RE: REQUESTED PERSONAL MEETING WITH PRESIDENT JIMMY CARTER

Dear Mr. Reiman:

As a result of our interview with you at the Executive Office Bldg., June 24, 1977 and following our recent phone conversation of Oct. 7, I am sending this letter to formally request that a personal meeting be arranged with President Jimmy Carter for Charlotte Blob (Director of UFO Education Center) and her associates. Briefly, the reasons for requesting such a meeting are as follows.

- 1) On March 31, 1976, Presidential Candidate Jimmy Carter --as a result of our questions to him at the Appleton Airport News Conference (Appleton, Wis.) --- made the historic declaration for the first time that, as President, he would release all the secret government information concerning UFO's.
- 2) Immediately following that News Conference, I spoke personally with Mr. Carter telling of our extensive evidence and films, and the humanitarian work of Charlotte Blob and UFO Education Center. Mr. Carter thanked me for the offer to view the films, etc., and said a meeting could be arranged sometime following the election.
- 3) The President needs to know that there is far more to this Field than paperbacks, statistics, or academic speculation. ALL PEOPLE FROM ALL BACKGROUNDS ARE INVOLVED. For this purpose, UFO Education Center is unique in its non-profit service of Direct Counseling -- on a 24-hour, "Open Line" telephone, available across the country. This is a humane approach: an effort to develop a profound dialogue, by means of a sound, educational program, at all levels --- universities; schools; community and religious groups; State, Local, and Federal officials; law enforcement agencies; and concerned citizens and leaders in many other countries.
- 4) It is urgent for the President to know that a vast number of citizens acknowledge the objective reality of peaceful Visitations. Thousands, even millions, have a voice to be heard on the basis of their own experiences.
- 5) It is URGENT that the President learn from us, first-hand, the unprecedented near-landings correlated with his Presidential Campaign. The data are outstanding-----reported exclusively to UFO Education Center by highly-credible, unrelated witnesses including professors, technicians, officials, farmers, and veterans!

The inference here is clear. The people coming in these amazing craft are quite alert to President Carter's leadership and potential for benefiting this planet. The facts behind these correlations have been carefully kept from the press or sensational exploitation. We are sincere in wishing to keep this matter confidential ---BUT, he must be told the facts in-person.

6) Our Director, Charlotte Blob, is working closely and directly with Margarita Lopez-Portillo, sister of Mexican President Jose Lopez-Portillo. This concerns the release of information through educational programming on Television, Radio, and Cinema throughout Mexico, concerning these Visitations.

7) It is important for Presidents Jimmy Carter and Jose Lopez Portillo to work together to help bring the seriousness of these Visitations before the United Nations. Recent events in Mexico are amazing.

8) In accordance with President Carter's statement to me on March 31, 1976, we are now ready to meet with him, to show the daylight, close-up films, the documentations and evidence - - - to show the need for solid, public education in this Field.



Dear Margaret Costanza:

Our mutual friend and colleague, Ruth Gage-Colby, has urged me to get in touch with you at once. She felt that you would be especially interested to learn of the data (enclosed) and their beautiful implications for President Carter and the future of this planet. (Although this letter is long, much is of international importance.)

(While --- some of the events took place nearly one year ago, we have purposely and respectfully waited this period of time, largely at the request of President Carter, himself. In March of 1976 during the Wisconsin Primary campaign, he told me personally that he would like to view the evidence, as I had suggested, but that it would be best to contact him after the election. This we did via Fran Voorde, Dir. of Scheduling, then in Americus, Georgia headquarters. We were also in contact with the Conservation office at the Transition headquarters: Kitty Schirmer, Jim Rathlesberger, Carleton Neville, etc. Due to the pressure of extensive briefings during the transition period, Mr. Carter instructed Fran Voorde to send us the warm and positive reply that explained the situation at-hand. I have enclosed copies of this and other letters for your information. Also, you should know that a number of us, as individuals, worked with vigor and dedication to ensure the election of Pres. Carter, especially here in Wisconsin. Charlotte Blob, Director of UFO Education Center, wrote as an individual to many people around the country, in fact thousands received these letters. On October 31, Sunday...just two days before the election, Channel 6 in Milwaukee (ABC-TV) held a highly-publicized, prime-time interview with Charlotte Blob, Catherine Reid, and myself, during which we were questioned about the positions of Mr. Carter and Mr. Ford, vis-a-vis UFO events and presidential policy. We overwhelmingly urged the listeners to support Mr. Carter as the one who had courageously spoken-out to release all the secret files to the public.)

It is important to mention here, that our activity pertains in the broadest possible sense to more than so-called "UFO's". Inspired by the leadership and vision of Charlotte Blob, we are working often 18 hours-a-day to alert citizens' groups, university audiences, law enforcement agencies, and legislative bodies to the dangers of nuclear plants and nuclear testing; the need for viable, creative alternative energy sources, such as solar and 'free' electromagnetic/gravitational mechanisms, etc.; ... a wide range of consumer health issues; and the urgency for a peaceful, dynamic economy based upon a United Space Program, that may benefit all mankind.

As a further reference, there are at least two other persons during the campaign who became acquainted with our work in Wisconsin and around the country. One was Betsy Lorless, for whose scheduling around the state the week before the election we were chiefly responsible. She was working on the Energy Task Force in Atlanta, and was the last person from the headquarters to visit the state before Nov. 2. She was deeply interested in learning more about this Field and Charlotte Blob's work. The other person was Dave Joyner, the advance-man for Mr. Carter's appearances in Wisconsin, who was very encouraging indeed.

Now that President Carter is in-office, Ruth felt that you would be the person to sense the true importance of this information, and to work-out arrangements with the President, himself, for a get-together, as we had discussed already during the Wisconsin Primary. This DOES INVOLVE COOPERATION WITH THE NEW GOVERNMENT OF MEXICO, and this prospect offers limitless possibilities for peace and economic development between the USA and Mexico. (More on this subject later.)

