As far as the reference to Stoikes
on the top of the Todd Zechel - Art
Lundahl papers. I received those pages
from Zechel in 1982. Zechel never
did explain the Stoikes connection.

I got into touch with Bob Pratt concerning that Manuscript of his on Project Aquarius. He said his co-Author was William L. Moore. (Not Alvin Moore, as Wendelle Stevens thought). I asked for a copy - He said he would look around for one and get back with me later on it. (This was via a Telephone Conversation with him on Saturday Dec. 5, 87.) I asked him if he would like to go in with me on a book about Aquarius as Non-fiction. He said he would consider the possibility.

I got together with Robert Q Achzeiner of Costa Mesa, California, once again. Robert Achzeiner spent about 3 years working with Wilbert B. Smith, (1958-61). He has a piece of the huge Space debris which Smith and himself hauled in from the St. Lawrence River at low tide. He also has the Spectro-Analysis results of the metal of unknown origin. Dear Grant:

Please excuse me for not answering your correspondence sooner. Thank you very much for those letters from Rear Admiral Herbert B. Knowles to C.W. Fitch concerning UFO Physical evidence. Also that one from W.B. Smith to Fitch, concerning some type subject matter.

This just goes to show that Smith did gain access, somewhat, to the physical evidence. Now all we need is documentation proving that he did gain access to the entire recovered saucers and bodies.

I talked with Leonard Stringfield last Saturday; he verified that C.W. Fitch passed away a few years ago. I would like to know who has his

Files, letters, and research Notes, tapes, photos, etc. Maybe they are still at that place or in the hands of one of his children.

Did you see the proof in the form of a letter from Linda M. Howe of Littleton, Colorado, that the Aztec, N.M., and the Kingman, Arizona, crash/recoveries, were on the original "MJ-12 Presidential Briefing" Paper that Richard C. Doty showed William L. Moore and Peter Gersten at the 17th District office of A.O.S.I. on January 10, 1983. Also Linda Howe viewed the same version of "MJ-12" in April of 1983 through Richard C. Doty. This was all 18 months before Jamie Shander received the publicised version of "MJ-12" through the Mail as an undeveloped Roll of 35 mm film on Dec. 11, 1984, which only showed Roswell and Mexico as Saucer Crash/Recovery sites. Moore has been awful quiet on this, not a peep from him.

Did you see John Lear's Paper on The Project Aquarius + MJ-12 Stuff? John Lear is the Son of William Lear

the founder of the Lear Jet Corporation. John is now a Captain for a Major U.S. Airline company. His paper goes into detail telling of the Alliance that was set up between MJ-12 and some alleged Alien beings from elsewhere, the whys and wherefores pertaining to cattle mutilations, human abductions, implants, and etc, in relation to this alliance, and the attitude, now, of MJ-12 towards that alliance (regretful). He found out names of present day MJ-12 members

Received your letter of 18 NOV. 87. Many thanks for a quick return. I have enclosed a copy of Bob Peatts letter. He outlines the books he has written. You read this over and I will go along with whatever plan you think would work.

Could be a problem as to whether Moore would allow this to take place. As you can see Bob doesn't think much of all this stuff. He seems more interested in sighting reports. An example. When I was after the Dr. Eric Walker connection to Wilbert Smith, I liked him the fact that Walker was alive and involved with Bush & the RDB & the crashes. He didn't follow-up on it. Shortly after Steenman went after Walker and got the story. Bob's boss I suppose. He did not respond to the letter, and I haven't heard from him since.

I believe it was one of his reporters who had the story about Jackie Cleason seeing the bodies. I couldn't get any further information from the reporter on that either.

Just sent off my one shot at Mrs Smith regarding all the rumors surrounding Wilbert Smith. (eg) his connection with Bush, being shown a crashed saucer etc. She has offered to answer and goes back to Ottawa Dec 12, so I will know before then.

Could you give me more on the Alden Moore fragment? I am not familiar with this.

