Gentlemen:

It is my unpleasant responsibility to inform you that on June 10, 1993, my friend and immediate superior, HPF President and Director, Dr. Scott Jones, was accused by his executive assistant, Menelika A. McCarthy, of making uninvited sexual advances to Ms. McCarthy, several times during her tenure of employment. Ms. McCarthy also reported to me on June 10 and 11, incidents involving two other women whom she named ("Angie K." and "Ginette", last names can be provided), who Ms. McCarthy told me had reported to her similar unwanted sexual advances toward them by Dr. Jones.

Because neither Scott's wife, Johnnie, nor either of you gentlemen as officers and directors of the Foundation, have apparently yet been informed of this potential exposure of Dr. Jones, yourselves and the HPF to the legal and publicity impacts of Ms. McCarthy's allegations, and because in my opinion Scott's management of the Foundation is being compromised because of his efforts to "contain" this unfortunate situation internally, I believe it is my legal responsibility to inform you of this problem.

In the two months since Ms. McCarthy first made her allegations about Scott to me, quite an extensive written record and set of various actions have evolved, making the situation somewhat more complex than just her making of these unfortunate allegations. Foremost among these is the subsequent revelation, confirmed by both parties to me and to our HPF Press consultant, Robert Teets, that Scott and Menelika did have a sexual relationship in the past, while Ms. McCarthy resided in England and when Scott apparently visited her there. Mrs. Jones is unaware of this fact, as well.

Adding to our suspicions and to our difficulty in understanding Ms. McCarthy's motives is that Menelika withheld this crucial fact about their past relationship from me, at the time she made the allegations about Dr. Jones' sexual behaviors toward herself and these other two women. Menelika's intentions in making these allegations remain unknown but, by her omission, she in fact accused Scott of criminal sexual behaviors.

Both Bob Teets and myself are immediately available to share what primary information we have about these unfortunate circumstances, and I will provide you both with copies of the "file" developed about this matter, upon request. Attached to this

memorandum is a copy of the June 20, 1993, memorandum I gave to Scott, documenting Ms. McCarthy's allegations about him to me, and my immediate response and actions that I took. Also provided is a copy of my July 15, 1993, memorandum to Scott, further documenting the situation and some personal concerns.

In various recent communications to Scott, both Bob Teets and I have sought to focus for him the inherent difficulty of his position, regarding any dealings he has with Ms. McCarthy, as long as neither Scott's wife nor the HPF Board have been informed of her allegations, and their past relationship. We have explained its untenability, as his fear of potential disclosures could compromise him or put the Foundation at some risk of adverse legal exposure or unfortunate publicity, if she should prosecute or sue.

For the record, I have been an acquaintance and friend of Scott's since June, 1988, when we were introduced by our mutual friend, Dr. Leo Sprinkle, of Wyoming. I have been a "paid consultant" to HPF since August, 1991, and began full time consultation in June, 1992. Since January 1, 1993 and currently, I have been a full-time employee of the Foundation, in the position of Director of Project Development.

During my various involvements with Scott and the Foundation, I personally have witnessed no inappropriate behaviors of Dr. Jones toward Ms. McCarthy or toward anyone else, nor had I heard of or been told of any such until Ms. McCarthy's revelations to me in making her allegations in conversations of June 10 and June 11, 1993, and subsequently confirmed by her in the written record (8/12/93). If Scott has personal problems in this regard, it is certainly my hope that you can intervene and assist him through any difficulties this situation may cause him. But, neither friendship nor my tacit responsibilities to you, as HPF's Board, can be served by suppressing this, any longer, as the situation is extremely "corrosive" to the Foundation and its activities, and potentially damaging to the reputations of all of us who are involved with HPF. Also, it appears that Ms. McCarthy has attempted to use partial disclosure of these issues, to another HPF employee (me), to in some fashion enhance her position or to compromise or control Dr. Jones in his ability to objectively manage her activities.

Be that as it may, and pursuant to your own inquiries, please be advised that one problem HPF currently has is its failure to have filed any of the required "Charity Registration" information, for any of the several years' of Foundation operations, with any state in which we do business or solicit funds. The primary state where we may have a problem and penalty is New York, the location of our primary benefactor to date. Although we have not openly solicited public contributions, we are supposed to have filed, (something that Ms. McCarthy apparently was to have handled, but did not). This situation can most likely be handled by filing an appeal and an explanation requesting a waiver of any penalties, owing to our "sole-source" funding status so far. I am at your disposal for additional information, and wish to speak personally with you.

RE: **Salary and Title Transition of HPF Staff**

Pursuant to our conversation on 1 March re everyone's salary being cut in half effective 1 May, I just wanted to point out that before Christmas you had set the date for 1 June. In any event, though you gave me a verbal notice that this was your plan but that if funding came through "within the next 60 days" that this would be a "nonevent", in the case that this happens, you will need to serve everyone with a written notice that "effective 1 May or 1 June your current salary of \$XXXXX will be halved to \$XXXXX until "further notice" or until "appropriate funding is established" wherein as you stated, "everyone's salary would be brought back to their original status". By doing this in writing, the Foundation will be legally covered. If you would like me to draft a letter for you, I can do so.

Again, I want to reiterate to you my decision to tighten my belt and alter my family's lifestyle for a time until we can get things in order financially and programmatically. Please as I have assured you, rest any doubts or fears that I would obtain a part-time job that would interfere with my primary job at HPF. This simply will not happen. My future part-time employer will be told up front of my situation and so there will be no room for conflicting hours or schedules as seemed to be your main concern. My loyalties lie with HPF first and foremost.

Dear Scott,

I'm very sorry that it was not appropriate for me to communicate before this, for reasons that are apparent now.

After Menelika called and reached out to me last week (3/7), and I arranged for her to tell her story to some others besides myself, the nature and depth of the various issues crystallized. I hope that before you react or build further upon the unfortunate happenings of the months since June, you will wait until you fully understand what it is that she is saying, and to whom. My reticence at contact has been driven by my desire to avoid any deceptions, or other pressures until Menelika was secured and my own situation was better defined. It truly was nothing personal.