I had the honor to speak face-to-face with (then-candidate) Mr. Carter on two separate occasions last Spring while he was in Wisconsin. But rather than taking them out of context, I will give you the picture, somewhat condensed, in chronological sequence.

It was sometime in the early evening of Tuesday, March 23, 1976 that Mr. Carter arrived in Wisconsin on the first leg of his successful Primary campaign. He arrived from the East, fresh from his victory in North Carolina, and was the celebrated guest of Wisconsin's leading Democrats at a special reception at the Red Carpet Inn near Milwaukee's Mitchell Field. Yet, I am certain history will remember that night for its 'unscheduled' extraterrestrial events!

Jimmy Carter and a vast number of authentic, extraterrestrial spacecraft arrived in the State of Wisconsin virtually simultaneously!

No other agency, organization, or scientific group has received the full account of what was involved, and we have always felt that, to every degree possible, it should be President Carter and his family to be the first ones to know the tremendous scope of just what did happen at 10:30 PM, March 23, 1976.

Knowing how urgent it was for Mr. Carter to be elected President, we decided to hold-back this data from an often-sarcastic or arrogant press corps. One National News Director from a major TV Network was eager for details, but we respectfully declined to discuss the matter any further.

It should here be taken into account that Wisconsin is remarkable not only for its UFO sightings, but for the unprecedented liaison with Law Enforcement Agencies and the public, initiated by Charlotte Blob, Director and internationally-respected university lecturer. In process were a whole series of plans for close coordination by means of special Law Enforcement Seminar/Lectures, at the local, county, state, and regional level. This was done very carefully in order to create a balanced dialogue among citizens, law enforcement and the media. All have cooperated beautifully.

Thus, it was only a couple of hours after Mr. Carter's 'touch-down' for the first time in Wisconsin ---AND EXACTLY AT 10:30 PM --- that the skies literally 'opened-up' over nearly 9,000 square-miles - - -about 1/6 of the area of the State! Furthermore, we later learned it was in this very sector of the State that Mr. Carter had scheduled his appearances for the following two days.

All reports from citizens were directed to this headquarters from around the State by means of radio, newspapers, and the law enforcement authorities, themselves. It was not until the following day, March 24, as the witnesses phoned-in from such a wide area that we realized a major event had taken place. No sooner would we end one conversation, than the phone would begin ringing with another witness on the line. Nothing like this had ever happened before.....or since, for that matter.

In brief, here is an outline of what happened. We logged a total of eighteen excellent reports submitted to us by a good cross-section of the population. These included a Professor of Psychology in the Black Studies Dept. at the University of Wisconsin (Madison) with two carloads of people driving home from a church choir rehearsal; farmers; military veterans; police and sheriff's deputies; a ranking Member of the Dane County Board of Mental Health (in Madison); rural families; approximately twenty additional individuals seated by the large picture window in Madison's famous "Edgewater Restaurant" overlooking Lake Mendota; a Cartography Specialist on the Staff at Univ of Wisconsin, Madison; and a number of others.

What we do know is that these were mostly very close-up, "near-landings" ranging from one-mile,  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile,  $\frac{1}{4}$  mile, and in some cases no more than "two blocks away". They tended to be large "brilliantly burning objects", with broad sparkling, colorful trails in their wakes, finally appearing to "explode" in enormous bursts of light, in a number of cases illuminating the the surrounding countryside for miles around, as "bright as daylight". THIS IS PERHAPS THE MOST REMARKABLE ASPECT: DURING ALL THE SIGHTINGS NOT A SOUND WAS EVER HEARD FROM THESE CRAFT. Most went from East to West, at low altitudes, although a few were seen to descend rapidly, in a direct vertical line, exploding noiselessly just before touching the ground.

The sizes of the craft were considerable, for a number of witnesses a first thought they were burning airplanes just about to crash. Then came the noiseless, brilliant explosions.

The night was perfectly clear, and meteorites must be ruled-out for sightings lasted from 5, 10, 20, and as much as 50 seconds.

Locations ranged from Mineral Point in the southwest, to Appleton-Green Bay-Lake Winnebago area in the northeast, to Kenosha and the Waukegan area in the southeast: a vast area including Madison, Cross Plains, Baraboo, Ripon, Green Lake, Princeton, Pewaukee, etc.

AGAIN, I feel it to be important that President Carter and his family should definitely hear and see the full story, for themselves. In fact, the sooner this could be arranged, the better. This, I stress for several reasons.

These reasons are as follows:

The information, which our Director, Charlotte Blob, would like to share directly with President Carter involves substantive, affirmative breakthroughs for Peace, as a result of her private consultations and meetings "at the very top" of the new Government in Mexico. These consultations were held at the request of those "top" individuals in Mexico, themselves. I would rather not mention a specific name in this letter, but the primary person is well-known to Mr. Carter and around the world.

Specific projects and recommendations to be discussed with the President would be these vital areas:

- 1) Public education concerning these Peaceful, Extraterrestrial Visitations ---in a balanced, humane manner -- in both the USA and Mexico.
- 2) A "Solar Energy" Peace Corps -----mutually sponsored by both Mexico and the USA ----- in experimental regions of the countries: enhancing international harmony, and spearheading the reality of solar energy as an urgently needed, alternative energy source.
- 3) The urgency of 'demilitarizing' all Space Programs on this planet. To continue in this spiraling arms-race into space would be the greatest betrayal of humanity's destiny.
- 4) Correlations of increased frequency of these visitations with strides for Peace, accomplished by individuals and nations.
- 5) Virtually "free-energy", clean and omnipresent, as utilized by the people in these spacecraft. We have everything to gain and to learn by being honest with the American people and all upon this planet. It is the next.....the most significant step in our transformation as a Space Civilization: toward New Energy and World Peace.
- 6) The most recent daylight films of these craft, some obtained with the assistance of local law enforcement agencies and concerned citizens. Also telescopic slides and international evidence as presented at universities and law enforcement Lecture/Seminars.

