

4 1/2 - a part of this complex has been used since ancient times for the same purpose. In more modern times it has been enlarged and expanded. It is in a strategic location. It's main function is to hide supplies. It is along a major supply route.

4 1/2 - This underground facility is well concealed by the natural ravines and rugged terrain. The opening to this complex is large, natural, and is like a large cave entrance. It cannot be seen from the open ground leading to it because it is hidden by a canyon or ravine. It is very difficult to see from overhead because it is concealed in the hillsides. On the inside is a large natural cavern that has been used in ancient times as a military storage point. In more recent times a large rectangular room/warehouse has been carved out of the rock beyond or adjacent to the cavern area. This location lies along an important supply route that has been used from ancient times to the present.
