appeared to be a falling star at first. but observing closer it turned to have crashed to the ground with a flash of light so bright it lit up the whole sky behind the roadside bush. The discription of this object would be a ball of fire with a tail the color would be almost ultra violet. The ball would be a bright white and yellowish. With the tail being the same color with a touch of blue inside (some what the affect of a cutting torch). the object fell at a forty five degree angle at a tremendous speed. the sighting lasted for at least 3 seconds. The [REDACTED] time would be around 11:30 pm Dec 6. when the sighting occurred. I estimate the meteor to be at least fifty mile away. when it crashed.
