7. OVER COURSE OF OBSERVATIONS, ONE OBJECT WAS ALL RED, ONE WAS METALLIC, ONE WAS RED, WHITE AND BLUE AND SEEMED TO BE SPINNING. ONE OBJECT SHOT OUT A RED FLASH OF LIGHT TO A STAR. IN ALL OCCURRENCES THERE WAS NO SOUND, NO TRAILS, AND LENGTH OF SIGHTINGS LASTED FROM SECONDS TO HOURS. ALL OBJECTS WERE SMALLER THAN STARS. AZIMUTHS VARIED FROM DIRECTLY OVERHEAD TO ALL POINTS ON COMPASS. SOME OBJECTS WENT FROM ONE END OF THE SKY TO THE OTHER IN A STRAIGHT COURSE.