As to the Charlie - Red - Star photos. I have.

appet. I have the story although it is in a draft manuscript that I have misplaced (lost?) One other researcher here has a copy.

Have a number of photos in color and infra-red of the ground-lights (Smith called moniteers) I believe ~~we~~ have stories and dates.

Have the famous CK4 film and a 25 page review in the manuscript. Dr. Hynek called it the best night-time UFO film he had seen. At this point (approx. 77) I started to think he was a double agent as he failed to interview a single witness of 10¹⁰ (including 3 pilots, a newspaper editor) in three positions on the ground. He just got a copy of the film and ran. Rumored analysis was done by NASA.

Have a single photo I took which comes off the roll of film before the uncut 24 frames I sent you in the mid 70s (and never viewed.) This is I believe only one of two that turned out from the 24 taken.

I also believe there is one other good Charlie-Red-Star photo, but it is held by someone else. (I will check.)

Have also sent along a letter which is the source of the quote used by you and Sturman in the intro. You will note Smith states almost the same thing Walker stated about trying to obtain an official position being a "waste of time."

Also have a break on the AVRO-saucer deal. A researcher (who didn't know the significance of it) claims to have a letter from former Vice President Johnson referring him to Dr. Clarence Bush, in response to a question on the AVRO-saucer. This would place this letter in the early 60s. I am waiting on a copy now.

Many thanks for the second copy of your book.

I have written two researchers in Europe who apparently saw the letter sent to Amstee. Amstee wouldn't give me an exact date of the letter, but did provide names of two people who have seen it.

A fellow researcher here in Winnipeg is in the UFO Update section of the latest OMVI. He likes the lights of publicity. He got into OMVI even though he does almost no research. He's a librarian and could achieve a lot if he didn't have the hang-up about seeing his name in print. He's the one that I get all my Friedman info thro' second hand. On THE RECORD, the following jems.

Friedman is scheduled to speak here in a couple weeks. I had talked to Chris for a couple minutes that he should read your book, as you lay out all the cards on the table so to speak. Chris was amazed when I had the Saloche letter from you and some details you gave on Smith I hadn't heard. He ~~was~~ thought Friedman wouldn't have this because he didn't show it to us on his trip thro' last time. I told him later, Friedman had it.

Anyway, Chris phones Friedman about his upcoming trip and the subject of your book came up. "Steinman" according to Chris account of Friedman's conversation "can't get two facts straight." I said to Chris "really." What does he mean. Chris said he didn't really know but that the book wasn't significant. "Has he read it?" Packed. "No," said Chris, "he

hasn't read it yet."

"How can he know it's not true?" Pashed.

"I don't know?" said Chris.

I stated he didn't accept it because the subject of the ARTEC crash would further damage their (Moore/Friedman) MJ-12 documents.

Then Chris dropped the bomb. Friedman still stands behind the MJ-12 documents. He added something about the fact DORY might have been involved, but something to the effect that the document is still basically accurate. ^{He apparently had an answer for everything}

I believe it was Einstein who stated that man spends only a short period of his life in original thought. Once he gets credit for it, he spends the rest of his life defending it at the cost of truth.

I've enclosed the Swan material. As you can notice there are references to material being sent to Navy Intelligence. Jay Couley stated in a 1979 article that Navy was in contact from this point up to 1979, but he didn't answer my letter when I questioned him on this. Smith learns of Swan from Knoles and gets all his material for the "New Science." Still no word from Mrs. Smith who can confirm this. ^{The Smith people usually clam up when you mention} ① AFi
② Mrs. Swan
③ Smith's files

You mentioned Richzeker before - now his name rings a bell. ^{Logan} ~~Logan~~ gave it to me. His name was not mentioned by Budge.

If you see him could you put his association with Smith in context. ① Did he work with the Canadian govt? ② Did he work on the anti-gravity experiments? ③ Did he go to see Mrs Swan (many of Smith's closer associates travelled to Maine with Smith) ④ Most importantly find out if he knows who AFFA is? ⑤ Did he correspond with Smith? ⑥ Does he have any issues of "Topside"?

