Dear Ms. Wright:

Please take note of the enclosed sketch of an alleged Alien that was drawn by Mrs. Betty Hill, an alleged Abductee, which appears on page 65 of the latest OPEN MINDS Magazine.

I have an interest in this drawing as is follows-

Some years ago while working as Electronic Technician at Aerojet ElectroSystems Co. in Azusa, Ca. while on break in the office of Mr. Ronald Regehr, a friend and Specification Writer for Aerojet, he introduced me to a fellow employee named Vincent De Paula, who was an artist.

On a whim I asked Mr. De Paula if he could draw me a picture of an Alien, and he said that he could so on another occasion I went to the Arcadia, CA Library, and on loan, got a copy of, I believe the book that was titled Interrupted Journey that had the very same Alien drawing now appearing on page 65 of the Open Minds Magazine.

It is stated in the enclosed Defensive Investigative Service (DIS) file number 85260 DK1 34091W9 of an association of a friendship that had developed between, Bill Moore, and myself between 1983 and 1986. It is also stated in this same DIS file the statement-

“SUBJECT assumed that Moore is an investigator with the U.S. Air Force, because Moore showed SUBJECT some credentials.”

Indeed Mr. Moore showed my wife and I an ID card with his picture that identified him as a Special Agent with the Air Force Office Of Special Investigations (AFOSI) and told us that one of his responsibilities was to meet me and provided me with documentation regarding the existence of UFOs. One such document he gave me is about a Project Snowbird as can be found in this DIS file, and as how it came to contain an unclassified stamp at the top of it, is spelled out in the MDR request enclosed dated 23 November 2010. The attached MDR response dated 13 Dec 2001, acknowledging the receipt of my MDR with respect to “Project SNOWBIRD”-

An officially UNCLASSIFIED copy of the PROJECT SNOWBIRD document may be found as an integral part of the enclosed DIS file number 89311-Dk1-3408-1W9.

On one of our meetings, Mr. Moore took a folded piece of paper out of his shirt pocket and passed it to me under the table at which we sat at in Love's Restaurant in Tujunga, CA. I unfolded the piece of paper and found what looked like the frontal view of the face of an Alien, and it looked the same as that in the inset drawing found on page 65 of the Open Minds Magazine. I recall however, that in the drawing Mr. Moore showed me the Alien's jaw hung open and when I showed the drawing to my wife, I remarked- "Oh its dead." With the memory of that drawing in mind and the drawing from the book I showed to Mr. Vincent De Paula (the Artist), I asked him if he could make a drawing of this Alien, and he concurred, making me a drawing front and side with his signature and the date thereof on the 8 and on half by 11 piece of paper.

I began circulating this drawing, in my FOIAs to the Air Force, I have since lost a copy of this drawing. I believe that the Air Force still has copies of these FOIAs with the drawing, because in the enclosed DIS file number 85260 DK1 3409 1W9 may be found a letter dated MAY 14 1986, that states, in part-

2, It has also come to our attention that Subject has had frequent correspondence with the U.S. Air Force regarding UFOs. His correspondence may be reviewed by contacting Col. Barry Hennessey, USAF, Office of Special Projects, at the Pentagon. Ergo-

1. Under the provision of the Mandatory Declassification Review Executive Order 13526 Section 3.6 if any of my FOIA letters collected by the Air Force and containing a drawing of the head of the Alien as depicted by Vincent De Paula have classified information in them I respectfully request their review for declassification and a copy of them.

I bring this to your attention because of my FOIAs, which contained a copy of Mr. De Paula's drawing, caused some Agency to investigate him for how he came to have drawn the head of the Alien. He had to spend nearly a whole week in downtown Los Angeles, CA, explaining to authorities just why he did this. After he passed away from Testicular Cancer, at a gathering at Ron Regehr's home in Long Beach, CA, I met Mr. De Paula's widow, and she was furious at me for having gotten her husband onto trouble.

On another dinner engagement requested by Mr. Moore, he told my wife and I that an individual that he called "Falcon" had told him to show me the drawing, and said that that "would turn me on".

