I checked telephone information in State College, PA --home of Penn State after checking the library re Walker. There was no listing so I called the University. I don't have a mailing address for him but he does apparently go in to the university still as an ex president.


I would certainly agree that HAK was in all the right places at the right times doing the right things for him to have been involved and perhaps still involved in the UFO coverup. I have no idea how to prove that at this time.

I have no idea why you want to have the government turn flying saucers over to the scientific community. The security implications of the technology of the saucers are enormous. I do not want technical information made public. Why do you? I want the world to know that indeed our planet is being visited by ETI and that the government knows a great deal. I certainly don't want all information made public. After all what about all the data obtained by other governments especially the Soviet Union? Do you expect them to make their information available? I would expect them to grab ours and put it together with theirs...

A direct frontal approach often calls the troops out of the closet. I certainly appreciate that you have been spending a lot of effort and turning up leads worthy of further attention. But again I must express my strong concern about not going past the data. .. as was the case with Sarbacher. These guys can't be brow beaten. - Q. Did you send me the letter dealing with the EBS-1 yet?
- A. No, I did get you that yet. I got you a tape which I put on the mail. I left here two days ago.
- Q. Mentions talking to Linda Howe.





How does Stringfield know about the high-level conferences at WPAFB? Is it through one of his better sources? Were Chinese and Soviets present there?


I'm enclosing a sighting report form for you to use in the Polish woman's abduction report. Please make a copy for us and mail it back to us here.



How are you these days, Larry? It's been a while since we've heard from you. How is the current court battle going? I assume you are involved in litigation. By now, you're probably fairly knowledgeable about the law. Maybe you could save a bit of money by changing professions and getting a law degree.

Now to the serious aspect of this letter. I am enclosing a photocopy of a newspaper clipping of a photograph of Ike and a man whom we'd like to find out more about. We do not know his name. Can you find out? This is extremely important. Apparently, he was in charge of a series of meetings at Wright-Patterson AFB in the late 1940's. These were the first of the MJ-12 meetings. He is still alive and MUFON is attempting to get him to release to them all the notes he made at the meetings.

Zeroing In On The Crashed Flying Saucer Mystery
The William S. Steinman Letters To Tom Benson ***

Letters of October 23, 1985 and November 5, 1985 from William Steinman to myself are excerpted below regarding material pertinent to the subject.

William S. Steinman, a UFO researcher was able to obtain a copy of three pages of notes from Canadian Government Flying Saucer researcher, Wilbert B. Smith's personal research diary, that recorded an interview that he had with Dr. Robert I. Sarbacher on September 15, 1950. The notes originated from Smith's widow (Murl) who obtained them out of Wilbert's own research diary, which is in the possession of his son. The notes are preliminary to, and are mentioned in, the "Geo-Magnetics" document. The mentioned section, is on page 2, second paragraph: "I made discreet enquiries through the Canadian embassy staff in Washington." The "Smith Notes" says Steinman are the discreet enquiries and he has had these notes for over two years and they are what prompted him to look up Dr. Sarbacher in the first place. Dr. Sarbacher remembered the Smith interview when a copy of the Smith notes were sent to him-to jog his memory.

In fact, says Steinman, nobody would ever have thought of Dr. Sarbacher, in the first place, without first having the "Smith Notes". In these notes, Smith also verifies the Frank Scully book, "Behind The Flying Saucers" (New York: Henry Holt and Company, 1950) as being substantially correct (quote by Sarbacher). Steinman considers the discovery of the "Smith Notes", as a major breakthrough in solving the crashed-recovered Flying Saucer mystery. Steinman considers the letter from Dr. Sarbacher to him as a further breakthrough. Wilbert B. Smith set the basic groundwork for the Canadian and U.S. government's cooperative effort to build a Flying Saucer aircraft. The name of the project was "Project Y".

The Canadian Flying Saucer investigation project, "Project Magnet", headed up by Wilber B. Smith, was a front very similar to Project's Sign, Grudge, and Blue-Book in the U.S. The front projects kept the public satisfied while the real projects were being worked on behind the scenes (to analyze and subsequently duplicate the recovered Flying Saucers), says Steinman.

A copy of the Dr. Sarbacher letter to William S. Steinman and a copy of Wilber B. Smith's Geo-Magnetics memorandum follows as documentation to the above.

3. I did receive some official reports when I was in my office at the Pentagon but all of these were left there as at the time we were never supposed to take them out of the office.

4. I do not recall receiving any photographs such as you request so I am not in a position to answer.

5. I have to make the same reply as on No. 4.

I recall the interview with Dr. Brenner of the Canadian Embassy. I think the answers I gave him were the ones you listed. Naturally, I was more familiar with the subject matter under discussion, at that time. Actually, I would have been able to give more specific answers had I attended the meetings concerning the subject. You must understand that I took this assignment as a private contribution. We were called "dollar-a-year men." My first responsibility was the maintenance of my own business activity so that my participation was limited.

