RE: R/O U.F.O. Sighting
 St. Theresa Point, Manitoba
 95-02-06

1. Unidentified Flying Object
2. 95-02-06. Reported at 01:08 a.m.
 Object located directly above St. Theresa Point, MB.
 Last observed at 08:00, on 95-02-06.
3. Circular object about 1000-2000 ft. Reflected light off
 it when spotlight shone on it. No lighting observed, nor
 any sounds heard.
4. The sky was hazy and it was snowing.
5. Apparently, upwards of 300 people were at scene, upon RCMP
 arrival, only about 100 persons remained.
6. Received a report the same day from Island Lake Weather Station.
 We were advised that a white balloon was released on 95-02-05
 at 11:12 a.m. The balloon was last observed going in a
 southerly direction, making it a very strong possibility of
 what was observed at St. Theresa Point. Believed by RCMP
 to have indeed been a weather balloon.