In a public address at a UFO conference that Mr. Moore gave in Las Vegas, Nevada on June 30, 1989, he stated that AFOSI Agent Richard Doty was his liaison person between he an Falcon, and in the enclosed article found on the Internet titled- Spy Games Revealed: Spies, Lies, and Polygraph Tape, dated June 27, 2009, by Gary S. Bekkum, it is stated-

"It was Doty who claimed Col. Hennessey was Falcon, and it was Doty who claimed Col. Hennessey had provided him with UFO documents for release to the public."

As an integral part of the enclosed DIS file number 89311-DK1-3408-1W9 may be found a- "To whom it may concern;" letter dated 17 March 1989, stating in part-

"At the request of Lee M. Graham I am writing this. Over the course of many years I have exchanged correspondence with Lee on numerous topics. These include bits and pieces-'tidbits'- of data on stealth, UFOs, aeronautical rumors, etc. At the same time these were provided to Lee I also made it a point to provide the same data to Ben Rich at Lockheed ADP. Ben, in turn, provides the material to AFOSI..."

And as indicated in the enclosed letter enclosed, dated 29 Aug 1985, it is indicated that "John Andrews" has received a copy of the "Snowbird" document, two copies of the document having been given to me by Bill Moore, one for me and one for John Andrews.

And, back to Mr. Andrews' now UNCLASSIFIED letter dated 17 March 1989-

"I provided Lee with the Lockheed Stealth designator (F-117), codename (Senior Trend) all before September 1987."

And-

"Col, Barry Hennessey has been my AFOSI contact. (Prior to Hennessey was Col. Troyer and prior was Col. Leo Olsen of late 1970's)"

And signed-

"John J. Andrews"

And as indicated above, is found in this DIS file number 89311-DK1-3408-1W9- a large UNCLASSIFIED stamp in the lower right hand corner, the very same UNCLASSIFIED stamp in the lower right hand corner is found on the enclosed, from the same DIS file the PROJECT SNOWBIRD" document.

Of interest here is that this copy of the Project Snowbird document has been sanitized with the word CETUS, and the section (OPR: USAF/NSA/CIA/MJ12) blacked out, and as well, the correct spelling Nevada is misspelled Nevede. Bill Moore stated to me that this is how the Air Force tracks the documents.

As to the relationship of John Andrews to that of Col. Barry Hennessey, I have enclosed a Biographical sketch of John Barry Hennessey that states-

1. 1964 ? 1993, special agent, Air Force Office of Special Investigations, Washington, D.C,

And attached to this Biographical sketch on John Barry Hennessey, I have attached a letter dated 16 Sep 1987, that states in part-

“Dear Lee:

Col. Hennessey (Barry) was in my office yesterday-perhaps at the same time FBI was talking with you. He opened conversation saying, ‘I don’t know anything about UFOs.’ I wrote him a letter-copy attached. He then got on the topic of a Lockheed airplane instructing me to not use its ‘F’ number in further writing nor its codename.”- Ergo-

2. If the Air Force possesses a copy of the letter Mr. Andrews has reference here to as-
“copy attached’, Under the provision of the Mandatory Declassification Review, Executive Order 13526 Section 3.6, I respectfully request the review of that letter for declassification, and a copy of it be sent to me.

And, Mr. Andrews states further-

“I just guessing, feel your FBI talk may be related.”

And-

“Hennessey said. ‘I won’t lie to you.’ But ... his comment about his not knowing anything about UFOs was already a lie.”

Signed-

To this copied letter of John’s, may be found a line where I had written-

And I have enclosed several pages from the DIS file number 86139-DK1-341?-1W1, dated 26 SEP 1986, where on one page may be found one of the following statements-

“1. Mr. Lee M. Graham sent a Freedom of Information Act Request (Tab 1) to the Air Force, requesting information about the SR-71 and U-2 Aircraft, the Lockheed CL-400 Aircraft, Lockheed production facilities, camera systems, and a classified AF facility.”

And it is signed-

“R. H. TROYER, Colonel, USAF
Special Projects, Security Director”

I am an Aircraft "buff", I had located the "classified AF facility" from reading an article in AvWeek Magazine that stated that the stealth fighter was based at Tonopah, Nevada. I simply went out near Tonopah, Nevada where there was a big missile on a sign next to a road that led off into the desert and found an air base that had a number of individual hangers painted with the same paint scheme as the individual SR-71 hangars at Beal AFB in CA.