About the only thing I remember at this time is that certain materials reported to have come from flying saucer crashes were extremely light and very tough. I am sure our laboratories analyzed them very carefully.

There were reports that instruments or people operating these machines were also of very light weight, sufficient to withstand the tremendous deceleration and acceleration associated with their machinery. I remember in talking with some of the people at the office that I got the impression these "aliens" were constructed like certain insects we have observed on earth, wherein because of the low mass the inertial forces involved in operation of these instruments would be quite low.

I still do not know why the high order of classification has been given and why the denial of the existence of these devices.

I am sorry it has taken me so long to reply but I suggest you get in touch with the others who may be directly involved in this program.

I don't note related to your letter of March 2, 88.
I got the letter from Greenwood and it was in response to
a request for material on Smith. I assume he either has
the photos or knows who does.

With the physical evidence. There might be hope yet.
I got Pat Dora letter to Mum Smith after talking to
the sources she had referred to in 1978. She does not want
to be involved in research anymore, as she had her own life
and this was Willett's work, not her's.

Having gathered together affidavits about Smith
over the years I approached those names given by Mum last
90% of the stories stayed unconfined because they would
have been classified material.

Therefore I wrote to Mum stating that she had referred
me to see whether she had a lot of stories from reliable
sources were still up in the air. She wrote back stating she
would do what she could even though she didn't have the
time or interest or knowledge as Willett.

I wrote in her letter stating I would only write one letter
stating all the names, and then I would have her alone
and try to solve the rest on my own. She would comment on what

The names include ① Smith was shown a document known

The letter remained unanswered till Feb-15, 88, and I have enclosed a copy of that letter. It has been a while since with still no word.

I have also included an interesting item on Hynek. It's significance lies naturally in your claim Dr. Mark Tuve was one of Scully's sources. This as far as I know is not found in Hynek's bio, and of the 13 names listed on the page Hynek's name is the only one not found in the index of the book. His name does not appear in the book either.

I am familiar with the Howe material, but not the Lear Jet Corp. material. Am looking forward to your forwarding a copy.

Henry Kissinger's name appears in another book related to the "secret parallel gov't in the U.S.". Will provide you this when we relocate it.

Will keep an eye open for more Smith letters related to hardware or knowles. Bray had not seen these letters either so there must still be some floating around that didn't have duplicates in Smith's files.

Finally, Timothy Good had not seen the Caswell Smith letter, and has not corresponded with Caswell for 30 years. Caswell became a Schovak's witness. I sent him a copy. Apparently there is more Smith-Caswell correspondence.

Dear Grant:

First of all, I want to thank you very much for the material that you sent to me. I especially appreciated that Wilson memmo dated Sept 15, 1969, that suggested that Smith's "Geo-magnetics" memmo "should at no time be made available to the public". I heard about that memmo but never had a copy (Wilson's Memmo). I also really appreciated that copy of Stan Friedman's "Access to Information Request Form", which shows that he was interested enough in Dr. Eric A. Walker's back-ground.

Back in December 1983 Stan Friedman called Dr. Robert I. Sarbacher via Telephone. During that conversation, Sarbacher stated "I did not attend the meetings at Wright Field concerning the recovered Saucers; but there was one person who attended

all of the meetings. I can't remember his name, he wrote a book on electrical-engineering, was a member of the R.D.B., and was head of the electrical engineering department at a university in Pennsylvania."

Grant, I did some research and found that this mans name was Dr. Eric A. Walker. I called Dr. Sarbacher, who verified that Walker was the man who did attend all those meetings at Wright Patterson A.F.B.

I wrote to Stan Friedman on March 21, 1984, telling him that Dr. Eric A. Walker was our man. Friedman wrote back to me on May 25, 1984 (exactly 7 days prior to his "Access To Information Request" of June 2, 84) telling me that he was sure the Walker was the right man and that he had contacted Walker. Friedman stated that Walker knows something but is not talking.

I tried to correspond with Dr. Walker on March 12, 1984 (He had an unlisted telephone number - which Friedman obtained from Penn State University as Scientist to Scientist - he would not give it to me). The answer to my correspondence was

very strange ; It stated " Stop! Don't Try To Find Me I Came on that Machine I Will Leave May 15 Ergot Quiet Quiet Quiet"

The above was typed on the lower portion of my letter that I sent to Walker, as evidenced by my signature and "Very Sincerely yours". My return address was cut from the upper portion of my own letter to Dr. Walker and was taped to the front of his stamped envelope to me!!

I wrote again to Dr. Walker on May 31, 1984, with no response from walker.

