

Dear Mr. Sherman:

This is in response to your request, received in this office on March 20, 1997 under the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552. Your March 18, 1997 request to the Office of Science and Technology Policy (OSTP) sought records pertaining to any documents, visual materials and related information, etc. regarding sightings of anomalous aerial objects, unconventional aerial vehicles, unknown submerged objects and extraterrestrial intelligence on and above the planet.

Since your last request, FOIA 96-23 dated October 23, 1996, we were unable to locate any records responsive to your request. If you consider this to be a denial of your request, appeals may be made in writing within 30 days of receipt of this letter. Both the letter and the envelope should be clearly marked "Freedom of Information Act Appeal." Determinations of administrative appeals are required within 20 working days.
