1. (S/CL-2/NOFORN) On 6 January 1984, LTC Buzby and [redacted] met with [redacted] on two occasions. At the first meeting MG Stubblebine was in attendance. The purpose of the first meeting was for [redacted] to ask MG Stubblebine for authorization to interface directly with this office in order to work out an arrangement whereby this office could assist NSA in an OPSEC project in psychoenergetics. MG Stubblebine authorized the requested interface.

2. (S/CL-2/NOFORN) Later LTC Buzby and [redacted] met again with [redacted] in anticipation of working out details of NSA's requirements. During this meeting it became apparent that [redacted] did not know exactly what it was that he wanted. He did not appear to have been briefed on the concept of Associative Remote Viewing by [redacted] as we had been led to believe. [redacted] stated that, in his opinion, the Remote Viewing work that we had done for him in the past seemed of little or no value to him. We explained the concept of Associative Remote Viewing to him as it could be applied to the "reading" of sealed authenticators. Again, he was unsure as to what application such a technique may have for NSA. The meeting was ended without deciding on anything other than [redacted] needed to think over what he wanted to do. [redacted] stated that he would contact us as soon as something was resolved.
