1. (S/NF/SK) MISSION: Determine if the vessel known as [REDACTED] which left Honduras on 21 September 1988, was carrying drugs as suspected. If so, determine where on board the illegal drugs were stored. Determine how they were packaged and stored. Determine where they were unloaded and determine the final destination for the drugs.

2. (S/NF/SK) VIEWER TASKING: Encrypted coordinates 127880/79629. The cue "item of interest" refers to any drugs on board the vessel (if any). To determine where the drugs were unloaded and their final destination, the viewer was given a map of the entire United States to dowse.

3. (S/NF/SK) COMMENTS: 003 reported that there were drugs aboard the vessel though he sensed that the drugs were "like" marijuana not cocaine. The drugs were stored in 10-20 rounded, hollow, cylindrical containers which looked "similar to" emergency life-raft containers. These 10-20 cylindrical containers were stacked inside a large, rectangular/oblong metallic container with corrugated sides "similar to" a CONNEX container. This large rectangular container was below-deck in a low, central location inside the large, forward portion of the vessel. This container was surrounded and covered by other items and materials. One impression of these other materials was that of large, banded stacks of dimensional lumber. The drugs were off-loaded somewhere in the vicinity of the mouth of the Albemarle Sound in North Carolina, near Nag's Head/ Kitty Hawk.

The ultimate destination for the drugs is Los Angeles, Boston, New York City and Knoxville. The drugs will not end up in either Chicago or San Francisco. The drugs will be transported in a two-axle, yellow, silver-colored box-body truck moving a long distance from east to west.






Site involves a vessel on a large body of water. Vessel is medium sized, superstructure aft, and many thin vertical and horizontal elements "like" poles (A/S of medium-sized coastal freighter), and a large, open space forward. It is slow, old, but reasonably kept up, party to look respectable and not attract attention. (A/S that it was originally a legitimate vessel, but its owners fell on hard times and became desperate, resorting to questionable "consignments" to make ends meet). Water is a large expanse of grey, ominous water "like" the North Atlantic pending a storm. An item of interest is rounded, cylindrical, hollow, reminiscent of an emergency life-raft container on a ship, containing something producing the AOL of "container of marijuana", and the impressions of dusty, crinkly, crumbly, vegetable matter with a cloying taste/smell "like" moldy hay that is compressed or tightly packed. Some 10-20 of the smaller rounded containers seem to be contained within a larger, rectangular/oblong metallic container with corrugated sides similar to a connex container for store supplies and tools at a motorpool. The entire thing is in a low, central location inside the large ^{Covered} forward portion of the vessel surrounded and covered by other items and materials. One impression is of large, banded stacks of dimensional lumber. There was one AOL or AOL/S that cocaine was not involved, but rather marijuana. A location-finding exercise on 17 Oct 88 suggested that the material was or will be offloaded somewhere in the vicinity of the mouth of the Albemarle Sound in N. Carolina, near Nag's Head/Kittyhawk. Ultimate destination of materials may be LA, Boston, NY, Knoxville, not Chicago or San Francisco; impression of a 2-axle, yellow, silver-colored box-body truck moving a long distance from east to west. An earlier session (12 Oct 88), thought to have presented only AOL, may represent alternative or other destination. AOL or AOL/S of Washington, D.C., and sketch resembling Capitol Bldg produced, as well as old, dilapidated house-type structure. Same session identified impression of site involving people interacting, connected with some sort of relatively small metallic objects that were curving and straight, small and intricate, with angles, hefty for their size, interlocking pieces, functional, tool-like, useful, purposeful, specialized, fairly precise but extreme tolerances not necessary for adequate functioning. Clicking sound sometimes present when used. AOL/S of small concealable weapon produced.