It isn't at all about me, Scott, and never has been it appears. Partly because of the ineffectiveness of the approach Bob and I took to this set of problems when they first came to our attention, another avenue was indicated by Menelika's revelations of March 11, 1994. Beyond that, I've been told that it will be inappropriate for you and me to discuss any of the merits of her case, or my own as pending. Going on about my personal hopes, fears and griefs over this isn't productive at this juncture.

However, I am in receipt of your letter to me of March 4, 1994, notifying me of the termination of my full-time status on April 30, 1994. As you directed, I have continued full-time working on the "UFO Guide," as Bob has said he informed you. I do have some questions about various arrangements, but like you, I don't know much about standard practices in such affairs. Bob has offered to counsel with us, and I see no reason not to avail ourselves of this, or indeed, to continue working professionally on the matters at hand. I'll be "on line" and at the keyboard and phones on Monday morning. I've been in contact with Bill Malone via e-mail, about expense reconciliation. He is generically aware.



Effective April 30, 1994, your position as a fulltime employee of the Human Potential Foundation will be terminated.

I will provide you, as we have discussed, a short draft statement about the intelligence community and its probable functioning in the UFO arena, and a second draft statement about the working of the federal record system.

As I noted in my letter to you of February 3, 1994, you have made valuable contributions in many areas of the Foundation. I look forward to more of the same in the future as we work together on projects central to the Foundation and of personal interest.

March 23, 1987

There has been no feedback from the breakfast with Cousins and Kroc. As we discussed, I have no additional detail about their agenda beyond that which I gave you in the memo following my telephone conversation with Gordon Feller. Mrs. Kroc appears to have the impression and hope that her money can be used to have an important and rather immediate effect on arms control. I don't know whether she has been misled by Feller and/or Cousins, but after you left the table she stated that she must be listening to a different drummer, and didn't appear to want to believe that the issue couldn't quickly be solved by persons of good will, and those without such a disposition simply be removed from the loop. Cousins asked me to urge you to follow through on his request that you give a major foreign policy speech that directly and forcefully articulates your goals as the Chairman. To point out the maljunction of the administration's foreign policy misadventures and missed opportunities, and the flack you are taking from both the Doves and the Hawks in your attempts to get the Threshold Test Ban and Peaceful Nuclear Explosion treaties ratified.

George Gallup's secretary called and cancelled our scheduled appointment this week. That is the second postponement. We have not rescheduled yet. I will write up the issues we are interested in and mail this to him along with copies of the views and proposed questions I have gathered from survival researchers. This will take the pressure off the meeting, although I will still press to have it.

When Wink Franklin sent copies of the GSA application forms to engage the use of the Departmental Auditorium, he also sent background material about Noetics and the proposed November symposium. In that material it was stated that the 1984 Consciousness and Survival symposium was "sponsored by the Institute of Noetic Sciences and the Smithsonian Institution." I have talked to Wink previously about this statement and asked him to stop using it. As you recall, Wilton Dillon and I carefully negotiated the statement, "planned in cooperation with The Office of Smithsonian Symposium and Seminars." The 1984 Symposium was not sponsored by the Smithsonian Institution. They are very sensitive about the use of their name and this has the potential of hurting Noetics and upsetting my current efforts to get Smithsonian aboard for the November conference on Exceptional Human Capabilities. I will talk again to Wink about this.

Charles Spencer, Vice President of the Fetzer Foundation visited the office. He much appreciated the letter you sent to John Fetzer.

March 2, 1987

Attended a meeting pulled together by Anthony A. Gedeon, president of Gedeon Aviation Corporation, on the subject of models of creative education. It was held at the Washington headquarters of the Da Love-Ananda movement. They presented a briefing of their Garden of Lions school in New York state. A second presenter was Judy Haines from the Mead School in Greenwich, CN. Both of these schools have a very successful track record of teaching using whole-brain learning techniques including meditation, guided imagery and intuitive processes. The Garden of Lions has a high visibility spiritual guru focus. The Mead School has found acceptable metaphores for their spiritual content. A third presentation was by Ravi Arapurakal, founder of Winsight, a computer software company that has developed a line of computer programs that draw out the intuitive side of the user. These programs are different than Human Edge/Thoughtware that provide simple level conclusion based upon user provided data, and also different from Think Tank/MaxThink that does organize user thoughts and ideas and stimulate thought in a general way. I recommend that we get a few of these programs on our system: Improving key relationships; Helping your boss get ahead; Anticipate emerging problems; Find hidden opportunities; and Develop a selling argument. They are written to run on an IBM PC or any of its true compatibles. Our Data General is a true compatible. Charles O. Bubar, president of Creative Management Services also presented a briefing on that organization's effort to work with alternative education and training techniques in the private sector. Paul Messier, Office of Research, Department of Education, and Paul H. Berkowitz, Special Assistant to Representative Ben Gilman (R-NY) were also at the meeting.

Call from Jack Fobes. As you have requested, he will propose at the up-coming board meeting of the Club of Rome that your status be changed to Honorary Member. That will put you in the company of the King of Spain, Jimmy Carter and others who have previously actively served the Club. Jack said that there are no formal responsibilities associated with the status of Honorary Member, but of course any level of continuing support for the Club would sincerely be appreciated. He specifically noted the Club's continuing and pressing need for financial contribution from its active members. I believe that Jack was sending a gentle message. You may want to check whether or not you have made your annual contribution to the Club.

The scheduled meeting with George Gallup on March 3rd was rescheduled at the request of Gallup for 3 p.m. on March 27th when he will be in Washington. We will meet in my office, or if you desire to participate, wherever you want it.