However, in this same DIS file number 86139 DK1 341? 1W1, is found a letter enclosed dated, 23 August 1985 to-

Mr. Philip J. Klass

Wherein I had stated to Mr. Klass, that a Dr. Manamann had given me permission to accession his military records to prove that he was at a base that had photographed with a "Image Orthicon Camera System" a "UFO/Atlas encounter".

This apparently began the AFOSI interest in my Air Force FOIAs regarding UFOs.

As was know to Mr. Andrews ("John") by his letter enclosed dated 16 Sep 1987, and his letter ("Regards John") the UNCLASSIFIED letter dated 17 March 1989, an integral part of the enclosed DIS file number 89311-DK1-3408-1W9, I had been given information on the existence of the F-117 codenamed SENIOR TREND, (see the enclosed "declassified per 17 Apr Memo") This occurred in Office of the Aerojet Manager of Security on the date of 15 September 1987, by my signing the enclosed C E R T I F I C A T E, that states, in part-

I, Lee M. GRAHAM, UNDERSTAND THAT I HAVE BEEN EXPOSED TO INFORMATION WHICH HAS BEEN IDENTIFIED TO ME AS BEING CUEURRENTLY AND PROPERLY CLASSIFIED AND FOR WHICH I DO NOT HAVE A NEED TO KNOW.

The Declassified per 17 Apr Memo, A T T A C H M E N T 1, clearly states-

1. YOU INCLUDED THEE FOLLOWING INFORMATION IN FOIA REQUESTS.

I was previous to this date been asked by Mr. John Andrews to make a FOIA to the Air Force regarding the existence of the F-117.

The attached MEMORANDUM FOR DISTRIBUTION, dated 17 APR 1990, was issued by-

JOHN B. HENNESSEY, Colonel, USAF

Special Projects Security Director
Assistant Secretary
Of the Air Force

It was a direct violation of Section 5B-Access, Chapter 5, SAFEGUARDING, AIR FORCE INSTRUCTION 31-401, dated 1 November 2005-

To have provided me with classified information on the F-117 Program "FOR WHICH I DO NOT NEED TO HAVE A NEED TO KNOW"-

So, there had to have been a special dispensation for Major General Michael C. Kerby assisted by FBI Agent William J. Hurley, to give to me this "CLASSIFIED" information on the "F-117" on 15 September 1987, and for Col. Barry Hennessey to be aware of the fact in order for him to issue the document, dated 17 APR 1990 which led to the closing of the DIS file, just two days later, ergo-

3. If still classified, under the provision of the Mandatory Declassification Review Executive Order 13526 Section 3.6 I respectfully request the review of that Record and/or document/provision that gave the Air Force permission to provide To me with that information about the F-117,

And-

4. Under the provision of the Mandatory Declassification Review, Executive Order 13526 Section 3.6, I respectfully request a copy of the provision of Air Force law by which the PROJECT SNOWBORD document and Mr. John Andrews' letter, dated 17 March 1989, an integral part of the enclosed DIS file number 89311-DK1-3408-1W9 were "UNCLASSIFIED", and copies of these records sent to me.

Thank you for your time, and consideration Ms. Wright.







SUBJECT: Declassification of Association between F-117A and
the SENIOR TREND Nickname

This memorandum constitutes a "letter change" to the SENIOR TREND Security Guide, 1 October 1989. Effective immediately, the association of the nickname "SENIOR TREND" and the F-117A aircraft is declassified. Each holder of the SENIOR TREND Security Guide should post this memorandum to their copy of the Guide. Documents classified solely because of the former classification of this association are now unclassified; and may be handled and stored accordingly. Each document should be reviewed to assure that there is no classified information other than the association.

Documents declassified under the provisions of this change should have their classification marked through, show the initials of the individual reviewing the document; and reference this memorandum as authority for the declassification. On bulky documents, it will only be necessary to re-mark the cover and title page, first two pages, and the back of the document. Post a copy of this memorandum inside the cover of the document.

The Air Force will continue a review of the classification of SENIOR TREND information, and will notify program participants of changes. I enjoin each organization and participant to remember that much information remains classified and to redouble efforts to protect this vital program.

AT THE REQUEST OF LEE M. GRAHAM I AM WRITING THIS.

