

EARLY BIRDS ROOST at the door of the land office in Battleford (facing page) to ensure first pick of new tracts opened for settlement in the early 1900's. While many immigrants relied on agents hired by the Canadian Government, others came in response to advertisements and traveling exhibits (below).

Alongside them at the land office were successful homesteaders who could file to buy an additional quarter section after meeting the first claim's requirements—part-time tenancy and thirty acres of ground broken within the first three years.

Not everyone found it a promised land. About half the Doukhobors left in disgruntlement at policies they felt infringed on their religion. A group of greenhorns from England found themselves misled by their leader, Moses Barr. But most stayed, despite the loneliness and hard labor