K Discussion with our contacts at DIA. They are somewhat concerned about the forthcoming report of the National Research Council (NRC) on human technologies. As you recall, we attempted through Frank Press to get a qualified parapsychologist on the committee that looked into parapsychology and five other human technologies for the Army Research Institute. The only person on the committee with any knowledge of psi was psychologist Ray Hyman. Ray has a good reputation in his field, and is a known skeptic and protagonist about psi. Honest skepticism is essential, but in my opinion, Ray's mind is not really open on the subject. More significant is the fact that George Lawrence was the Army's project officer in the effort. Lawrence with Hyman were sent by the Defense Advanced Research Projects Agency a number of years ago to look into what the Stanford Research Institute had done with Uri Geller as a subject. Their report is a small classic in distortion and bias. Hyman may have mellowed a bit since then, but there is no evidence that Lawrence is anything but uncomfortable with psi any determined to thwart open research into it. John Alexander is writing an internal letter in the Army about this current situation and the anticipated negative recommendation by the NRC. If the report is negative for incorrect reasons, I recommend a letter to Press pointing out that your first suggestion in having a qualified parapsychologist on the committee probably would have avoided the problem we anticipate. Actually, I'm not as pessimistic as Alexander. Hyman is intelligent and will be careful not to set himself up to undefendable criticism. What we may get is a report that is so bland that it doesn't say anything. Of course, we can complain about that too. A saving grace is that the other members of the committee may not have known much, if anything, about psi going in, but I assume they are scientists of integrity and would not allow Hyman to get by with anything grossly unfair.

Conversation with Arthur Berger who has recently founded the International Institute for the Study of Death (IISD). This organization will be meeting at the University of Wales for three days immediately before the Parapsychological Association annual meeting at the University of Edinburgh, Scotland. I plan on attending both meetings and suggest sharing several of the points you made at Elizabeth McAdams' ceremony; the main one being coordination and cooperation in survival research. The IISD audience will be international, and there is some survival research under way in Europe. George Meek has a support group

there. A flyer on the IISD is attached. You will note that Jack Spong is member of the Advisory Board.

Through the Senate Navy Liaison Office I requested some photos of 1960's - 1970's navy research with marine mammals, sea lions, dolphins and whales. Some of these show trainers using both verbal and non-verbal communications with the animals. I believe that telepathic communications also were involved whether the navy intended it or not.

February 16, 1987

In conversation with Wink Franklin I was told that they are still having technical problems with getting the computer discs provided by Jack Spongs office of the Consciousness proceedings to print in clean text. After several vendors have first asserted that they can solve the problem and then failed to do so, they are trying one more time before they re-key all the edited papers. He assured me that the speakers would all be provided copies of the proceedings when they are finally published. I told Wink that I would be having lunch with George Gallup on March 3rd to discuss the poll that Gallup agreed to run concerning public attitudes toward government support of anomalies research. I specifically asked for written input from Noetics about the subjects and philosophy they would be interested in having covered in a national poll. I have made the same request from the John Fetzer Foundation, and from John Alexander in his roll as president of the International Association for Near Death Studies.

Willis Harman called and requested that we change the dates of the Exceptional Human Capabilities (EHC) conference to the weekend of November 14-15. This was done to avoid requesting members of the Noetic's board to make back-to-back trips to Washington, D.C. on successive weekends. I have arranged for the Interdepartmental Auditorium on Constitution Avenue as the site for the EHC conference. That auditorium can be set up to seat 1,325.

Conversation with Stephan Schwartz. He and his Mobius organization are planning on doing some dolphin research this year. I briefed him on the planning my Center has under way for some open water dolphin research this July. We will share plans and try to develop a joint research protocol.

There has been a break in the ranks of the followers of Ramtha. It has been reported that Shirley MacLaine requested the Ramtha staff not to use her name in association with any of Ramtha's activities, and a large group from the San Francisco area have defected. The charges are that the energy has changed from what it had been, that there is a dominance of commercialism and a serious reduction in the spiritual content. The above is not an unusual evolution in movements such as these.

I was briefed my Norie Huddle and Sig Cohen, (ACDA Information Officer) about a very successful organization in the Los Angeles area known as the Inside Edge. This is a once-a-week early morning breakfast club that serves as a network for assorted

new paradigm concepts. They plan on starting a club in Washington based on the LA model. Each club is limited to 100 members. When that number is reached, a second club is formed.

Telephone call from Tom Bearden. He and his associates have heard that there have been some unannounced changes in Patent Office procedures that can result in the DOD issuing a Security Order on certain areas declared to be military critical technologies. I checked with the Patent Office and they confirmed that there are two DOD Military Critical Technologies Lists, one unclassified and the other classified. Both Tom and I have been running on parallel tracks in attempting to develop energy devices that are not based upon current technology. Bearden's concern is that new energy technology may, by the above administrative procedure, be restricted from getting into general public use. I will learn the facts.

I had a second visit from Benedict Arul. Arul is the brilliant individual who claims to have invented a new science. I am going to get him in touch with Glenn Olds to see if the Alaskan Pacific University can provide him with some support. You may recall that Glenn has indicated that he is going to establish at his university a new School of Uninvented Science.

February 2, 1987

Visit by Charles Spence, Vice President for Programs and Research, the John Fetzer Foundation. It appears that Fetzer will be supporting the planned November 21, 22, 1987 (change of dates from October) Washington conference on Exceptional Human Performance. Spence asked if you would be willing to send the 85 year old John Fetzer a letter that commends and encourages him and his foundation for the support they are providing researchers in subtle energy and other areas of interest to us. I will draft a letter for your consideration.

I provided you with a memorandum on my conversation with Brendan O'Regan and his anticipated support for Claudine Schneider and possible hearings on mind/body medical research. In a subsequent conversation with a psychic friend, I have the feeling that work being done at Brown University by Albert Dahlberg, M.D., Ph.D., may be included in these hearings. Dr. Dahlberg has been working for several years with a female psychic called Winter (full name is Teresa A. Pope). Winter provides Dahlberg with diagnostic data.