OVER THE COURSE OF MANY YEARS I HAVE EXCHANGED CORRESPONDENCE WITH LEE ON NUMEROUS TOPICS. THESE INCLUDE BITS AND PIECES - "TIDBITS" - OF DATA ON STEALTH, UFOs, AERONAUTICAL RUMORS, ETC. AT THE SAME TIME THESE WERE PROVIDED TO LEE I ALSO MADE IT A POINT TO PROVIDE THE SAME DATA TO BEN RICH AT LOCKHEED ADP. BEN, IN TURN, PROVIDES THE MATERIAL TO AFOSI. I PROVIDED LEE WITH THE LOCKHEED STEALTH DESIGNATOR (F-117), CODENAME (SENIOR TREND) ALL BEFORE SEPTEMBER 1987. RECENTLY I PROVIDED LEE WITH PHOTOS OF PATCHES SAID TO BE SYMBOLIC OF THE STEALTH SQUADRONS.

COL. BARRY HENNESSEY HAS BEEN MY AFOSI CONTACT. (PRIOR TO HENNESSEY WAS COL. TROYER AND PRIOR WAS COL. LEO OLSEN OF LATE 1970'S). I SHOULD POINT OUT FOIA REQUESTS TO AFOSI, FBI, CIA HAVE ALL INDICATED I HAVE NEVER BEEN "INVESTIGATED."



2. George (NMN) Contreras, Shift Lab Supervisor, AES, with daily contact as immediate supervisor from 1985 to present. Contreras said that he considered GRAHAM an honest, responsible person with no problems with morals, alcohol, drugs, finances, or law enforcement. Contreras stated that GRAHAM does have a problem in requesting information for which he had no "need-to-know". Contreras said that GRAHAM is working on the DSP-1 Sensor Program (DSP) and the questions GRAHAM asks are above his need-to-know. Contreras stated that it is his opinion that GRAHAM is trying to prove that the Air Force is attempting to cover up the existence of UFOs. Contreras stated that GRAHAM has asked engineers about information regarding the sensors and that the engineers have been alerted not to talk to GRAHAM unless there is a "need-to-know". Contreras related that GRAHAM feels the DSP is being used to track UFOs. Contreras said that he, Contreras, worries about unclassified data being combined with other unclassified data yielding classified data. Contreras said that GRAHAM is very effective at collecting data. Contreras stated that GRAHAM could be used by others (UFO buffs) to collect data from AES. Contreras said that GRAHAM and another person at AES (NFI) formed a "research business" and had cards printed. Contreras said he had seen the card, but no card could be located. Contreras stated that GRAHAM'S interest started with UFOs and that GRAHAM thinks aliens gave information to the US for the Stealth Bomber. When asked about loyalty to the US, Contreras said that he felt that GRAHAM was susceptible to being tricked into providing research or data, but that GRAHAM was basically loyal. Contreras would not recommend GRAHAM for a position of trust because he, Contreras, feels GRAHAM "is irresponsible in risking his clearance over his interests of which he has no need-to-know". Contreras further stated that GRAHAM is security conscious and has no security violations. Contreras said that he would appear at a hearing if necessary.

On 17 Jan 90, Contreras was recontacted to obtain names of engineers whom GRAHAM had asked questions of. Contreras stated that the engineers were reluctant to talk about GRAHAM. Contreras further stated that some engineers had either quit or been transferred to other locations.

Sir, I am writing, seeking information to the following very SPECIFIC questions. I HAVE made Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) requests to the National Security Council (NSC), the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), and the United States Air Force (USAF), with regard to this material. They ALL, however, have been unable or unwilling(?) to answer the questions.

With your permission, I shall ask the questions and give you the reason for the purpose of the question.

1a. Has the United States flight tested a sub-scale version (see enclosure A-1 through A-3) of the B-2 stealth bomber at Groom Lake, Nevada?

If we have-

1b. I respectfully request to know to what specific agency of the U.S. Government one should make a request to for a photograph of this sub-scale version of the ATB?

The reason that I ask this question-

Here (see enclosure A-1 through A-3) is a letter from my friend Mr. JOHN ANDREWS. Included in the letter is a drawing of an aircraft that has been witnessed flying in the Groom Lake, Nevada area. If you compare this drawing (see enclosure A-3) with that of B-2 stealth bomber (see enclosure B), you will see that they are nearly identical. The drawing (A-3), however, was supplied to me on "29 April 1986" (see enclosure A-1) long before the Air Force had released an artists conception of what the B-2 was to look like. This drawing (see enclosure A-3) is of a flight model, sub-scale, version of the stealth bomber that demonstrated that the vehicle was being flight tested years ago.

