Summary of Report

The target is a fishing / trawler vessel w/ several boom-like projections. Its condition is unkept & damaged. The bridge / cabin area has several odd angles associated with the front of it. It appears to produce an overly large amount of exhaust / smoke while running. There are nets or something woven hung "out in the wind" but are not being ^{currently} used for intended purpose. The vessel is not fishing. It is towing something behind it that is rectangular in shape & slopes down from front to rear. It is associated with C/S [redacted] and the U/I S/V. The target is acting as a "look out" or "early warning system" for the [redacted] operation.
