Re: Possible U.F.O. Sighting

On December 12, 1994 at 10 p.m. Constable D.R. Brecknell received a complaint from a male Whistler Resident [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] said he could see a U.F.O. above Blackcomb Mountain which is located near Whistler, B.C. [REDACTED] said that he and two of his friends could see the U.F.O. above the mountains near Whistler. [REDACTED] said it appeared to be round and was hovering over the mountains. It had flashing lights which appeared to be oscillating. [REDACTED] said it did not appear to be moving, just hovering.

Constable Brecknell could see something in the air space above and between Blackcomb Mountain and Whistler Mountain. It appeared to be red, blue and yellow flashing lights, stationary and hovering in the sky. Lights were similar to those of an aircraft's lights. The sky was clear, the object was well above the two Mountains which are approximately 6800' elevation. No sound could be heard.