\* \* \* \* \*

This has been quite a lengthy letter, but I do hope you have had the quiet moment to ponder what is contained herein, and to bring it directly to President Carter's attention. Ruth Gage-Colby has been keenly interested in Charlotte Blob's work for many years now, and she felt that, in view of her developments in Mexico, I should contact you immediately in order to speed this news to the President.

By the way, just to complete the chronology as I promised, this is what transpired after those Wisconsin mass sightings.

On the afternoon of Thursday, March 25, 1976 Gov. Carter stopped to speak with us after his lecture in Green Bay's Port Plaza Inn. We were delightfully overwhelmed by his openness in discussing his own UFO experience, some years previously, and he took extra time, even with the rush of the crowds to go into details for us. He received a packet of materials and newsletters from us concerning Charlotte Blob's outstanding work, wished us well, and expressed surprise as I briefly mentioned the massive sightings two days earlier.

The second occasion occurred the following Wednesday morning, March 31, 1976 in his historic News Conference at Appleton Airport. I use the word "historic" here quite properly; for never before had a Presidential Candidate proposed to personally intervene to release the full information concerning these visitations to the American public. He made this statement to us in answering our question ----as part of that News Conference-----

".....and as President would you air what's "behind closed-doors" today in regards to UFOs?"

Gov. Carter: "I don't know what to make of it. However some of the sightings have been witnessed by 20 to 25 people, law enforcement officers, and everyone in the cockpit of a major airplane, and so forth. But I can't tell you what to make of it. If I knew, I'd be the only one in the world who does. But, yes, I would make these kinds of data available to the public, as President, to help resolve the mystery about it."

"On a public basis?"

Mr. Carter: "Yes, on a public basis."


Interestingly, we had no idea prior to that News Conference that Gov. Carter was going to introduce (of all subjects) his plans for "sunshine laws" at the Federal level on that morning.

I am enclosing additional background material for your information, concerning this international citizens's effort. Currently we are serving as consultants to both law enforcement and legislators, with greater activity than ever. Last September U.S. Senator Proxmire sent his Home Secretary to spend the better-part of an afternoon at our Appleton (Midwest) headquarters discussing and viewing the evidence. I have enclosed also a photocopy of Sen. Proxmire's warm letter of support, encouraging us in our work.

Thank you so much for your kind attention to these matters. There is some urgent and promising groundwork to bring directly to President Carter. I look forward to hearing from you by letter or phone at your earliest convenience. (Appleton headquarters)

The best wishes to you that this may be a year .....for Peace.


Tom Pattison of my staff has reported to me on the meeting held at the U.F.O. midwest headquarters on September 16th.

# Superior beings have visited the planet earth

Imagine seeing a young child playing with a stick of dynamite. You, being of a superior intelligence, would probably try to take away the dynamite for the child's survival.

With that same idea in mind, beings of superior intelligence are trying to keep the inhabitants of earth from destroying themselves and their planet, according to the members of a group who gave a presentation on UFOs (unidentified flying objects) to the Marquette Police Department yesterday.

Five representatives of the UFO Education Center showed films and slides to about 30 Marquette officers, Michigan State Police troopers, members of private security forces and Marquette Senior High School students and teachers at Shiras Planetarium. Police Chief George Johnson invited the representatives from the center's midwest headquarters in Appleton, Wis.

"This intrigues me," the chief said. "I thought it was very educational and the officers enjoyed the program."

A few years ago two Marquette officers saw a kind of glowing vessel hover over Lake Superior before it circled and took off, leaving two airplanes from Sawyer Air Force Base behind, Johnson notes.

"I'm quite sure we're not the only world with life on it," Johnson said. "That's just my personal opinion."

He said he invited the UFO Education Center people to "make the officers aware of this kind of thing, and what to expect and how to report these things to a certain agency."

Charlotte Blob, director of the midwest headquarters, told a news conference before the three-hour afternoon presentation that she became interested in UFOs when she was with the Air Force's Operation Skywatch.

She said the Air Force taught the watchers about the known kinds of airplanes and then talked about UFOs.

"The 'unknowns,' we were told, were extraterrestrial and didn't pose any danger," she told newsmen. She said a restricted textbook for use at the Air Force Academy says earth has been visited by three or four extraterrestrial civilizations in the past 50,000 years.

As a Skywatch worker, she saw a strange, gold vessel. The ship was conical in shape, with windows around the top section. Two Air Force jets tried to intercept the craft. After seemingly toying with the jets, the UFO speeded away.

The ship that she saw was exactly like ships that have been sighted all over the world, she said. Photos of the ship were in the presentation.

Americans have been conditioned by spectacular science fiction to think beings from outside our world are hideous creatures to be feared, Blob said.

"We're expecting the morbidity, rather than understanding that a humanity might be out there," she told newsmen. "We've

been taught that man has the superior intelligence, but we've got to admit that there is intelligence out there."

Given the accomplishments of man in a short time of space travel, she said, why couldn't beings on other planets achieve far more sophistication in thousands of years of space exploration?

Oil and power companies hope to suppress information about UFOs because the extraterrestrial ships use a new energy source that would challenge their monopolies. But even men on earth are beginning to use solar and electromagnetic energy as power sources, similar to power sources used in UFOs sighted all over the world.

Blob says the public's attitude toward UFOs has changed in the past few years.