As you recall, this week involved a day of U.S. Association of the Club of Rome activity. Jack Fobes has written you a letter thanking you for the support and time you gave to the meeting. More interesting was the material that Alexander King sent you about the meeting held in October at lake Issyk-Kul in Kirghizia with world intellectuals including Americans Arthur Miller, Peter Ustinov and James Baldwin. When I read the material that King sent, I was reminded of our conversation with Glenn Olds at lunch on February 6, when he was proposing Alaska and Alaska Pacific University as a site for a U.S./USSR conference. The subject that we came up with as a conference subject was joint applied technology to meet world energy, food and medical needs. Since Gorbachev got aboard with the outcome of the Issyk-Kul meeting, we might also consider an Alaskan conference that addresses conference techniques. Specifically, the Statement of the Issyk-Kul Forum calls for "A new way of non-linear thinking, imagination, new insights and new anticipative initiatives." King in his comments about the meeting talks about, "creative and intuitive approaches which might contribute to the understanding of the global problems." I think that Glenn would be willing to host a conference that used highly intuitive, non-linear styles of information gathering and planning. I bet the Soviets would play, but I'm not sure about "official" U.S. participation.

I spent about 45 minutes with Glenn and Eva Olds with Mrs. Jihan Sadat in her Northern Virginia home.

February 9, 1987

Conversation with Wink Franklin about the poll that you suggested at the awards ceremony. Both Noetics and Fetzer are interested in such a poll. Wink talked with George Gallup about it. I will contact Gallup and if he is interested, share the inputs I have been gathering about such a poll.

I sent a letter to the two Office of Science and Technology Policy staff members whom I have been discussing the Spring conference on Exceptional Human Capabilities that you asked Bill Graham to host. They had asked for my input and outline of the meeting. This is an early stage and they have not yet shown any initiative. Their response to my suggestions will tell us where this idea may go.

January 30, 1987

January 26, 1987

My memo to you on January 28, detailed the activity of the January 26,27 meeting with Adm Jim Watkins and Alice McGill. I have had several phone discussions with Alice since that meeting. She has called to go over some of the planning details of the Personal Excellence Program.

On January 30 I spent three hours with Dr. Paul G. Huray and Lee W. Rivers, staff members of the Office of Science and Technology Policy. Deborah Wince had arranged for this meeting. Most of the meeting was spent answering general and detailed questions about psychic and other anomalous phenomena. Both of them are personally interested and open minded on the subjects. Huray is a physicist from the University of Tennessee and the Oak Ridge National Laboratory. Rivers is on a Fellowship from the Allied Corporation. Neither of them know Bill Graham very well and were cautious in estimating how our proposal will go with him. They both said that some sections of the President's State of the Union address gave leverage to push for the conference. They were referring to Reagans comments on excellence and competitiveness. I asserted that the conference we proposed would be a very logical follow up on the President's statement. Wince had not shared with them the two page outline of the meeting. I told them I would send them a copy of this updated in view of Reagan's speech, and said that Graham had indicated to us that he had no disagreement with an agenda based upon "human potential."

Conversations with Noetics on the proceedings of the Consciousness Symposium. They asked me to send the original copies of the papers given by our speakers. This is a last round of editorial review. The plan is to send galley proof copies of the papers to the speakers for a final review.

Dr. LaVerne called and said that he was not able to give his presentation to any Members last week. He did brief someone on Congressman Harry Reid (D-NV), and later gave the presentation to Rev. Pat Robertson. He said that Robertson was enthusiastic about it. In a later call he said that D'Amato's office was going to set up an appointment for him to brief Fletcher. He said that if that didn't get any action that he would go to the Washington Times with the material. I wished him well and told him that we did not see any additional roll for us to play.

Attached is a revised draft of comments for you to use at Elizabeth McAdams' ceremony. They combine your material with that which I previously had sent you.

December 21, 1987 - January 4, 1988

Annual leave. Received a call from Uri Geller on December 20th, his birthday. He sounded a bit sad. I suspect that he assumed that we knew this was his birthday and was disappointed that personal greetings did not pour in. I gave him best wishes from both of us.

Received a call from Ginette Matacia who identified herself as a psychic who wanted to meet and discuss a possible working relationship. I have known her father, Louis, for several years. He is a very successful dowser in the local area. Ms Matacia and I met and had a long conversation about her psychic experiences. According to her, she has done some work with the FBI, but appears to work more with private investigators on civil and criminal cases. She volunteered to work with me and I am using her on a robbery case.

Visit with Ann Brooke from Idaho. She contacted me through Leo Sprinkle (University of Wyoming). You met Sprinkle at the University of Virginia meeting of the Society of Scientific Exploration. Mrs. Brooke shared a very detailed account of her UFO experiences.

January 4 - 15, 1987

Meeting with Col John Alexander. The Army has been unyielding in its decision to transfer him out of the Washington, D.C. area, and his command has either been unsuccessful or unwilling to battle to keep him in his position at the Army Laboratory Command. The result has been that Alexander has submitted his retirement papers, and will retire at the end of March. The special project that he was organizing will either now abort or perhaps be transferred to private industry with government funding sought to do the research. I feel that it is important to brief President Carter on this planned effort, and as we have discussed, will draft a letter to him requesting an opportunity to brief him on the project.

Dick Gunther, from Los Angeles, visited to discuss what plans we have to establish a National Commission on Human Potential. I told him that we were waiting for the first draft of the NSF funded research being done by the Institute of Noetic Sciences on past government sponsored research in this field. Noetics has told both of us that the first draft should be ready in early February. I am working with Wendy Senor on Henry Waxman's staff on this effort.

In a telephone conversation with Leo Sprinkle, University of Wyoming, (you met him at the University of Virginia meeting of the Society of Scientific Exploration) he identified a Newport, RI resident, Dick Farley, as a possible source of research support into UFO phenomena. I understand that Ken Ring is currently interested in researching psychological post effects phenomena of people who claim to have been UFO contactees.

Early this week I reminded you of your annual contribution to the Club of Rome.

I visited one of my friends in the intelligence community and asked him to assess what interest his organization might have in an approach to them to participate in a problem solving application of applied psychic phenomena. This person is very senior in his organization and very familiar with psychic phenomena. He thought that the privately funded Task Force approach that I have discussed with you that would involve the Center for Applied Anomalous Phenomena and members of selected government agencies and offices was a good one. However, his view was that at the present time the intelligence community would not participate even at no cost to them. He suggested that the best place to start would be with the Department of Interior (for psychic archaeological applications) or any other department where issues of classified material and projects did not arise.