Indeed in an article in the "FEBRUARY 1988" issue of "GUNG-HO", it is stated on page 41-

"As for other low observables in the Nellis skies, every

...attime ... has had or is flying a stealth design of one sort or another. Northrop, for example, has had three scaled down versions of it ATB "flying wings" in the air for over seven years."

At the present time, the B-2 bomber is getting some very bad press; ostensibly because it is an unproven design. Quite obviously if the sub-scale version does exist, it would have been thoroughly test flown and tested for its ability to fly through Soviet radar systems at the Groom Lake/Cactus flat (P366 and P322) flight test facilities.

Being a supporter of the B-2 program, I believe that the USAF should garner support from the American public for the B-2 by revealing that information it can without violating National Security. If a sub-scale B-2 ATB exists, I do not feel that that revelation would violate National Security.

2. Mr. QUAYLE, Sir, can you define for me what is meant by the term National Security?

However, if the sub-scale version of the ATB does not exist; if this drawing (see enclosure A-3) is but disinformation created by the United States Air Force (AFOSI), I would hope that you would wish to repudiate it, otherwise-

The reason that I ask this question-

Please note these articles (see enclosure C) from the "Monday, July 24, 1989" issue of "Aerospace Daily" (page 130) which state-

"F-117A EMERGING: Pentagon officials say further declassification of the Air Force F-117A stealth fighter is being considered, with release of its mission and more detailed photographs possible late this summer. The step is under review since so many photos of the aircraft, flying in daylight near its Tonopah, Nev., operating base, are showing up in the press. "We'd like to get out in front of this," a Pentagon official says."

And-

"AND STEALTH SHAPE: Footage of the F-117A broadcast last week shows the plane to have a flattened, tapered fuselage profile, a highly-swept V-tail, and what appear to be four

oval exhaust ports for its two engines. The films also show the aircraft in tight turns with its wings at 85-90 degrees of bank, and using a drag chute to slow its landing roll."

Mr. QUAYLE, Sir, in the month of August 1987 Mr. JOHN ANDREWS provided me with information that the F-117 aircraft exists. Please note his letter (see enclosure D) wherein he states-

"To whom it may concern:

At the request of Lee M. Graham I am writing this.-

I provided Lee with the Lockheed Stealth designator (F-117), codename (Senior Trend) all before September 1987."

I (Lee M. Graham) provided this information to my friend Mr. R. W. KOCH and he made a FOIA request to the USAF. The Air Force, however, lied to Mr. KOCH in their response (see enclosure E) wherein they state-

"Our search disclosed no records, or knowledge of, a F-117 Night Hawk."

However, on "15Sep87" (see enclosure F-1) I was provided with proof (see enclosure F-5) that the F-117 exists.

This "proof" (see enclosure F-5), however, may be disinformation created by the Air Force Office of Special Investigations (AFOSI).

Please note this Address (see enclosure G) given before a public audience on the evening of "JUNE 30, 1989" by Mr. "WILLIAM L. MOORE.

"In early September, 1980, I was approached by a well-placed individual within the intelligence community who claimed to be directly connected to a high-level government project dealing with UFOs. This individual, who subsequently came to be known as "the Falcon", told me that he spoke for a small group of similar individuals who were uncomfortable with the government's continuing cover-up of the truth and indicated that he and his group would like to help me with my research into the subject in the hope and expectation that I might be able to help them find a way to change the prevailing policy and get the facts before the public without breaking any laws in the process. I knew I was being recruited, but at that point I had no idea for what. In any case, I was told that if I was interested in cooperating with their group, I would be further contacted by a liaison man and that future meetings between me and "the Falcon" would be arranged by this person. The liaison person who subsequently made contact with me was AFOSI agent Richard Doty-- a man who has