If he was around Smith he must have at least one weird story such as the enclosure from Duplantier found in my files.

There is a lot of material on the piece hauled from the St. Lawrence. Actzhemer seems to be the only one left around who still claims to have a piece. I will send along some material on it.

If Pratt sends a copy of his manuscript, I will pay you the costs to reproduce and send me a copy. Bob covered the 1975 flap here and ~~got~~ can get to the bottom of the story if he believes. He seemed to be very conservative on documents in the last couple letters I got from him.

I have some more letters related to Fitch. Got them from Greenwood. Maybe he has Fitch's files. There is no real connection. Knowles lived near Mrs. Swan and alerted the Navy Intelligence. As a member of the board of NICAP, Smith learned of Swan probably thru Keyhoe. Because Swan is also in contact with AFFA, Smith probably ran to see her.

Fitch did not know about Swan but pursued the 1952 piece (which Stokes wrote extensively about in FATE). The connections were the same as with Mrs. Swan. Knowles-Smith - Lundell.

Fitch is famous for his interview by phone with Smith where Smith states he gave the 52 piece back to a "small group" much higher than the AIR Force.

Fitch writes to Knowles and Smith trying to uncover who the small group was. Smith does not budge. He states "in official hands."

Later in the intro to "Hollow Earth" a "conversation" with Smith is referred to where Smith again refers to a small group that controls the hardware. This conversation again was credited to Fitch although this is not certain.

Admiral Knowles Dole^{n't} think had any clearance on these matters. He was simply shown the 52 piece. Fitch Oguess thought he had an inside track.

I tried to contact Fitch ten years back without success.

I have sent Bob's ^{part} actual letter in reference to his book to Stevens. I imagine he will pass it to you.

Sorry for the delay. Hope all is well with you. Still seems to be a lot of new things happening at this end. Have not been able to follow-up on all the leads.

- have enclosed the Smith - Caswell letter you quoted in your book. You will note he made the same "waste of time" comment made by Walker.

- have also enclosed for your interest two letters from Admiral Knowles to research Eitel (whose interview with Smith appears in Edwards book)

- had a lead on the AVRO saucer that now requires research. Ronald Anstee a researcher in Montreal Quebec claimed that he had written James Uccy - President Johnson for information on the saucer. Johnson answered the letter himself and referred Anstee to Commander Bush. The letter made the rounds thru a couple researchers in Europe and disappeared. A copy should still be at the Johnson library.

- have also sent the Top Secret memo asking to give Smith his security clearance. Don't know if you had seen this.

- also got the FBI documents on Swan. This Smith was asked in my last letter to talk about Swan but I haven't heard yet.

- have written to T. Bowen author of "Paperclip Conspiracy" to see if he has direct evidence of Nazis at AVRO. He mentions Bush in his book as part of

the American effort to recruit these scientists.
- on page you refer to an article dealing
with the ARO Saucer. It is from.

- as to your last letter, the material related
to Sundahl has sticks on the top. - I assume Steven.
Do you have a mailing address for him? He wrote a
good piece on the metal piece that came to Canada. That
piece also ties Sundahl to Av. Roe.

- Sundahl was on a recent NOVA show dealing
with airborne intelligence done by the U-2. He was
very close to Kennedy.

the only thing we worked together on, because Bray

A couple comments on your book. I will have to cover a few points here as your book raises many important points and I am only writing of the top of my head.

- Best book in UFOlogy today. It heads straight for the truth. This is why I have worked solely on W. O. Smith for 12 years. The answers have been there all along. All we have to do is find out what the gov't to know - 40 years ago.

- related to the MS-12 documents. As your name was given by Greenwood on his last issue you probably already know about the trouble these are in. Your documents (as reproduced in your book) appear to be the sanitized copies put out by Moore. The copies I have from Friedman and others are clean.

