PLEASE BE ADVISED THAT OUR DETACHMENT RECEIVED A COMPLAINT FROM THE ABOVE CAPTIONED INDIVIDUAL. HE AND HIS MOTHER [REDACTED] SAW AN UNIDENTIFIED OBJECT IN THE SKY OVER THE [REDACTED] AREA ON 05-01-95, THEN AGAIN THE NEXT NIGHT, 05-01-95. BOTH SIGHTINGS WERE CONSISTENT AS FAR AS POSITION AND DESCRIPTION ARE CONCERNED.

THE OBJECT WAS SEEN FROM THE [REDACTED] HOME AT [REDACTED] MARNOCK BAY, B.C., TEL. [REDACTED]. THE OBJECT WAS STATIONARY AND LASTED FOR SEVERAL MINUTES IF NOT HOURS.

THE OBJECT WAS DESCRIBED BY THE [REDACTED] AS A BLUE DISC, THE COLOR OF BLUE DISC AS THE SKY TAKES ON DURING A HOT SUMMER'S DAY. THERE WERE SEVERAL SMALL RED DISCS ALONG THE BOTTOM EDGE OF THE BLUE DISC. THERE WERE LIGHTS ALONG THE TOP OF THE DISC. A BRIGHT, BEAM OF LIGHT WAS SEEN MOVING ALONG AN EQUATORIAL AXIS ON THE BATH BLUE DISC OF THE OBJECT. THERE WAS NO SOUND EMITTED FROM THE OBJECT.

THE [REDACTED] DROVE AROUND THE MARNOCK AREA IN SEARCH A BETTER DESCRIPTION FOR THE POSITION OF THE OBJECT AFTER HAVING BELIEVED AT FIRST THAT IT WAS OVER CHASO BAY IN THE MARNOCK BAY AREA - THEY THEN VERIFIED THAT IT WAS OVER THE [REDACTED] AREA. THE OBJECT COULD BE SEEN WITH THE NAKED EYE. HOWEVER COLOR COULD ONLY BE DETERMINED WITH THE AID OF BINOCULARS.

THE SKY ON THE TWO NIGHTS WAS VERY CLEAR AND THE AIR CALM AND WARM, APPROX. -4 C. THE [REDACTED] APPEAR TO BE VERY REASONABLE AND WELL SPoken PEOPLE. BOTH ARE SOMEWHAT WORRIED BY THE NATURE OF THE COMPLAINT IN THAT THEY FEEL THAT THEY WILL NOT BE TAKEN SERIOUSLY.