It seems reasonable now that the first leaks about the Friday Geller meeting came as the result of arranging to use S407. Andy Plattner of U.S. News and World Report called before the meeting took place. In addition to the news articles we have seen on the meeting, I have taken calls from: Andy Plattner (twice); Maggie Hall, a self identified free-lance journalist (twice) who wants to do a serious interview with you on the subject; Don Harney, NY Post who said they were considering a follow-up story and had contacted James Randi; David Jones, London Times; John Connelly, London Sunday Times (twice) with most of his questions concerning arms control; Jane Whitmore, Newsweek, who suggested a serious interview. Whitmore gave me a number of details about Geller at Geneva and wanted me to confirm them; Steve Dujack, Foreign Service Journal (and a member of the local psi debunker club); Shelagh Kaplan, Common Cause; and the editor of the Skeptical Inquirer, the journal for the Committee for Scientific Investigations into Claims of the Paranormal. This Committee is Geller's chief nemesis. I have responded to all of these with the limited simple truth we agreed upon, i.e. there was a private meeting, people from Congress and the executive branch were

invited to listen to Mr. Geller express his concern about what the Soviets are doing in psychic research and applied psychokinesis. Most of the callers had your, Fascell and Stokes' names and wanted confirmation of them. No one really argued when I told them that since it was a private meeting I could not discuss who was invited or who attended.

April 27, 1987

Press inquiries about the Geller meeting continued into this week. The last to come in were from the London Sunday Times. They appear to be dusting off the article they didn't run about Geneva, Kappleman, the Soviets and Geller. In persistent questioning I reaffirmed that there was no Geller/arms control link.

In a telephone conversation with Geller I learned that he has been as beleaguered by the press as we have been. Newsweek and the London Sunday Times have been particularly attentive. He was told by the London Sunday Times that the U.S. Mission had released a photograph of himself, yourself, Kappelman and a Soviet arms negotiator at Geneva. Geller asked why we would do that. Of course I had no answer then or now. I hope it wasn't a casual decision, but one based upon some hope that it would help rather than cause more damage. Geller had told the press that he was invited to Geneva to perform. He has been questioned a number of times whether he had been asked by the United States to negotiate arms control, and whether he was asked to influence the minds of the Soviet negotiators. He told me he answered no to both of these questions. He did tell the press that for some time when he has been in the presence of world leaders he sends a mental message of peace, "I project peaceful thoughts to world leaders." That may be a subheadline in an upcoming London Sunday Times. Geller expressed concern for both you and Kappelman.

With Iran-Gate hearings starting I assume that this will be pushed out of the media's mind, although there still will be requests for interviews with you on what your interests are in the subject. I recommend that you do not give any interviews on this subject for some time. Later, it may be helpful and even necessary in an attempt to mend some arms control fences to select the best reporter and media we can, and give a broad, philosophical interview that takes the safe ground of promoting basis research.

Our intelligence and other friends were not hurt by this and

Meeting with Professor John Tsu, JFK University, and Robert Yang, president, Indo Financial Services (Fresno, CA), and an activists for the Laos Mong community in the United States. Mr. Yang will be sending a letter to you about the Laos situation in SE Asia.

Several telephone calls from Marcello Truzzi and Brenda Dunne on the subject of a possible NBC feature news program on the National Research Council's report on Human Capabilities. Truzzi had heard from Ray Hyman, a CSICOP member of the NRC committee. Apparently Hyman has been sent a copy of Jahn's letter to the NRC, and will be responding to Jahn's comments on the report. According to Truzzi, who can be dramatic, he thought that NBC was trying to fuel the fire for maximum interest content. Hyman may have suggested to Truzzi that he suspected we or Jahn was feeding the media. I assured Truzzi that we expected the principals to do the investigating, and had not spoken to the media about it. He wanted me to call Hyman. I suggested instead to Truzzi and Dunne that Jahn and Hyman should be talking to each other. I understand that such a conversation subsequently took place. There was one element of realism in all of this. Bob and Brenda had given an interview about their lab activity to the same NBC reported that reportedly called Hyman for an interview on the NRC report.

A document has been located in the National Archives that appears to refer to the MJ-12 document that we heard about at last years MUFON conference held at the American University. The MJ-12 group is alleged to have been the very senior scientific and intelligence organization that had responsibility to investigate UFO sightings and to exploit crashed hardware. The document we were told about has not been authenticated or proven bogus. There is an effort underway to try to authenticate the one page document located in the Archives that refers to a MJ-12 meeting in the Eisenhower administration.

I received a call from, Lee Graham, an aerospace-technician in California. He said that Bill Moore, the researcher who gave the dinner talk at the MUFON conference on the MJ-12 document had identified you as having been at the conference. Mr. Graham said as the result of a Freedom of Information Act request for UFO and Stealth information he was visited at his company by a FBI agent and an Air Force general with the data he requested. He was allowed to read the information, but not allowed to keep a copy. According to Graham, when he showed them a SNOWBIRD document, the Air Force general said it was authentic and to keep up the good work in trying to get this information into the public domain.

Graham said that the general was introduced to him a "Mickey." The SNOWBIRD document stated that the U.S. government is in contact with an extraterrestrial civilization.

Later, Graham said that he identified "Mickey" from a photograph as Major General Michael C. Kerby. Kerby is Director of the Air Force Office of Legislative Liaison. I called General Kerby, he visited and we had a conversation on the subject. He denied knowing or meeting Graham and gave the standard AF line on Project Blue Book that established before it was closed down that there was nothing of substance to UFO reports.

Two recent magazine articles on the subject suggest that George Bush is the current head of the successor organization of MJ-12, and that our very successful Stealth technology is directly related to technology given to us over the years by cooperative extraterrestrials.

March 7, 1988

Conversation with Tom Hurley, Institute of Noetic Sciences. I called Tom to check on the status of the survey that the Institute is conducting on government sponsored research into human capabilities. Tom said they are having a very difficult time in getting specific responses to their inquiries from government agencies. I had hoped to use this survey as background for the legislation we are drafting to establish the National Commission on Human Potential. However, it is clear that we should not wait for its availability. I have collected 18 examples of previously legislated national commissions and I expect to get the first draft completed by March 18.