People no longer question the existence of extraterrestrial vessels, she said. The questions now are "Who are they, and what is the purpose of their visits?"

One possible explanation for the visits is that other beings are trying to save earth people from blowing their planet apart, she said. The earth is slowly changing its polarity, but nuclear blasts jar heavily against those changes.

Consequently, the earth's fault system is seriously weakened raising the possibility of the entire planet falling apart, she said. According to theory, superior beings of other worlds are trying to warn us against our self-destruction.

Persons have trouble accepting that explanation, Blob said, because they're not accustomed to thinking of themselves as children with dynamite in relation to a superior intelligence.

## The Kind of Night for Talking of UFOs

Madison, Wis. — It was a dark and stormy night. The wind whipped cold rain through the naked trees of Capitol Square and streaks of water ran down the Capitol like blood from wounds.

Tomorrow the Legislature would be back in session, but tonight there was to be a "hearing" up in Room 213 Northwest having to do with UFOs.

Then, there it was: It was round and green inside and strips of bright white light ran across it over the heads of the occupants. There were three odd shaped windows along one side and there was a faint buzzing noise.

It was, of course, Room 213 North-

west and the buzzing was from the vacuum cleaner of a maintenance crew working down the hall Wednesday night. There were about 50 people inside the room, including a half dozen legislators. Up in front were three representatives of the UFO Education Center at Appleton. One of them, Tom Helman, a neat, pleasant appearing man of about 40, smiled and welcomed everyone.

### "Bridge of Communication"

"We are here to try to establish a bridge of communication," Helman said. "We want people to be able to talk about the things they are seeing.

"We know that we are being visited by people from other planets. We know that they are peaceful. We know that

they are human beings who work quietly among us and they are not creatures. If you want to see creatures, turn on the evening TV news."

There have been many recent sightings of spacecraft by Wisconsin residents, Helman said. "Virtually half the people of Door County have seen these craft in the last couple of weeks — some at close range."

Helman said the time was ripe for release of all government information concerning UFOs.

### Peaceful Intent

The space people are from other planets in our solar system, Helman said, and they are visiting Earth to try to quietly direct our life along peaceful lines. They

are also very interested in what we are doing with nuclear power, he added, and they want to prevent us from polluting space with misuse of this power.

"We must step aside from our egos long enough to recognize that there can be intelligent life elsewhere," Helman said. "It would be gross arrogance to think that the planet Earth is the only place it exists. With only a fraction of the technical knowledge that the space people have, we could solve all of our energy problems.

"We are only asking that people talk quietly and calmly and admit the truth. Now is the time for candor in the affirmation of all human rights, and the next step would be to acknowledge the peace-

ful human reality of these extraterrestrial visitations."

### Pictures Shown

Helman showed slides and movies of objects he said were spacecraft. These "craft" were generally L-shaped and moved about erratically. Many of the pictures had been taken by the late George Adamski, who founded the work being carried on by Helman and his co-workers. There was also a picture alleged to be of a space person from one of the craft.

Assisting Helman were Haruhisa Koyama, of Japan, and Cuiclahuac Liceage, of Mexico. They are associate directors of the UFO Education Center.

Earlier Wednesday, a press conference had been held in the Assembly parlor. It was sparsely attended by a couple of TV crews and two reporters. The Capitol facilities were used through the courtesy of Rep. David Clarenbach (D-Madison). Clarenbach said he felt the subject

was of public interest and that use of the Capitol was a right that anyone had. Clarenbach was not among the legislators at either the press conference or the hearing.

### Questions Asked

The evening session was followed by questions from the audience, each of which was dealt with articulately by Helman.

Then the round green room was empty and the bright

lights went out. The humming noise could still be heard. Maybe it was a vacuum cleaner down the hall. Maybe it was the Wisconsin Legislature slowly building up dynamic energy and momentum for a productive session, and maybe it was visitors from outer space, idling their engine while they watched what was going on.

Out in the dark and stormy night, the latter seemed the most probable.


They kept us there for well over three hours. It was a fine evening and the citizens and legislators had much to contribute on their own.



- 4) 1/18/77 COLFAX; (ref: Dunn Cty Sher) 7:45PM Miss E.T. & aunt sighted craft "big as the moon, really bright"; followed her car en route from Chippewa Falls to Colfax; very low alt.; landlady, Mrs. L.C., also witness; 9:15PM brother, T. & friend D.S. saw 3 ft. diam. blue light landed in field 200 yds behind house; 1 ft. haze around it; later blue light 2 miles away in uninhabited woods area.
- 5) MEQUON; Daylight! Student J.V. saw scoutcraft hovering less than  $\frac{1}{4}$  mi. away; saw dome, 2 landing gear; large as truck; at first all-white then white above & brown beneath; 3-4 min.; one witness: student D.D.

