There are/were 9 vessels within the vicinity of a portion of [redacted] within the vicinity of docks or wharfs (see diagram). Two vessels (labeled #1 & #2) are involved with contraband drugs.

Vessel #1 has a rusty or faded red hull and white superstructure w/ large rusted areas where the paint is peeling. It has one ~~last~~ large mast-like object and two smaller angular objects on deck. This vessel has a central hold area where frozen fish or meat is stored. In between the solid layers/blocks of fish/meat & ice are layers of small packages wrapped in what resembles white freezer wrapping paper. The words ANTIQUA and MARYSPORT are associated with this vessel. Its destination is the west coast of Mexico.

Vessel #2 has a dark blue or black hull with a white superstructure which sits far forward. There are one or two masts present on deck. There is a hold area within the center of the ship where barrel-like containers are lying on their sides. It is an area of the ship that is dark, rusty and has an oily smell. Forward of these containers is a dimly lit section where boxes are stored. These boxes are hiding an area further forward which contains smaller, flatter boxes. These boxes are holding small,

round-shaped glass bottles of greenish glass liquid,
 on their sides in an alternating pattern (see
 diagram). The liquid content is highly
 volatile & yellowish in color. It has a dry "feel"
 like reminiscent of acetone or solvent. This
 liquid is used in the manufacture of some type
 of illegal drug or substance (either a "designer"
 drug or steroids). ~~It~~ It needs to be handled
 very carefully. There has been at least one
 death associated with the transport of
 this substance. The name Dick Carson or Carson
 or Carlson is associated with this substance / operation.
~~Its designation is a clandestine laboratory.~~
 The ship's destination is L.A., ~~and the substance~~
 The substance is bound for a clandestine laboratory