- this is why I asked you how you felt about the MS-12 documents in my last letter. If MS-12 (as described by the FSM documents) are for real why are they not aware of the AZTEC and Paradise Valley crashes. Also they don't have Bush as MS-1. Thirdly your date for the Roswell crash is different than there's. (I will quite listen to Friedman's ^{estimation of your book.} _{don't imagine it will be} ^{your})

- you have also used a sanitized copy of the Bolling AFB document, but you used the clean copy as well P 304 vs 625. Please have reviewed both copies. Any idea why UFOlogists would find it necessary to sanitize documents.

Related to the Canadian material, there is only one point I find some disagreement with - that being Smith's involvement with the AVRO-CAR. Maybe you have some documents I haven't seen. I have an Access to Information Request asking for the AVRO material (the Canadians spent at least 10 million or there must be some paperwork) but haven't heard yet. Have enclosed some documents which apply. Note Solandt changed

only the first Second Story meeting. Zechel can be of help here. You see from your book ^{you} have contact. Would you pass on some questions and requests for documents? Zechel interviewed Art Lundahl related to the important Swan case, but he also was involved with the 52 piece that went to Smith in Canada and back according to Smith to "the small highly classified group." Zechel was told by Lundahl that the piece also went to AVCO, as they intended to use a similar item on the cancer. Zechel has written letter from Goodspeed (who wrote the "official history of DRB") confirming he handled the piece. I need this letter to file a request for documents. Goodspeed might have carried the piece ^{back, and he's} still alive.

• on Page 2 and Page 13 are the quote by W.B. Smith and Smith helping Newton to see the huminoids. I assume this comes from Stevens files, so I have contacted him. If I am wrong maybe you can give me more detail on those statements.

• also have enclosed a document from Wright at Canadian Embassy. When I first saw this document years ago I wondered why the (?). I am beginning to understand.

• I have 1600 pages coming from the RCMP (VFO sighting reports). Should have seen them by now but they "forgot" to ship them to RCMP headquarters here. Also have "revelant documents" coming from External Affairs related to the Smith/Embassy deal. Could be a while yet till I find out what.

• we have been working hard on the Sheffield case. Rumor is we are about to get some documents. Also got a letter from the former defence minister who first leaked the story the Canadians had a VFO landing base. He couldn't remember who told him. Doesn't believe there was a covering at least on our side of the border. Letter #2 is on its way.

• Could you provide me the documentation related to Oppenheimer being shown the writing. I have an insouciant expert here with Ph.D. in Rappaport Physics and Ph.D. in Philosophy who I believe knows Oppenheimer. I would like to show him the writing for a comment. He probably will doubt Oppenheimer's involvement which is why I need some documentation.

Once again I thank you for the information you sent along. Congratulations on your persistence with Dr. Willet. I will naturally respect your confidentiality on this. Best of luck. Keep me updated.

A lot has happened here. Last night I had a 2 1/2 hour interview with one of Mr. D.B. Smith's associates. (Very disappointing) A brief review for you on who worked with Smith.

1952 Smith begins official NRC work. "Incidental Personnel" as discussed in the memo included.

Mr. L. Tuzo Wilson - NRC, now Chancellor of York University if still alive. (magnetic upset rocks, fields etc)

Mr. George Garland - NRC, now at University of Toronto (gravitational expert)

Mr. James Watt - physicist from D.R.B. now at University of

Alberta. H. Thompson - communications expert, Dept of Transport - Canadian gov't has told me there are 150 people in the civil service with this name so am having some trouble tracking these people down.

1956 to 1962 (Willet's death)

Dr. L. Bridge - worked at Defense Research Board from 1952-1959. Worked with Willet from 57 on quite close - a couple meetings a week at least.

This is who I interviewed. Worked on the anti-gravity experiments with success. Smith supervised

How
David Dillard - died on the way to
and responded with his wife. It apparently was
quite brilliant but did a "massive data"
work on Budge.

"Buck" Buchanan - primarily with the R.C.M.P.
was involved in the early "military" experiments near
the University of Ottawa.

Whitcomb - still have no first name
Some assistance from Budge to give this name as
Whitcomb was high up in D & T with satellites
etc.