- 6) 1/21/77 JACKSON COUNTY; nr. City Point & Black River Falls; 9:30PM Mr. G.D. & girlfriend in car, followed by light (white then red/orange) moved up & down, then switched sides of road very fast.
- 7) 1/25/77 Black River Falls vicinity; Mr. & Mrs. D.G. sighted bright, glowing light, yellow; also red & blue; begin 1/7, 1/10 & entire week 1/18 thru 1/25; w. binoc. shape appeared bigger at base than top; close as  $\frac{1}{4}$  mi. away; neighbors alerted & using telescope.
- 8) 1/77 MEQUON; Daylight, close-up! Student J.V. saw scoutcraft hovering less than  $\frac{1}{4}$  mi. away; saw dome, 2 landing-gear; large as a "truck"; all-white changed to white above, brown below; 3 min.; witness: friend D.D.
- 9) 1/25/77 COLFAX; Miss E.T., aunt & boyfriend saw ship bigger than moon; too bright to look at directly; moved forward & back, then near to ground behind woods in field area 10:35 to 11:00 PM.
- 10) 1/27/77 - New London; approx. 9:30 PM; 2 ships "like telephone-poles in the sky, changing colors" several witnesses.
- 11) 1/30/77 ANOKA, MINN.: 8:15 to 9:15 PM; Mr. P.M. & sister-in-law G.M. & families; saw moving, revolving lights; G.M. w. binoc. could see rectangular windows & round dome; above tree tops in W. hdg.N.; static on TV.
- 12) 1/30/77 APPLETON: Mrs. B. & friends; red & green; moving S. then N. then slightly higher; 8:45 to 9:05 PM (ref: Outagamie Sheriff)
- 13) 1/31/77 HUDSON: (+ Bayport, Minn.) Officer Purrington w. Bayport PD; also Miss C.B. saw large, bright craft; red, white, blue/grn, yellow; hovered over Hudson, Wis., low; moved N. & S., 1 mi. each direction in 3 seconds; maneuver then repeated.
- 14) 1/31/77 ANOKA: Mr. P.M., Mrs. G.M. & families watch same object hovering as before. This time airplane approaches craft. Craft speeds away in a flash; returns to same spot instantly after airplane passes.
- 15) 2/2&3/77 ANOKA: Similar sightings as before;
- 16) 2/4/77 BARABOO: CLOSE-UP. Mr. J.L., 8:57 to 9:21PM saw large, round object; "like two dinner-plates with edges together"; as close as  $\frac{1}{4}$  mile away. Mr. J.L. estimated size: "length of two football fields" (600 ft.) 2 military-type helicopters circled craft & 4 others later scanned area. Mr. J.L. was Army Sgt. in Viet Nam, directed air-strikes from ground. Thus, he is professionally-trained observer. Stated: "I don't believe in UFO's, but I know that was no helicopter, and I have never seen anything like it in the military." (CORRELATION with Guadalajara, Mex.)
- 17) 2/4/77 PORTAGE: 8 to 8:30PM; Mr. F.O. & wife see craft 5x larger than bright star; intensely bright "like after-effects of watching welding-arc"
- 18) 2/4/77 MONROE: (date approx.) 8 PM; Mrs. N. saw 5 lights in-a-row; middle one hovered; other 4 moved away. Next PM saw large pink-flourescent object "energy shot-out around it" then disappeared over woods.
- 19) 2/5/77: ROCK SPRINGS; 6:15 PM (ref: Sauk Cty Sher) Mrs. C.F. & husband saw light bigger than any star; seen in West; came directly overhead then hdg SE; extremely fast; She was in Civil Defense; stated "not balloon".
- 20) 2/8/77 APPLETON: 7 to 7:30PM; Mr. & Mrs. M. sighted craft low in East;  $\frac{1}{4}$  size of moon; shaped like orange plate w. huge light on each end. Craft hovered 10 min., then moved rapidly, flashed brilliant rainbow colors; hdg W. to zenith; window-like lights around bottom; disappeared in 3 sec.

UFO Ed Center called Lt. C. in vicinity. He could not spot craft. Lt. C. called for Brown Cty Sher Dept to send squad car w. binoc.

C.'s home; spots enormous craft, hanging vertically in sky, rectangular; 3 huge lights red, green, white, each "10 times size of a star"; approx. 1 mile away; sighted 3 sec.; estim. length 220+ ft. X 50 ft. or larger. Army vet, 14 mos. in Viet Nam at airport. "That was no airplane". Previously a firm skeptic.

37) 3/21/77 STURGEON BAY, Door County: Mr. & Mrs. R.L., son, daughter and renter; 7:00 to 7:25 PM; TWO SHIPS; intense green in center & large green haze around each;  $\frac{1}{2}$  moon to full-moon size each; very low; gradually moved west out-of-sight; no noise; mostly hovering; no fog, clear.

38) 3/21/77 STURGEON BAY, Door County: Mr. & Mrs. W.F. & 3 children; 7:10 to 7:40 PM TWO CRAFT: spiral, hazy, round to egg-shaped; yellowish haze all-around obj; pulsating; one was closer and brighter; lights revolving; moved W. & faded; brighter area near bottom.

(NOTE: THESE PAIRS OF OBJECTS WERE SEEN A FULL TEN HOURS BEFORE THE CALIF. "PAIRS" AND WERE HOVERING. ABOUT FOUR HOURS BEFORE FIRST CALIF. REPORT.)

# UFO headquarters calls Door county sighting a 'scout craft'

At least eight Door county men, women and children are among a growing number of state residents who have spotted unidentified flying objects (UFO's) within the past two nights.

Joan LeClair called Wednesday to say she and four other Jacksonport people had spotted an unusual object "hanging over the trees near West Jacksonport" at about 8:30 p.m. Tuesday. Grabbing her husband's binoculars, Joan climbed to the second floor of their Ivanhoe Bar to take a closer look.

"My hands were trembling," she reported, "but I kept the glasses trained on an elongated object. It glowed green on the top and bottom but had what appeared to be a red band around the center. There appeared to be another compartment on the bottom of this disc and I could actually see windows in this lower part. You won't believe this but there appeared to be a passenger inside."

A neighbor, who asked that his name not be mentioned, saw the same type of object hovering for about three minutes over the same clump of trees. This man, accompanied by his two sons and a friend, said he did not see any windows or figures moving about but he did describe the same colors and shape of the object.

"It was green with a red band around the middle," he said. "It just sort of hung there and then shot ahead at a terrific speed."

When asked if he had ever seen anything like this before the man said, "Yes, many years ago but I didn't say anything about it at the time."

Sightings were also reported Wednesday night by a woman living on the outskirts of Jacksonport and a Baileys Harbor man. Two of these people reported their findings to the sheriff's department and Deputy Mark Rispins was sent to West Jacksonport to investigate.

