1. (S/NF/SK) INTERVIEWER TASKING: This project has several levels of tasking. Each separate level will be addressed as it occurs in the sessions or as the specific data obtained from the session answers in part or whole any of the tasking provided. The initial tasking being exploited in this session pertains to the configuration and special characteristics of the US developed "Stealth" bomber. Future sessions will be devoted to comparing this aircraft with prototype Soviet systems as well as seeking out the method by which the Soviet Union was able to acquire US Stealth technology.

2. (S/NF/SK) SOURCE TASKING: Source was told only that this is the first session of a multi-session target and that He had not previously been targeted against this tasking. Source was further provided encrypted coordinates of 135750/112794, as per Coordinate Remote Viewing (CRV) protocols, and directed to begin with the general area of the target site and move to the specifics at the direction of the Interviewer.

3. (S/NF/SK) INCLEMENCIES: There were no reportable incidents or anomalies which may have influenced the data obtained in this session. It should be noted that this session constituted the initial session under an office re-organization in which this Source was placed under the operational supervision of the Interviewer. The changing of "rhythms" and interpersonal relationships between the Source and the Interviewer often results in some early faltering but as these relationships become firmed up the problems seem to fade and disappear.

4. (S/NF/SK) SUMMARY: Source furnished the attached summary which was prepared following the session and submitted to the Interviewer

within 36 hours after the session. The completeness of the typewritten summary has been compared to the Interviewer's notes and all deletions, changes, and/or corrections have been verified as acceptable by the Interviewer. In the summary Source reported a warm, dry area with a decided military "feel" about it. According to Source there may have been a body of salt water near this area. The site seems to be concerning with the development or use of some sort of high-technology equipment which Source alternately perceived as land based tracked vehicles to surface to air missile systems. The site is made up of a complex of separate areas reminding Him of military bivouac sites and tactical operations centers. Some of the equipment in this area is routinely kept concealed with tarps and transported to the area on large flat bed trucks. Source touched briefly on several items of "special interest" but was unable to objectify these objects in a manner which would indicate that He had in fact acquired the proper site nor item of interest.

5. (S/NF/SK) COMMENTS: This was the initial session between Source and this Interviewer in an official team relationship. In the opinion of the Interviewer, Source may have been suffering from a residual "drive" from the last project which dealt with the mid-East. It could be argued that He was, in fact, on target, if one presumes that the Stealth technology is being tested and developed in an arid region such as the Mojave Desert or other areas of the US Southwest and that the descriptions of the bivouac areas was nothing more than His impressions of the test area. This is a moot point however, since the main thrust of the targeting is the actual aircraft and at no time during the session was the Source able to provide data which would indicate that He was attempting to describe an airframe or items associated with an aircraft. His description of a rather complicated component, which he was directed to "re-sketch" may, on the other hand, be a description of a key component of the Stealth system and representative of Source's impression of what the main characteristic of that aircraft. Future sessions will be dedicated to directing Source's focus of attention to the "item of interest to this tasking" in the hopes that He will be able to throw off any other ADL and begin describing the actual aircraft.


Site involves a land/structure/water interface as well as an activity or event. Land is arid, sandy, unsettled; water is large, bounded by land on at least two sides, may be salt; climate is sunny, warm, and bright. At least one of the structures in the general area seems to be grey, large, complex, made of metal, and suggestive of the AOL of 'vessel'. Military, organized, assigned, watching, and waiting are words that apply to this structure. There is also a chronic, low-grade tension present. People present are wearing clothing "like" uniforms, but they are not all the same.

Another facet of the site involves an area on land, isolated, which includes vehicles, trailers, antennas, cables, etc. parked in a way suggestive of a TOC or bivouac site. This grouping of ~~vehicles, etc.~~ serves a supporting function for some other part of a "system" which seems to be weapons related in some way. This first "bivouac area" seems presently to be dormant, or "on standby", with low manning level. It's "like" a C<sup>3</sup> site; it involves electronics but they are not primary to its function. There are occasional aircraft overhead, not threatening, but like they're patrolling or something similar. This location, together with the other location that is connected with it, are combat related, have a purpose that is directly connected with weapons and targeting, and is somewhat mobile. Tracked vehicles are present, along with one that seems to be used for transporting and placing into operation one form of weapons system that involves long cylindrical objects mounted in multiples which can be individually dismounted and remounted. AOL of SAM-6.

There is a further object of interest which may or may not be hidden from view. It doesn't seem especially complex, but is based on relatively simple principles. A container is involved. The object is rounded, angled, curved, somewhat dense in part of it, has components that are interconnected it doesn't seem to be especially large. Something within the object can be rotated. It clicks as it goes, "like" octagonal or hexagonal. There are things resembling small tubes, pipes, or conduits coming out and going in. Some sort of housing is involved.

A further item of possible interest is secured and wrapped in a flexible covering like a very large tarp and carried on a flat-bed trailer; it must be lifted off with a crane cautiously to avoid damage or "decalibration."