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



OPERATION MAJESTIC-12 is a TOP SECRET Research and Development/ Intelligence operation responsible directly and only to the President of the United States. Operations of the project are carried out under control of the Majestic-12 (Majic-12) Group which was established by special classified executive order of President Truman on 24 September, 1947, upon recommendation by Dr. Vannevar Bush and Secretary James Forrestal. (See Attachment "A".) Members of the Majestic-12 Group were designated as follows:

- Adm. Roscoe H. Hillenkoetter
- Dr. Vannevar Bush
- Secy. James V. Forrestal*
- Gen. Nathan F. Twining
- Gen. Hoyt S. Vandenberg
- Dr. Detlev Bronk

- Dr. Donald Menzel
- Gen. Robert M. Montague
- Dr. Lloyd V. Berkner

The death of Secretary Forrestal on 22 May, 1949, created a vacancy which remained unfilled until 01 August, 1950, upon which date Gen. Walter B. Smith was designated as permanent replacement.

On 24 June, 1947, a civilian pilot flying over the Cascade Mountains in the State of Washington observed nine flying disc-shaped aircraft traveling in formation at a high rate of speed. Although this was not the first known sighting of such objects, it was the first to gain widespread attention in the public media. Hundreds of reports of sightings of similar objects followed. Many of these came from highly credible military and civilian sources. These reports resulted in independent efforts by several different elements of the military to ascertain the nature and purpose of these objects in the interests of national defense. A number of witnesses were interviewed and there were several unsuccessful attempts to utilize aircraft in efforts to pursue reported discs in flight. Public reaction bordered on near hysteria at times.

In spite of these efforts, little of substance was learned about the objects until a local rancher reported that one had crashed in a remote region of New Mexico located approximately seventy-five miles northwest of Roswell Army Air Base (now Walker Field).

On 07 July, 1947, a secret operation was begun to assure recovery of the wreckage of this object for scientific study. During the course of this operation, aerial reconnaissance discovered that four small human-like beings had apparently ejected from the craft at some point before it exploded. These had fallen to earth about two miles east of the wreckage site. All four were dead and badly decomposed due to action by predators and exposure to the elements during the approximately one week time period which had elapsed before their discovery. A special scientific team took charge of removing these bodies for study. (See Attachment "C".) The wreckage of the craft was also removed to several different locations. (See Attachment "B".) Civilian and military witnesses in the area were debriefed, and news reporters were given the effective cover story that the object had been a misguided weather research balloon.

A covert analytical effort organized by Gen. Twining and Dr. Bush acting on the direct orders of the President, resulted in a preliminary consensus (19 September, 1947) that the disc was most likely a short range reconnaissance craft. This conclusion was based for the most part on the craft's size and the apparent lack of any identifiable provisioning. (See Attachment "D".) A similar analysis of the four dead occupants was arranged by Dr. Bronk. It was the tentative conclusion of this group (30 November, 1947) that although these creatures are human-like in appearance, the biological and evolutionary processes responsible for their development has apparently been quite different from those observed or postulated in homo-sapiens. Dr. Bronk's team has suggested the term "Extra-terrestrial Biological Entities", or "EREs", be adopted as the standard term of reference for these creatures until such time as a more definitive designation can be agreed upon.

Since it is virtually certain that these craft do not originate in any country on earth, considerable speculation has centered around what their point of origin might be and how they get here. Mars was and remains a possibility, although some scientists, most notably Dr. Menzel, consider it more likely that we are dealing with beings from another solar system entirely.

Numerous examples of what appear to be a form of writing were found in the wreckage. Efforts to decipher these have remained largely unsuccessful. (See Attachment "E".) Equally unsuccessful have been efforts to determine the method of propulsion or the nature or method of transmission of the power source involved. Research along these lines has been complicated by the complete absence of identifiable wings, propellers, jets, or other conventional methods of propulsion and guidance, as well as a total lack of metallic wiring, vacuum tubes, or similar recognizable electronic components. (See Attachment "F".) It is assumed that the propulsion unit was completely destroyed by the explosion which caused the crash.

A need for as much additional information as possible about these craft, their performance characteristics and their purpose led to the undertaking known as U.S. Air Force Project SIGN in December, 1947. In order to preserve security, liason between SIGN and Majestic-12 was limited to two individuals within the Intelligence Division of Air Materiel Command whose role was to pass along certain types of information through channels. SIGN evolved into Project GRUDGE in December, 1948. The operation is currently being conducted under the code name BLUE BOOK, with liason maintained through the Air Force officer who is head of the project.