Both sightings took place at about the same time, between 8:30 and 8:45 p.m., but by the time Rispins got there the

object had disappeared. Sgt. Gary Bies, however, reported the incidents to the Midwest UFO Headquarters in Appleton and Associate Director Thomas S. Heiman immediately contacted LeClair. After hearing her description, Heiman asked for a drawing which is being sent to his office today. Heiman said in a telephone interview this Thursday that the description closely matches that of a "scout craft" which has been seen by residents in the Appleton area and as far south as Racine.

"This type of spaceship," Heiman said, "closely resembles an actual ship which was photographed in 1952 by George Adamski, one of this country's pioneers in UFO research. Adamski actually met a passenger off this ship and the meeting was confirmed by several witnesses."

Heiman, noting that Adamski died in 1965, said his work is being carried on at the national UFO headquarters in Valley Center, Calif., but that his photographs have been authenticated by a leading Nassau nuclear engineer. "This type of craft is not a true disc," Heiman added. "It actually has a dome and passenger

compartment such as LeClair saw."

The associate director stressed the fact that a communication gap must be bridged between government and American people regarding UFO's and said that these space visitors are friendly. "They mean no harm," Heiman said firmly. "We have to show we are not afraid to extend a hand in friendship."

This particular type of scout craft is, according to Heiman, about 20 to 30 feet or more in diameter and is capable of traveling at exceptionally high speeds. It is also able to maneuver rapidly in a number of directions.

"An awful lot of sightings have been seen around the state," Heiman stated. "The Appleton and Racine spotters saw the object described by your Door county people at 8:01 p.m. It will be interesting to compare the drawings."

Heiman asks that residents spotting unfamiliar objects to notify the police or call his office direct. The number is 414-731-5001 and there is someone on duty 24 hours a day.

Just when the Bionic Woman was matching wits with that hairy monster Wednesday night, Pat came rushing in the living room.

"I just let Snoopy out, mama," he said breathlessly, "and there's something really weird in the sky."

I had exactly 13 pincurls left to twist in my wet hair and wasn't too anxious to go outside but Pat's urgency compelled me to drop everything and follow his lead. First, however, I took the precaution of draping a blanket over my dripping head and grabbing my husband's World War II binoculars.

Due east over our back porch was what appeared to be an unusually bright star. It was so high in the heavens we had to crane our necks for a really good look but once we had it aligned with my clothesline post, keeping track was fairly easy.

"It's Venus," growled my husband, who followed us outside. "Come inside before you freeze to death."

"I've never seen Venus play hop-skotch," said my son. "The dumb thing's moving around up there."

While my husband adjusted the binoculars for a better look I ran inside and put on my trusty bifocals. Pat kept insisting the object was smooth, round and shiny white with red and green lights at either end. I didn't see the colored lights but the shiny white part literally glowed.

"What you see, son, is the refraction on the lens of the binoculars," my husband explained, just as the phone set up a shrill ringing. "There's an explanation for everything."

Dennis Krishka, a young man who told me he had seen an unidentified flying object the night before, was my caller. He too had spotted "Venus" at about 7:30 p.m. and the red and green lights were plainly visible to him. He told me he had taken the entire basketball team out of the village hall to observe the sight before calling me.

Dennis lives in Sister Bay, not far from our place, and the light was due east for both of us.

Pat and I set up our vigil in the kitchen while my husband returned to his all-important television program. The two of us observed (Pat with the binoculars and me with my specs) a smaller red light moving up toward sparkling old Venus and two smaller objects moving in. The latter, Pat said, had more of an "orangish" color than red but they all had the same luminous glow which appeared to fade and then brighten.

We watched for more than an hour before my older son joined us. He had seen the light in the east, too, but thought basketball took priority over star gazing. Once he saw the steadily ascending red object, however, he maintained his vigil with the rest of us. Up, up it went, straight over the clothesline post until it was about half way to hop-skotch land. The bright Venus light, I should mention, appeared to be directly overhead.

When the little red light veered in any direction the big one followed suit.

At 11 the phone rang again. This time it was Tom Heiman from the UFO Educational Center in Appleton who was in Door county interviewing Joan LeClair and other spotters. Unfortunately, the call came at the time Venus was streaking out of sight and my poor little red straggler was nowhere near home base.

I told Heiman what we were watching and he said several other people were reporting the same sight. I then said it was the best show I had seen in a long time and outside of a stiff neck, half-set hair, and sniffles (it was a cold night) I really felt exhilarated.

"Are you going to write about it," he asked.

"No," I replied. "Nobody will believe me."

## Door-Co. Residents Sight UFO

**STURGEON BAY** — More than a dozen persons in an area stretching from Sturgeon Bay to Sister Bay in Door County reported seeing an Unidentified Flying Object on Tuesday and Wednesday nights.

The UFO was described by most of those claiming to have sighted it as "sausage or oblong-shaped," brightly colored and bathed in light.

According to a number of reports, it was first noticed by Jim Richmond of Jacksonport Tuesday about 8:30 p.m.

"A weird experience," is the way Richmond described the sighting.

Richmond said he was sitting in his living room looking out the window when he saw what he first believed was a bright star moving back and forth in the western sky.

Realizing it couldn't be a star, Richmond said he picked up his binoculars and went out on the front porch for a better look. Through the binoculars he was able to see the UFO mov-

ing from side to side, stopping and then moving again.

"I knew it couldn't be a plane," Richmond said.

In a short time, news of Richmond's discovery spread, first to the Robert LeClair family across Highway 57 and then to a number of their friends in the village.

Jim Kaus, his two sons, Dennis and Daniel, were visiting a friend, Don Badtke when Mike LeClaire telephoned. Kaus said the four then went outside and spotted "this awful big outfit" above the treetops to the west.