The usual membership on the Ottawa New
Sciences club was 22-24, as high as 56. The
few above were the scientific "line" assistants of
Smith on the club. Budge told me at times
however, he felt he was only a "line" assistant.
Smith would tell him "Build this" "word that
coil"

"Unfortunately if Budge was told little of
the gov't work, few others would know.

As to the Swan case. If you have the
Project Conqueror documents released by Moore
you will find a Project Sigma. This fits the
Swan case. First as per the Enclature TOP SECRET
Project. According to Miss Smith (I am trying to get
written confirmation on this) AFFA who Smith was
in contact with was to land at Safford. AFFA wanted
a guarantee he would be allowed to land. The
R.C.M.P. and "government?" said yes. Then Smith
AFFA requested a guarantee he would be allowed
to take off once the contact was finished. After the
R.C.M.P. agreed. After a long meeting the "government?"
(probably Defense Research Board People) they stated

They could not guarantee it. Therefore JFK called the whole thing off. The government tells the truth "nothing ever happened."

Smith found out (we don't have this to check up) about Mrs. Swan this "technical" knowledge who was a good friend of Smith's. The FBI got involved and I am about to get that file (1954). Smith and U.S. Navy Intelligence were in contact till 1959 and the "Psychic" Incident.

Put the Suffield landing with JFK and the CIA contact with JFK and you have what is described as Project Sigma.

T. Zechel has some good interview material with Bert Gurdal (one of the participants in this case and also involved in the ~~1952~~ 1952 piece that came to Canada). Problem is finding Zechel. Even Greenwood don't know where he is. Have more on the Swan case if you are still interested. It has been written up a couple times. nobody has really gone after it.

You will also note in the TOP SECRET Project Treatment article that there was another committee. I have recently written to Mr. Hellyer to push for records, as there were no TOP SECRET committees dealing with UFOs. We could have another W-12. Topside ~~issue~~ identifies spoke of W.B. Smith as being on this committee. This is questionable tho' as I don't think they know about this first hand either.

I told you the story about AFSA at Suffield.
She also told me how the monitors would
hang around the yard when meetings were going
on, and how they had burned out a wire of
his house.

She related how Willett had 37 (I
think she might be a bit high on this number)
patents, and that all but one ended up filed
under the gov't. The only one Willett said was
not to say a word. Apparently the gov't was
jealous. Their idea was that anything Willett
designed had been done on gov't time as far as
they were concerned.

When Willett had finished the anti-gravity
experiment he had approached Dr. Ronald C.
Rose at the National Research Council. Rose was a
very powerful physicist and might well be on one
of the M^{rs} Long's letters I sent to you. Rose
actually told him to write it out. Smith refused.
According to Mrs. Smith if he had the gov't
then had the right to seize the experiment. I'm
fairly certain he stated that at times they had
simply walked into the house, grabbed certain
inventions and walked out. Smith came home disassembled the
experiment and never said another thing about
it again. He said the
world wasn't
ready for it.

Next before is the story about Smith's death.
You will see written in many places he died of
a brain tumor (PHILLIP KLAS always uses this
to explain why Smith talked to extraterrestrials and
was involved with psychics) He died of stomach
cancer, and knowing that he was dying had told
Mabel he had double copied all his documents.
He stated that she should get all the documents
and place them in an undisclosed place. The
gov't would come looking for them. She did as

she was instructed. Sure enough when Wallcut died the Canadians, Americans, and Russians came looking for Wallcut research notes etc for their research. She told everyone who came that she had burned them. Then she stated the book was started - nothing was ever missing and to her the intent was clear.

This story of the records is one I have never pushed her to answer as who knows who to trust. I think Bray got some or all. I have asked him in my last letter to clarify this point.

It's been a lot of years, and I have finally attempted to again get Mrs. Smith to talk. She told me a lot in I believe 78 face to face, but the whole thing is a bit hazy. The stories above are a rough sketch of what she claimed at that time.