On 06 December, 1950, a second object, probably of similar origin, impacted the earth at high speed in the El Indio - Guerrero area of the Texas - Mexican border after following a long trajectory through the atmosphere. By the time a search team arrived, what remained of the object had been almost totally incinerated. Such material as could be recovered was transported to the A.E.C. facility at Sandia, New Mexico, for study.

Implications for the National Security are of continuing importance in that the motives and ultimate intentions of these visitors remain completely unknown. In addition, a significant upsurge in the surveillance activity of these craft beginning in May and continuing through the autumn of this year has caused considerable concern that new developments may be imminent. It is for these reasons, as well as the obvious international and technological considerations and the ultimate need to avoid a public panic at all costs, that the Majestic-12 Group remains of the unanimous opinion that imposition of the strictest security precautions should continue without interruption into the new administration. At the same time, contingency plan MJ-1949-04P/78 (Top Secret - Eyes Only) should be held in continued readiness should the need to make a public announcement present itself. (See Attachment "G".)

MEDICAL RECORDS/INTERVIEWS

6. Efforts to perform a medical record and interview at CCS met with negative results as it is no longer in business. Inquiry at Christian Counseling Associates (CCA), 144 E. Foothill Blvd., Arcadia, CA, disclosed that CCS is no longer in existence. CCA records clerk advised that CCS went out of business in the early 1970's (NFI). CCA is not affiliated with CCS.

SUBJECT INTERVIEW

7. On 19 Mar 86, SUBJECT was interviewed relative to the allegation that he may be a "minor security risk". SUBJECT was also queried about his past bankruptcy and psychiatric treatment.

SUBJECT advised that in approximately 1985, he visited the vicinity of Tonopah Test Range (TTR), Tonopah, NV, and photographed portions of that facility from an unrestricted area using a zoom lens. SUBJECT explained that he did not know that TTR was a classified area. SUBJECT stated that he did not see any warning signs which prohibited photographs from being taken. SUBJECT described himself as an "aircraft buff", and that was the reason for his visit to TTR. SUBJECT denied that he was a minor security risk because of his interest in aircrafts. SUBJECT advised that he is a security conscious individual and would never intentionally violate any security regulations. SUBJECT related that because of his knowledge of aircrafts, he is in a position to detect possible security violations committed by others. SUBJECT said that he would be the first to report a security violation. When SUBJECT was asked how he obtained an unclassified document, formerly designated TOP SECRET, concerning Project Snowbird, SUBJECT explained that it was given to him by a Source. SUBJECT identified the Source as a Bill Moore, 4219 W. Olive, #247, Burbank, CA. SUBJECT described Moore as a casual friend whom he met in approximately 1983. SUBJECT advised that he has had an average of once a month casual contact as a friend with Moore from approximately 1983 to Mar 86. SUBJECT assumed that Moore is an investigator with the U.S. Air Force, because Moore once showed SUBJECT some credentials. SUBJECT advised that he believed the reason Moore gave him the document was so he (SUBJECT) could leak it to the public. SUBJECT explained that he took the document to his Security Department at Aerojet ElectroSystems, Azusa, CA, for their review. SUBJECT stated that Moore never tried to elicit any information about his job.

In response to questions regarding bankruptcy, SUBJECT reported that he filed for bankruptcy in approximately 1974 in Los Angeles, CA. SUBJECT described his current financial situation as good and reported no adverse credit or delinquent accounts since his bankruptcy.

SUBJECT explained that he received psychiatric treatment at LEH, Pasadena, CA, in approximately 1969. SUBJECT voluntarily advised that he had a nervous breakdown in approximately 1969 and was treated as an outpatient at LEH for about three months by a Dr. Nash. SUBJECT also reported that he received psychiatric care as an inpatient for a couple of weeks in approximately 1970 at Norwalk, CA. SUBJECT could not recall the name of the facility at Norwalk, CA. SUBJECT provided medical releases for LEH. (SA NAVAL AND WRITER)

8. On 11 Apr 86, SUBJECT was reinterviewed regarding developed medical treatment and to ascertain the address of CCS, Pasadena, CA. SUBJECT stated that he sought medical treatment at CCS approximately 1969 but could not recall the physician's