Whitley Strieber called and will be visiting Washington on March 17th. I will take him and his friend, John Glideman, a research psychologist, to lunch. You met Strieber, author of Communion, at Shirley MacLaine's suite last summer.

Bill Harman has sent me a draft copy of a research proposal on the causality question that he is considering sending to the National Science Foundation. I will give him written comments on it.

Subj: Dayton, Ohio conference on extra-terrestrial intelligence

On November 29, 1988, John Alexander Hal Puthoff and I joined UFO researchers William Moore and Jamie Shandera at a private home in Dayton to meet with two individuals who assert to have special knowledge of government activities with extra-terrestrial intelligence here in the United States. One of them appeared on the October 14th two hour TV special on UFOs. This was "Condor" who along with "Falcon" were voice and visually disguised.

Both of the two we met currently work for the government. For the most part, their stories are based upon information they have heard from others. Both have had a few personal experiences that are directly relevant to proof of the claims they assert, but I am not currently persuaded that what they think is happening is actually real. There are other plausible explanations, and they agree that this is the case.

Briefly, the story is that sometime in the 1950's, the U.S. government entered into an agreement with an alien culture that allowed them to establish at least one base in the United States. The location discussed is in Nevada, known as Area 51.

This story has been around for a number of years, and I have absolutely no idea whether or not it is in any way correct. There are a variety of permutations to the story, some extremely bizarre.

The person, Falcon, who claims to have first hand knowledge and proof of the basic claim, and I will meet later this month or in early January. As in the recent meeting, Alexander and Puthoff will also be at this planned meeting.

Correspondence and telephone calls from Mankind Research Foundation about the December 2-5, 1988, Seventh International Conference on Psychotronic Research at West Georgia College. Attached is a flyer about the Conference, and a one page fact sheet on Psychotronics. The Soviets are using this term rather freely. I'm not sure that everyone means the same thing when they refer to psychotronics.

Much communication over last week's UFO TV program. I have been contacted by many of the serious researchers in the field who had nothing to do with the production. Their views span a wide spectrum. Some thought that it was terrible, full of errors and outright falsehoods. John Alexander is in this category. Others felt that the production was poorly done, i.e., the incessant background music and the stilted cue card reading and almost complete lack of spontaneity, but nevertheless contained some new and possibly important information. Hal Puthoff fits somewhat in this category. Hal pointed out that the computer graphics of the ET head and body was a very expensive undertaking, and stood out as a diamond in an otherwise economically done production. He said that a frame by frame check of this section showed some initials on the graphic: "FTD" and "SYM." The thought is that the graphics may have been produced by or for the U.S. Air Force Foreign Technology Division. FTD has long been rumored to be the focus of Air Force interest and activity in ET matters. No researcher I have spoken with had seen these graphics before the TV show. The thought is that they were made available to the producer from official government sources. This supports the thesis that the government is making a backdoor announcement of knowledge and activity with ETs.

Following your conversation with Senator Glenn, I talked to Len Weiss, Staff Director, Committee of Government Affairs (44751). Weiss and I had a long discussion about a basis of a possible Congressional investigation. He then turned me over to a junior staff person, Lowell Soloman. It is my opinion after talking to Weiss and Soloman, that the TV producer, Michael Silegman is not tell the truth when he told Bill Moore that he is talking directly with a Glenn staffer on interviewing Falcon and Condor.

I now have the services of Albert A. Dahlberg as an intern. I have given him a research project that will support a strategy of getting both political and financial support for the Commission. Al's father is an M.D. at Brown University.

January 19, 1987

Weekend of 17-19 January. Quarterly board of Trustee meeting of the American Society of Psychical Research at New York City. This organization is finally pulling out of serious financial problems. At least it is no longer living off its capital. A modest amount of funds are becoming available to support research, something it has not been able to do for four years. Carole Austen was a house guest for the weekend. She is leaving Virginia Beach, moving back to California. We did some channeling on problems she has helped with in the past.

Conversation with Barbara McNeill at the Institute of Noetic Sciences on the status of the proceedings of our Consciousness Symposium. The final hold up has been computer format incompatibility between the system that Jack Spang has in his office and the system they will publish on in California. Several computer support firms had assured Noetics that they could easily transfer the data from one system to the other. It did not turn out to be that easy. Barbara said that this problem will be solved very soon, and that the book should be out of the printers within a month.

I hope that you saw Shirley MacLaine's two part TV special based upon her book, Out on a Limb. It was aired on January 18-19. The consensus I have heard is that the lay and professional psi community is pleased over the way it was produced and acted. There was some concern that it might be a set back rather than positive for the field. I thought that it was very well done.

Dr. Albert LaVerne has been in town this week. He contacted me and asked for an appointment to give you the 35mm slide presentation he has developed from the NASA photographs of the Challenger accident. I told him that your schedule simply could not be adjusted to set this up, but that I was available to look at it if it had new material I had not previously seen. He assured me that it did. Previously I had suggested to him that he could not expect to keep people in a briefing on this subject for more than 30 minutes; That if he included all the religious faces and symbols he claims to see, and to compound the briefing with his theories of good and evil, he would not be taken seriously except perhaps in the theological and philosophical communities. He assured me that he had taken my comments seriously and that he now had a thirty minute briefing that was scientific and only addressed the engineering problems of the accident. The

Presentation he gave me in my office lasted fifty minutes and would have gone longer if I had not ended it. He was unable to keep out religious references. Indeed, he had some new material and some of it is quite striking, but I cannot see how anyone in NASA or elsewhere in government can use it except in a personal spiritual way. He said that he had appointments to give the briefing to Moynihan and D'Amato, and expected also to get an appointment with Hecht. I have not heard further from him whether the appointments were kept and the briefings given. He was staying in a motel in Falls Church and suffered a fall the first day he was here, injuring his hand and bruising and cutting his face. With his bushy beard LaVerne already is a unique appearing person. With his recent wounds and assorted band-aids and sling for his arm he is even more outstanding. His objective remains the same, to get the briefing to the president.