When I saw Stan Friedman in June of 1987 at a Saucer Convention in Burbank, California, we discussed Dr. walker. Friedman claims that he has not tried to contact Walker since 1984

It was your letter of Aug 12, 1987 that once again got me interested in Dr. walker. I finally found a telephone number for him. I called Dr. Walker on August 30, 1987 and the conversation, which I want to remain strictly

CONFIDENTIAL between yourself and myself
went as follows:

E.W. - Hello

W.S. - Hello, this is William Steinman of Los Angeles, Calif. I am calling in reference to the meetings that you attended at Wright Patterson Airforce Base in around 1949-1950, concerning the military recovery of flying saucers and bodies of occupants. Dr. Robert J. Sarbacher, now deceased, related this to me.

E.W. - Yes, I attended those meetings concerning that subject matter; why do you want to know about that?

W.S. - I believe it is a very important subject. After all we are talking about the actual recovery of a flying saucer not built or constructed on this earth! And furthermore we are talking about bodies of the occupants from the craft who were analyzed. Human like beings, not of this world!!

E.W. - So - what's there to get all excited about? Why all the concern?

W.S. - I am not excited, just very concerned. Here, we are talking about a subject that the U.S. Government

officially denies, even to the extent of actually debunking the evidence and discrediting the witnesses. Then you sit there and say, "what's there to get all excited about?" and "Why the concern?"

Dr. Vannevar Bush, Dr. D. W. Bronk, and others thought it very important and were concerned enough to classify the subject as Above-Top-Secret, infact as the most highly classified subject in the U.S. Government!!

Did you ever hear of the "MJ-12 Group" and their "Project Majestic-12", which was classified as Top-Secret/majic? I have a copy of President Elect D.D. Eisenhower's briefing paper on that Project, dated Nov. 18, 1952.

E.W. - Yes, I know of MJ-12. I have known of them for 40 years. I believe that you are chasing after and fighting with windmills!!

W.S. - Why do you say that?

E.W. - You are delving into an area that you can do absolutely nothing about. so, why get involved with it or all

concerned about it? Why don't you just leave it alone and drop it? Forget about it!!

W.S. - I am not going to drop it. I am going all the way with this!!

E.W. - Then when you find out everything about it, what are you going to do?

W.S. - I believe that this entire matter has to be brought to the public's attention. The people should know the Truth!!

E.W. - It's not worth it!! Leave it alone!!

W.S. - Can you remember any of the details pertaining to the recovery operations and subsequent analysis of the Saucers and bodies?

E.W. - I am sure that I have notes concerning those meetings at Wright Patterson AFB. I would have to dig them out and read them over in order to jog my memory.

W.S. - If I write to you, will you please answer in as much detail as you can remember? Further more, could you please xerox those notes and send me a copy?

E.W. - I might. At least I will keep your letter, will dig out my notes, and will contemplate answering. That the best I can say for now.

W.S. - Well, Dr. [redacted], I will write a letter as-soon-as-possible. Thanks for your valuable time. Good-bye.

E.W. - Good-bye.

The very next day, I wrote him a letter and inclosed a copy of the "MJ-12 Document". That was on Sept 1, 1987. During that telephone conversation, Dr. [redacted] verified one thing to me "The existence of MJ-12" (There has been a lot of debate, as of late, as to the redlity of the 8 Page MJ-12 document and the Cutler Memmo from the national archives in Washington D.C.).

If, Dr. [redacted] writes to me at all, and further more if he substantiates the 8 pages of MJ-12, we will have taken one more giant step forward. If he sends me xerox copies of his Wright Patterson

Airforcebase meeting notes, then we will have taken several giant steps forward in our quest for the truth !!

That is the reason for the extreme confidentiality on this matter between you and I - The fewer the people that know, at this sensitive stage of the investigation, the better chance we have of obtaining the needed information.

Now as touching on your requests from me. ① The Arthur Bray letter that accompanied the Sept. 15, 1950 W.B. Smith - Sarbacher interview notes, which he sent to me in April of 1983 doesn't say anything revealing, just wishing me luck in my research, and giving me the addresses of Muri Smith (Wilberts widow) and W. James Smith (Wilberts son - whom you have been in contact with) - both of which are now obsolete.

② Inclosed, you will find copies of my letters to Dr. Omond M. Solant and his replies.

③ Inclosed, you will also find copy of the declassified A.O.S.I. Document, concerning saucers and bodies at Wright Patterson Airforce base.

④ As concerning Dr. Vannevar Bush and Dr. Eric. Henry Wang performing analysis on the recovered flying saucers. It is now self evident, through several channels, that Dr. Bush headed up the overall project, this needs no further explanation. Dr. Eric Henry Wang headed up the Department of Special Studies at the old Wright Air Development center at W.P.A.F.B. from 1949-1956. The department of Special Studies was moved to Kirtland Airforce Base/Sandia Labs complex near Albuquerque, New Mexico, where Wang was in charge from 1956 until his death in 1960. I located Dr. Wang's widow, who confirmed to me that he was involved in an Above-Top-Secret project to analyze and subsequently duplicate the recovered flying saucers. I cannot give you her address nor her Telephone number since both she and I were severely reprimanded and threatened over that interview.
