1. (S-SS) Statistics:

2. (S-SS) At the start of this session, I tried to rid myself of the feeling that there will be no attacks on U.S. flagged ships in the Gulf of Hormuz or the Persian Gulf during the month of September, by declaring it as both A.V. and AOL.

3. (S-SS) Having done this, I located myself on the Persian Gulf, and looked for a U.S. flagged ship, having a problem. Perceptions were:

- a. There was ²a U.S. flagged ship having problems which was located near land, the coast being in a north/south direction at that point (see sketch, bottom, P.1)
- b. The ship, itself is facing in a north/south direction at the time of the problem.

4. (S-SS) As a double check on this information, I then retasked myself with "U.S. ship having trouble in the Persian Gulf", and got nothing.

5. (S-SS) It dawned on me that I had just given myself two different tasking cues, so I again cued myself with "U.S. flagged ship having trouble in the Persian Gulf". Perceptions received were:

- a. Ship facing in a north/south direction.
- b. Something wrong (NFI) high on one end.
- c. The end with "something wrong" is the northern end of the ship, facing away from land.
- d. Feeling that this is the same ship as perceived above.

6. (S-SS) It did not occur to me during the session to draw a timeline, and check for a specific date of occurrence.

7. (S-SS) I then tried a pendulum exercise, to check the veracity of each element of EEI. Each item was tested repeatedly, with the following results:

Is the location of "something wrong" correct?	3	0
Is the flagged ship w/"something wrong" the same as the one on Page 1?	3	0

8. (S-SS) I ended the session without retasking for the Gulf of Hormuz. I realize now, however, that the last session, in which I got that there will be no hostile activities, was cued strictly toward problems in the Gulf of Hormuz, and did not include the Persian Gulf.

9. (S-SS) Viewer's critique: I just don't have that glowing inner confidence about this one, so am not certain how much I would depend on its results.

INTOSUM SUMMARY: LOCATED A SHIP WHICH HAS SOMETHING WRONG WITH IT, ~~HEAT~~ ON ONE END. SHIP IS LOCATED NEAR LAND, FACING IN A NORTH-SOUTH DIRECTION. DOESN'T SEEM TO BE MOVING OR POINT ANYTHING. THE PLACE WHERE "SOMETHING IS WRONG" WITH THE SHIP IS ON THE SIDE WHICH FACES AWAY FROM LAND, AND SEEMS TO BE ON THE NORTHERN END OF THE SHIP.