"I've never seen anything like it before," reported Kaus. "It can make a believer out of you. The lights kept glowing from bright to dim."

Kaus and Joanne LeClaire both described the UFO as sausage-shaped, with a red middle section and green on the bottom and top.

About the same time in Sturgeon Bay, 16-year-old Kevin Moore and his mother, Mrs. Edward Moore, watched as an oblong-shaped object which was "red in the middle" moved up and

down and crosswise in the sky for about an hour.

Wednesday, between 8 and 9 p.m., Russell Lundquist of rural Sister Bay said he saw something unusual from his window and went out into the yard for a better look. Lundquist, who was cautious about calling it a UFO, said, "Whatever it was, it was quite bright with some kind of light surrounding it. It was jumping around, not like anything you ever saw before."

About the same time Wednesday, Mrs. Dale Orsted and her son, Rande, who live on County EE of Baileys Harbor, spotted what they described as a "big ball" when they looked out their window.

Mrs. Orsted said the object, which was quite a distance away, was green on the bottom with a middle section of the "reddest red I've ever seen" and moved crosswise for about 15 minutes before disappearing "in a blink of the eye."

A check with Thomas Heiman, associate director of the UFO Education Center in Appleton, disclosed that there had been an unusual flurry of

sightings in the Fox Valley in the past week.

The center, a nonprofit organization funded by private donations, provides a clearing house for UFO information, Heiman said.

There is a good rapport between local law enforcement agencies and the center, Heiman said. When persons claiming to have seen UFOs report the sightings to the agencies they are referred to the center or the agencies calling the information.

About 90 per cent of sightings are unreported, Heiman said, and he added he was encouraged so many persons in Door County were sharing their experiences.

Any person believing that he or she may have sighted an object is urged, Heiman said, to call the center in Appleton or write P.O. Box 1436, Appleton 54911.

He stressed that persons interested keep a camera handy and log any sightings. He said it isn't necessary to use a flash because of the amount of light usually given off by the objects.

The questions no longer begin with "if."

They begin with who, why, what, where and how?

Miss Charlotte Blob (rhymes with globe), director of the UFO Education Center with international headquarters at Valley Center, Calif., who is visiting and speaking here, said that audiences have stopped asking if-type questions about UFOs and passengers.

"They want information about them."

Who are these beings?

Why are they here?

What do they look like? What do they want?

Where are they from?

How does all this affect us?

"People are more open in relat-

ing experiences, too," she said. "Our files are bulging with information, photos, drawings and film strips."

Some of the material will be shown during her program tonight at 8 in the West Shore Unitarian Church, 20401 Hilliard Rd., Lakewood.

"Our purpose is to teach — to educate as many of the masses as are willing to learn. Our problem is that people always take the fearful approach; we look for monsters, demons, humanoid creatures and whatnot, because of our science-fiction orientation.

"Instead, these visitors are friendly human beings, with a very compassionate nature. There is nothing fearful about them. We are being visited by our own relatives in the universe."

Miss Blob takes her teachings

seriously.

She said they (the "outer-space" people) have never been known to be hostile, violent or evil-intentioned; they have been visiting the earth for 50,000 years; the majority of the planets in our solar system are inhabited with intelligent life and that there are 10,000 of these "noble people visiting us incognito" at the present time.

A former associate of the late George Adamski, author of "Flying Saucers Have Landed," Miss Blob claimed that Adamski met with a man from Venus in the Mojave Desert on Nov. 20, 1952, whom he described as follows:

"He was about 5-foot-6, and I would estimate him to have been about 28, although he could have been much older. His hair was sandy in color and hung in beautiful waves to his shoulders, glistening more beautifully than any woman's I have ever seen.

"The beauty of his form surpassed anything I had ever seen. And the pleasantness of his face freed me of all thought of my personal self. I felt like a little child in the presence of one with great wisdom and much love, and I became very humble within myself. . . for from him was radiating a feeling of infinite understanding and kindness, with supreme humility."

She said that it has been demonstrated again and again that the intentions of the people on these crafts are of friendship and nobility and that man on earth still has to overcome his fear of the unknown.

But fear isn't the only thing man needs to change. Earth men are destroying their own environment and have been close to destroying the universe except for the intervention of these friendly protectors from afar, she said.

She cited radiation problems associated with the super-bomb explosions, changes in the earth's poles, changes in earth faults and other dangerous situations which she said has been brought about by man's experimentation. "That is also the reason so many of these people are visiting earth now."

At one point, a powerful hydrogen warhead, which had just been launched, was snatched from the atmosphere by these friendly interlopers in time to avert igniting the hydrogen belt in the atmosphere and circling the earth with fire, she reported.

"That story quickly was hushed up by shaken officials."

In speaking of pollution-type threats, Miss Blob claimed that many of the strange viruses, often referred to as new strains of flu, are types of radiation sickness caused by all the radiation we've put in the atmosphere.

"A physician actually verified that these flu cases are identical to radiation sickness," she said.


Miss Blob, a native New Yorker who spent much of her life in Wisconsin, left her studies at the University of Wisconsin years ago. She was majoring in psychology, but she had to quit to keep up with the demand for her lectures.

Her interest in UFOs dates back to her high school days when she was a volunteer in the nation's Skywatch defense program. That is when she had her first UFO sighting.


She has lectured all over this country as well as in Canada, Mexico, Denmark and Belgium. Presently she is working with law-enforcement bodies.

## Group wants information on sightings

# UFO seekers visit Marquette

Research into unidentified flying objects (UFOs) may ultimately result in a grassroots movement to keep the military out of space programs.

Representatives of the UFO Education Center's Midwest branch in Appleton, Wis., say they believe mankind must take a friendly approach to visitors from other planets. The UFO center spokesmen, in Marquette for two lectures, said this would require a change in thinking about space programs in the United States and Russia.

