3. (S/NF/SK) COMMENTS: Much conceptual locational data provided (see diagrams and sketches). Time-information not successfully obtained except for idea of imminence of operation, due to viewer's discomfort at fluidity of possible timing and organization of target operation. Stage VI diagram placed terminus somewhere along a approx 40 mile section of coast centered about 50 miles north of Charleston, SC.




