Nick, I have heard about the 3rd Avrocar before but
I would like to know
more before proceeding with a contact to Terry. The
third Avrocar was
apparently not built but there were at least two wooden
full-scale
mock-ups of Project Y- an earlier spade-shaped VTOL
design (destroyed
in 1954?!) and the Avrocar mock-up. The Avrocar mockup
was used mainly
for checking dimensions and trying out configurations
in the initial
design period of 1958-1959. It apparently was still

at the Avro plant in 1962 but its whereabouts are unknown since. The only other saucer craft that was constructed was the Avro PV704 test rig that was presumably dismantled in the early 1960's since the Viper engines that powered it were utilized in other research work. If you find out more, I would be delighted to use this information in my book.

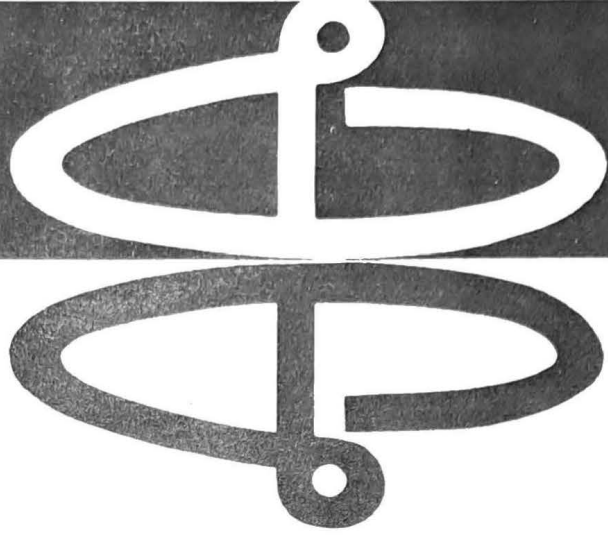

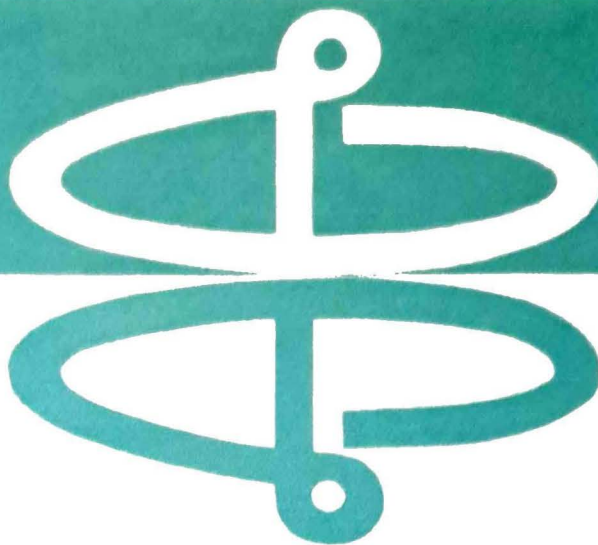

As I am sure you have heard from Ole Jansen, there is a fair bit of work taking place by researchers related to your father's files at the University of Ottawa. It has become a hot topic especially in the United States where few had ever heard of the story. On many days the Wilbert Smith section on my website gets more hits than the whole rest of the site related to United States Presidents.

As part of the effort to provide researchers with all the available research that your father gathered during his life, I have put together a research CD which will have many of the files from the University of Ottawa Archives, some of my correspondence, and many audios by your father or made about your father in the 50s and 60s. Included will be many audios that no one has heard.

One of the things that I hope you can help with is photos. Despite a whole filing cabinet full of stuff I have found that there are almost no photos. Even the archive seems to have nothing.

If it is possible I would like to get a scan of a photo of your mother and dad.
