Thank you for your quick response to my previous fax. Below I have included those specific points that you stated are necessary for the FOIA request.

I am an investigator for the National Institute for Discovery Science, (NIDS). NIDS is a privately funded, non-commercial scientific research institute dedicated to the study of aerial phenomena and related topics.

I recently received information of a UFO and entity sighting witnessed and reported by Security Police that occurred at McGuire AFB in January 1978. In addition to formal reports of investigations by the Security Police and the Air Force Office of Special Investigations, (AFOSI), I am requesting the daily blotters generated and maintained in Central Security Control, (CSG), and by Law Enforcement, (LE). **I am requesting these documents under the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. 552.** It is unknown exactly when in January this occurred, so it will be necessary to study all 90 or so blotter entries for each of the CSG and LE shifts respectively.

The alleged facts of the case are as follows:

Occurred in January 1978.

During the hours of darkness.

Between 0300 hrs and 0500 hrs.

Numerous sightings were seen over McGuire AFB and Fort Dix.


Army MP's and New Jersey State Patrol were pursuing a UFO up to and through Gate 5 on McGuire AFB.

AFOSI and a team from Wright-Patterson AFB responded and took the body of the entity.

This is in response to your Freedom of Information Act request #00-113, regarding information of a UFO and entity sighted, witnessed, and reported by Security Police that occurred at McGuire AFB on January 18, 1978. In addition to formal reports of investigations by the Security Police and the Air Force Office Special Investigations, (AFOSI), daily blotters generated and maintained in Central Security Control, (CSG), and by Law Enforcement, (LE). All daily blotters for Security and Law Enforcement for the dates of January 17th, 18th, and 19th. DD Form 1569's concerning this UFO and entity incident. After a thorough search by the OPR, there were **"no records"** found.

Security Police states, "All incident and blotter reports are destroyed after three years per AFMAN 37-139, Records Disposition Schedule".