After a long conversation with Alice McGill it is obvious that things are not going well on the National Program for Personal Excellence with Jim Watkins. Alice feels that Watkins does not have the drive to get the program planned, funded and implemented. Most importantly, he apparently is sitting on Alice and not allowing her to use her considerable skills and contacts to move things along. Apparently he is a spellbinding speaker on the subject, but that is about all. On January 26 and 27, Ann Young and I will participate in a working group meeting to discuss the program.

Chuck Spense, Vice President for Research for the Fetzer Foundation will visit me on February 2. Fetzer has been requested to support the October Exceptional Human Capability conference.

Jack Fobes, U.S. Association for the Club of Rome, was up on the Hill this week. He checked the space that Dante Fascell had arranged for the February 4th meeting, 2105 Rayburn. Jack called, very stressed, said that the room wasn't nearly large enough or adequate for the program. The Algerian Ambassador will be speaking. He asked me for assistance in getting a more suitable room on the Senate side. He said that he was going to call Peter Galbraith to ask for the Foreign Relations Committee room. That apparently was arranged. I have drafted some brief comments for you to introduce Alexander King. Jerry has the draft for review.

Attached to this report is a proposed draft of remarks for you to make at the International Foundation for Survival Research, February 8, at Los Angeles. I am not planning on attending this ceremony.

Jack Spong called me this week after being unable to get to you to return the calls you have made to him. We discussed the status of the publication of the proceedings of the Consciousness Symposium. Wink Franklin has sent him copies of parts of the manuscript for him to see some additional editing they have been doing at Noetics. Jack is pleased with this work. I have placed several calls to Wink to get an estimate of when the book will be published, but he has not returned my calls.

Joe Montville called and expressed support for Ambassador John McDonald as president of the U.S. Peace Institute. He and John have been working together for the past several years. Subsequent to the call he sent copies of material he has presented recently. I have already sent this on to you.

I have had several recent conversations with Paul Messier, Office of Research, Department of Education. August 18, 1986

Last week I assisted Dennis ^RViley in the Providence office on the Leonard Kortick/McDonnell Douglas visit. I called Jack Houck at Huntington Beach, CA. Jack was the McDonnell engineer who talked with Kortick when he flew out at his own expense to discuss his anti-gravity and future propulsion concepts. Jack said that there was nothing in his ideas that were useable at their present state of conceptualization. I suggested to Dennis that Kortick be urged to contact and work with the engineering department at Brown or URI to develop his concepts.

The August 15-16 meeting at Charlottesville on the energy program went well. The two inventors/engineers worked well together. This was their first meeting. I am in the process of raising funding for two prototype devices. Approximately \$30K will be required. 7

Long conversation with Dr. LaVerne and Mark Everett, owner of the photographic studio where work on the NASA transparencies is being done. Everett is somewhat spooked by the results he is getting. He said that his face appeared on one of the super enlargements. I suspect that LaVerne may be an unwitting PK agent for what is appearing in the photographs. If that is correct, it is almost as interesting as the results that LaVerne is after, i.e., to establish the "cause" of the Challenger explosion. I sent a letter to Everett to keep him on the project, and then called LaVerne and told him that after the first useable photographic results were available, I wanted to conduct an experiment with him that would determine whether or not his psychokinetic energy is involved. He agreed to this.

Discussion with Eldon Byrd on the Uri Geller/Randi correspondence. We jointly came to the view that this may well be Randi's Bravo Project, i.e., Randi is behind the mailing of the letters and tapes that accuse him of homosexual proclivity. The intent is to get someone else involved in duplicating and circulating the material and then to accuse them of originating the project. Eldon sent me a copy of a slanderous letter that Randi sent him on the subject. We also discussed the need for a meeting involving government and non-government scientists on Tom Beardon's concern about suspected Soviet application of Tesla's scalar RF theories. In a subsequent conversation with Joe Dick, I learned that Jim Wilson of the National Academy of Sciences has been thinking along the same lines. I have been requested by several others to pull a meeting together on this subject. Scalar RF theories would be a technological application of what is currently called psychotronics. The theories have been around for

a long time, and some people claim to have made successful applications. Most scientists ignore the claims and the field.

Arranged for the Center for Applied Anomalous Phenomena to sponsor a presentation by Patricia St. John at the Cosmos Club on September 30. St. John will talk about her work with dolphins and autistic children. She is an outstanding telepath, and has been able to teach telepathic techniques to parents and medical personnel. This is an excellent example of applied psi. We agreed over a year ago that she would label this "non-verbal communication." That has been successful, and she has had no problems in getting medical personnel to participate. A flyer of this event is attached.

Lunch and conversation with Bernard Gittelsohn. He is writing a book on psi to be published by Simon and Schuster.

Completed the article, "Sigh a Bit for Psi," and sent it to Mary Maruca, the editor of Courier, the house journal for the National Park Service. A copy of this article is attached.

Met with the Noetics Executive Planning Committee. Worked on schemes to boost sales for Willis' September 12 lecture. I urged the development of a Noetics East style that would be recognizable and appreciated by those who participate in Noetics functions. After the experience of arranging for the Harman lecture we should end up with a "how to" handbook for other volunteers to use for similar future events. ?

Conversation with Wanda Hollenbeck, Jack Spong's secretary, about the Symposium proceedings transcript. She said that Rinpoche and Groff's papers have now been keyed and the corrections I made on the other papers have also been keyed. I am working on the Question and Answer segments. These had not been edited, and one side of one of the tapes had not been transcribed. When this is accomplished I will make corrections, edit the questions and answers and send them to Jack for his decision on which ones will be included in the book. After that decision, Rhea White will make an index using the final draft of the transcript.

August 25, 1986

Continued working on the Q & A draft. All but two Tibetan words deciphered, and one name used by a questioner.

Call from Scott Feltmeyer, who identified himself as a reporter for the National Inquirer (800) 522-2301. He sounds as if he is a new reporter, and certainly knows little about the psi field. For example, he wanted to know what the U.S. and the U.S.S.R. was doing in the psi field, but did not know any of the published material on the subject, including the book by Ostrander and Schroeder, Psi Behind the Iron Curtain, that was sponsored by

the National Inquirer. I gave him leads to various labs and researchers.

