① . HE WAS CALLED OUT TO SANDY BAY RESERVE NW OF CANWOOD (APPR 40-50 MILES NW YPA) BY RESIDENTS TO REPORT A SAUCER SHAPED OBJECT IN THE SKY. IT WAS FIRST SEEN AT 11PM (0500Z) AND WAS LOW IN THE SKY DUE FAST, APPROXIMATELY THE SIZE OF 5-6 HOUSES. A RING OF PORTHOLES COULD BE SEEN AROUND IT WITH THE BRIGHTEST PORTHOLE IN THE CENTER. MIDDLE AREA WAS BLUE/GREEN, AND YELLOW WHERE THE PORTHOLES WERE. IT APPEARED TO BE SPINNING. BY 2AM IT MOVED SLOWLY TO THE SOUTH, DISAPPEARING FOR APPX 1/2 HOUR, IS FARTHER AWAY, HIGHER IN THE SKY AND NOW APPEARS STATIONARY. CONSTABLE BLIGHT SAYS NOW WITH THE NAKED EYE IT APPEARS AS A BRIGHT LIGHT, BUT THROUGH 10 POWER BINOCULARS HE CAN SEE THE COLORS IN IT.