"The U.S. and Russia are turning outer space into a battleground," Thomas Heiman, center associate director, said. "We are bringing the cause of destruction into an area where the public has yet to grasp the supreme reality, a superior avenue of research."

Heiman, Spanish director Cuitlahuac Liceaga of Mexico, and Japanese director Haruhisa Koyama, say they feel UFO inhabitants come to teach the world respect for life.

Heiman says "an enormous amount of evidence" shows that UFOs visit Earth. The technological knowledge of extra-terrestrial beings teaches humanity a lesson, he adds.

"We have to ask ourselves if we had that technology, would we have been so quiet and nonviolent in our approach to another planet," Heiman said. "We have to ask ourselves if we are ready to leave our war games behind as we enter outer space."

Heiman recalls Albert Einstein's statement that decisions concerning atomic power must be "taken to the village square," rather than being settled by the scientific or political elite. He says policy in space programs must be handled in the same way.

"By bringing citizen pressure in every country, it would be possible to take the military power structure out of the space effort and to give a sense of welcome to these people," Heiman said.

In view of this, the movement to spread information about UFOs has a broader purpose, he says. Although often sensationalized, it is a citizen effort that concerns nuclear weaponry and governmental responsiveness.

The UFO Education Center is headed by Charlotte Blöb, who spoke to law enforcement officers in Marquette last year, and is based in California. The non-profit group is supported by contributions and lecture fees.

It has worked mostly with law enforcement personnel and the media. Police officers are encouraged to report any UFO sightings to the Appleton center and are schooled in how to take reports.

Heiman says the group works with the media to improve public awareness of UFOs and to get citizens to call UFO information to the center. The center's 24-hour UFO hot line's number is (414) 731-5001. Also, persons who think they have seen a flying saucer can file a written report with the agency. The group's address is P.O. Box 1436, Appleton 54911.

The effort to give a more positive image to UFOs will hopefully get rid of fearful attitudes and misinformation, the men say. Liceaga says UFOs have responded to positive, friendly information and have, at times, appeared to rebut misleading information.

"I might say they take a corrective attitude to the capabilities we have to distort the truth," Liceaga said.

Despite images of invaders from outer space as presented in science fiction movies, Heiman says many persons who call the center don't have a fearful attitude. Most who report a UFO sighting feel a "sense of awe," he says.

## The Kind of Night for Talking of UFOs

Madison, Wis. — It was a dark and stormy night. The wind whipped cold rain through the naked trees of Capitol Square and streaks of water ran down the Capitol like blood from wounds.

Tomorrow the Legislature would be back in session, but tonight there was to be a "hearing" up in Room 213 Northwest having to do with UFOs.

Then, there it was: It was round and green inside and strips of bright white light ran across it over the heads of the occupants. There were three odd shaped windows along one side and there was a faint buzzing noise.

It was, of course, Room 213 North-

west and the buzzing was from the vacuum cleaner of a maintenance crew working down the hall Wednesday night. There were about 50 people inside the room, including a half dozen legislators. Up in front were three representatives of the UFO Education Center at Appleton. One of them, Tom Helman, a neat, pleasant appearing man of about 40, smiled and welcomed everyone.

### "Bridge of Communication"

"We are here to try to establish a bridge of communication," Helman said. "We want people to be able to talk about the things they are seeing.

"We know that we are being visited by people from other planets. We know that they are peaceful. We know that

they are human beings who work quietly among us and they are not creatures. If you want to see creatures, turn on the evening TV news."

There have been many recent sightings of spacecraft by Wisconsin residents, Helman said. "Virtually half the people of Door County have seen these craft in the last couple of weeks — some at close range."

Helman said the time was ripe for release of all government information concerning UFOs.

### Peaceful Intent

The space people are from other planets in our solar system, Helman said, and they are visiting Earth to try to quietly direct our life along peaceful lines. They

are also very interested in what we are doing with nuclear power, he added, and they want to prevent us from polluting space with misuse of this power.

"We must step aside from our egos long enough to recognize that there can be intelligent life elsewhere," Helman said. "It would be gross arrogance to think that the planet Earth is the only place it exists. With only a fraction of the technical knowledge that the space people have, we could solve all of our energy problems.

"We are only asking that people talk quietly and calmly and admit the truth. Now is the time for candor in the affirmation of all human rights, and the next step would be to acknowledge the peace-

ful human reality of these extraterrestrial visitations."

### Pictures Shown

Helman showed slides and movies of objects he said were spacecraft. These "craft" were generally L-shaped and moved about erratically. Many of the pictures had been taken by the late George Adamski, who founded the work being carried on by Helman and his co-workers. There was also a picture alleged to be of a space person from one of the craft.

Assisting Helman were Haruhisa Koyama, of Japan, and Cuiclahuac Liceage, of Mexico. They are associate directors of the UFO Education Center.

Earlier Wednesday, a press conference had been held in the Assembly parlor. It was sparsely attended by a couple of TV crews and two reporters. The Capitol facilities were used through the courtesy of Rep. David Clarenbach (D-Madison). Clarenbach said he felt the subject

was of public interest and that use of the Capitol was a right that anyone had. Clarenbach was not among the legislators at either the press conference or the hearing.

### Questions Asked

The evening session was followed by questions from the audience, each of which was dealt with articulately by Helman.

Then the round green room was empty and the bright

lights went out. The humming noise could still be heard. Maybe it was a vacuum cleaner down the hall. Maybe it was the Wisconsin Legislature slowly building up dynamic energy and momentum for a productive session, and maybe it was visitors from outer space, idling their engine while they watched what was going on.

Out in the dark and stormy night, the latter seemed the most probable.