Visit by Stan Linnander, a Swede who has done some psychical research in Europe and the United States. We discussed work he did with a psychic and a eight year comma patient. His assessment was that the psychic did make telepathic contact, and got the patient to make eye and finger movements that the family and doctors said were new.

Call from a contact in the intelligence community indicating that the Agency is showing interest in policy issues associated with Radiation Frequencies/human relationships. This would include the scalar technology discussed above.

It is a very complex plan involving raising \$200K plus in the U.S. and Canada, leasing three aircraft in the U.S., flying to Africa, and with Cuban MIG cover, fly in and bring out hundreds.

January 21 - 25, 1991

On January 21, meet with Rabbi Korff for slightly over two hours. He asked what role, what position, he will have in the Foundation. I assume that he will at least try to assist us in fund raising if we can identify a real position for him that meets his ego needs. We won't know whether he can produce unless we can be creative and identify a "position."

I suggest that he be designated the Chairman of the Foundation's Endowment Committee. That he be charged with raising an endowment that ultimately will allow us to operate from its income. He would like to be a player on the Board, but we can ask for his ideas without giving him a vote over what happens in the Foundation.

He asked for two documents to assist him in fund raising:

- (a) A one or two page document that makes the case for the need of the Foundation.
- (b) A statement of the modus operandi of the Foundation and one or two of the planned Centers.

On January 21 I also met with Major General Zhang Naicheng and his assistant LTC Jin Zhu, military attaches of the People's Republic of China. They had been very helpful in arranging certain parts of my visit to China in September 1990. I gave them a summary of the outcome of the visit and talked about a possible future visit in 1991.

As would be expected, a number of my sensitive contacts have been communicating with me about issues of the Middle East war. I have been screening these and have passed some of them on to individuals who understand the sources and appreciate the inputs.

On January 24, I received a letter from Laurance Rockefeller saying that he would fund the first year of the Foundation and the first Center at a level of \$312,500. The first funds will be \$126,500, followed on June 1 by \$126,00. The delivery will be from Chase Manhattan Bank via stocks equal to the amount donated. The letter said that Chase will contact us for instructions to deliver. What I will ask them to do is to sell the stock and send a check to the Foundation.



Dear Dr. Jones:

Please be advised that I represent Dick Farley, who has received the notice of termination of his employment bearing your signature and dated March 4, 1994.

You are hereby notified that my client considers that his discharge is in violation of his employment rights, and that The Human Potential Foundation, Inc., is liable to him for damages, including punitive damages, under the principles of unlawful discharge of a whistle-blowing employee.

It is also a distinct possibility that, in addition to HPF, the directors and officers, including yourself, may be individually liable.

Mr. Farley's claim is clearly stated and supported by the attached documents, which are representative of a large number of letters, memoranda and other records in Mr. Farley's possession. His claim can be outlined as follows:

1. As of early June, 1993, the Foundation was enjoying reasonably good financial stability and had a promising future, in large part due to the efforts, energies and skills of Dick Farley.
2. In June, 1993, Mr. Farley became aware of the sexual harassment allegations against you. At that time, he, along with other concerned employees, confronted you with these allegations. At that time, according to my client, he and the other employees received assurances that the personal misconduct would not recur, and that you would notify the members of the board as to the problem and the proposed solutions.

3. According to my client, it became apparent to him as of August 23, 1993, that you had not informed the board of these negative developments, which were having a demonstrably damaging effect on employee morale and performance, and which had the potential of ruining the effectiveness of the Foundation. At that time, Mr. Farley confronted you with the attached memorandum, which he had proposed to direct to the members of the board. According to Mr. Farley, you tore up the memorandum, assuring him that, instead, you would go to the board and take care of the problem in a responsible way, making full disclosure to them.

4. There appears to be no evidence that you, in fact, ever went to the board about this problem. Mr. Farley recently became aware that the pattern of sexual harassment has continued, according to allegations of Ms. McCarthy, despite your previous assurances.

5. Beginning on almost precisely the same date (August 23) on which Mr. Farley confronted you with his proposed memorandum to the board, the fortunes of the Foundation began a downturn. In the ensuing months, projects were neglected; fund-raising efforts were virtually abandoned; operations were scaled back; and the Foundation is now faced with extinction.

6. It will be Mr. Farley's contention that, rather than confront the board with your problems in an earnest effort to get the management of the Foundation on the right course, you chose to save yourself the obvious embarrassment and opted to let the Foundation wither and die. Because Mr. Farley was the person who had confronted you most directly in the past, and because he remained the one who had the greatest remaining potential as a "whistle-blower," it will be his contention that you engineered the termination of his employment, using the guise of elimination of his position.

It is my opinion that the facts, as presented by Mr. Farley, make out a case for wrongful discharge from employment. Applicable state and federal laws afford Mr. Farley the remedies which we seek, and which include compensatory damages, punitive damages, attorneys' fees and court costs.

Copies of this letter of notification are being provided to individual members of the board because it is Mr. Farley's belief, and the record presented to me would certainly seem to support that belief, that you have previously concealed from the board material facts which, if known to the board and properly acted upon by the board, would have prevented the financial demise of the Foundation. Thus, Mr. Farley is not willing to assume that you will give to the board members the notification to which they are entitled. Such notification is especially important in light

of their potential exposure to individual liability, and also constitutes a good-faith effort on Mr. Farley's part that there be no further betrayal of the interests of the Foundation's principal benefactor, Mr. Rockefeller.

You are requested to notify the Foundation's liability insurance carrier of this claim immediately upon your receipt hereof.

We look forward to having the opportunity of discussing this claim with a representative of the Foundation or your insurance carrier. In the meantime, you are cautioned not to interrupt the Foundation's payroll obligations to Mr. Farley, inasmuch as such retaliation would be the basis for a further claim for punitive damages. Mr. Farley is willing to continue to discharge his responsibilities to the Foundation until the date his termination becomes effective and final.
